LOCATION, LOCATION, LOCATION

While the basement is still the most popular place for laundry rooms, the lower level has risen above its former dungeon status by using good lighting and well-appointed cabinets.

And in what other spaces can we find laundry facilities?

The kitchen – European kitchens have housed laundry appliances for decades. Tucked away inside cabinetry, they share common elements, such as sinks and countertops.

The bathroom – Sliding barn doors allow access to appliances while items can transition in and out of your closets.

Tucked away in the second-floor hallway – Most of the laundry originates on this floor. Using an otherwise unproductive corridor for access to the washer and dryer keeps laundry close to its

point of origin. Mudrooms or back door entry areas - Combine these hardworking spaces with

other wet functions such as a pet-washing station. Slushy winters, wet pool parties and wet doggies produce wet clothes and towels, making washing and drying them more efficient.

Wherever your laundry room is, the finishes need to coordinate with the kitchen. bathroom and the rest of your home's stylish design.

KEY FUNCTIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

Seasoned contractor Dan Robinson has this advice for laundry room construction:

Build an accessible washer outlet box. which hides pipes and keeps hoses neat.

Vent piping to the outside with minimal bends and turns to prevent lint build-up and dryer fires.

Install a bathroom fan to minimize humidity.

Use solid pipe rather than the white flexible accordion type. This enables you to push the washers and dryers closer to the wall for a tighter installation.

Build a false wall or enclosure to hide piping from view.

Have a contractor install your washer and dryer. They'll minimize the big gap at the back. Others may pay less attention to space requirements.

Ventless dryers are a great option, too.


Above all else, maintenance is important. Lint builds up over time, blocking vents. Clean your vents regularly!

Consider making the laundry area an integral part of the house with window treatments, wallpaper, plants (they'll love the humidity), outdoor area rugs, glamorous pendant fixtures and the same gorgeous materials for counters, backsplash and flooring, making it Instagram- and Pinterest-worthy.





CREATE A CUSTOM TEA TOWEL OR SET OF NAPKINS WITH A STAMP AND INK.









TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Blank tea towels and/ or napkins (cotton or linen work best)

Permanent ink pad in a colour of your choice

Rubber stamp in a design of your choice

Cardboard or craft paper Iron

HOW-TO

Wash and dry tea towels and napkins to remove sizing solution.

Lay towel or napkin on surface covered with cardboard or craft paper. Decide where to place your pattern.

Apply ink to your stamp from the stamp pad. Stamp towel or napkin. Be sure to apply even pressure on the stamp and hold in place for 10 to 20 seconds to ensure the ink transfers well. Let dry.

Turn fabric over and press with a hot iron to make ink permanent. он

This light and spritzy cocktail combines spicy ginger and sweet pear. Top with some bubbles and enjoy.

INGREDIENTS (per cocktail)

1 oz pear juice 1 oz ginger syrup 1 oz pear liqueur 4 oz dry sparkling wine

ice

GINGER SYRUP

Over medium heat, combine 1 cup sugar and 1 cup water in a saucepan.

Peel and slice a large chunk of ginger and add to the pot.

Bring to a boil and simmer 30-45 minutes.

Let cool and strain through a fine-mesh strainer.

Cover and refrigerate until ready to use.

PREPARE DRINK

Over ice, combine pear juice, ginger syrup and pear liqueur.

Top with sparkling wine and garnish with a pear slice. OH

THREE IMPERATIVES LED BEV AND ART ENNS TO THE LAKE ERIE COTTAGE THEY NOW CALL THEIR HOME AWAY FROM HOME – FAITH, FAMILY AND LEAVING A LEGACY FOR THEIR

Art had always wanted a cottage, but they were put off by the long commute up north. Six years ago on a drive to Port Rowan, where Bev originally hails from, they saw a for sale sign. "It was a lightbulb moment," Bev says. "There are

The Ennses came to the table with plenty of know-how to draw upon. Art has been in the kitchen business for 40 years, they've built several houses and 15 years ago they established their own thriving business in St. Catharines, **Enns Cabinetry**, with 20 employees. Two of their three sons work with them, and Bev, previously in nursing, manages the books and business matters.

The cottage is only 767 square feet plus the loft, but expansive windows overlooking the lake and a 24-foot apex ensure it feels anything but small. "We're here to spend time outside," says Bev.

"When the kids are here they're not inside, they're outside playing in the water and on the beach. In that sense it has everything we need and nothing we don't."

Their own home is done in an Arts and Crafts style, so they opted to go for a rustic look at the lake. Using flooring from **Aristocrat** they created a unique feature wall beside the staircase (by Dekker Stairs Inc.) and in the entry hall. They replaced the broken wood-burning fireplace with a gas insert from Stella's Regional Fireplace Specialists, employing Tim McDonald of McDonald Brothers Masonry to install *Continued on page 28*




a gorgeous stone surround. Wood from the original cottage was repurposed for the main-room ceiling, while leftover skids from the business were sanded and used for the entryway and bedroom ceilings. "I feel like ceilings are often overlooked by people," Art says.

For the kitchen, they chose maple cabinetry, which they manually gave a distressed look. "The guys had a blast with this," says Bev. "They took chains to it before they finished it – you'd think they're wormholes, but they are manmade." Their



son, Jason, built the hood from wood, and then gave it a remarkably authentic metal finish. "Keeping with the rustic style, we didn't put moulding on top of the cabinets," Bev says, "But we did install covers, so when you're looking down from on top it still looks finished."

The countertops are Corian from McFadden's Hardwood & Hardware Inc., a solid surface with an acrylic finish, chosen for its hard-wearing properties and warmth. New appliances came from Nickerson Home Appliances.

When they planned the rebuild, Art and Bev rejigged the floorplan

to replace two small bedrooms and a tiny bathroom with one larger bedroom and a larger bathroom with a tub. The bathroom cabinetry takes centre stage in here – textured like barn wood, it's a Miralis product Enns carries. "It's synthetic, with that whitewashed handscraped look," explains their son, Steve. "It's extremely durable and less expensive than the award-winning wood line of birch they developed." Look up, and a beautiful tin ceiling from Brian Greer's Tin Ceilings completes the handcrafted scene. The new floorplan also allowed for a much-needed laundry space. Continued on page 32

emon meringle TART

This bright tart is made of tangy lemon curd piled high with sweet, fluffy meringue. The meringue is torched until toasty brown for a signature look.

pie crust

1 ¼ cups all-purpose flour		
1/3	⅓ cup powdered sugar	
1⁄4	tsp salt	
1/2	cup cold butter, cubed	
1	egg yolk	
2	Tbsp cold water	
ta	irt pan	

Mix flour, sugar and salt together in a large bowl.

Using a pastry cutter or two knives, cut the butter into the flour mixture until coarse and the butter pieces are no larger than small peas.

In a small bowl, whisk egg and water together and add to the flour-butter mixture. Mix until dough comes together.

Transfer dough to a floured work surface and form into a round disk.

Wrap in plastic and refrigerate until chilled, at least 30 minutes.

Remove dough from refrigerator and let stand 10-15 minutes at room temperature.

Lightly flour work surface. Roll dough away from you and turn dough until it forms a circle just larger than your tart pan.

Fold the dough over your rolling pin and transfer to the pan. Gently press dough into the tart pan and trim excess from edges.

Refrigerate for 30 minutes.

Preheat oven to 400°F. Place aluminum foil over dough, pressing down into the sides of the tart.

Fill the tart with pie weights or dried beans. Bake for about 15 minutes, or until the crust is dry.

Remove the weights and bake for 5 minutes longer, until the crust is set and no longer shiny. Remove from oven.



lemon curd

6 egg yolks

1 cup sugar

½ cup lemon juice, freshly squeezed

pinch of salt

1/2 cup unsalted butter

double-boiler pots

Separate eggs and keep whites for meringue.

Add egg yolks to a large heatproof bowl and whisk in sugar, lemon juice and salt.

Add butter and place bowl over double boiler. Ensure the water is lightly boiling and stir the mixture with a rubber spatula until thickened. The curd should coat the back of the spatula.

Strain the curd through a fine mesh strainer to remove any lumps of egg that may have formed.

Place curd in the fridge for about an hour to set.

Preheat oven to 325°F.

Fill the tart shell with the lemon curd and bake for 15-20 minutes, or until the curd begins to puff around the edges. Remove from oven.

Let tart reach room temperature before placing in the fridge to chill completely.

meringue

6 egg whites 2 tsp vanilla extract 1 ½ cups sugar pinch of salt butane torch

In the stand mixer bowl, combine egg whites, vanilla extract, sugar and salt.

Bring an inch of water to simmer in a saucepan on stove.

Place bowl with ingredients on top of saucepan. Stir until hot and sugar is dissolved, about 5 minutes.

Remove bowl from heat, return to the stand mixer and fit with the whisk attachment.

Whisk on high until stiff peaks form and the meringue is thick and glossy.

Remove tart from fridge and top with meringue, either by scooping or piping.

Using a butane torch, torch the top of the meringue until golden. **o**H

homegrown MONARCHS

The rapid decline of the monarch butterfly population has received much publicity in recent years, and you may have noticed how rarely you spot one compared to years past. Many factors affect this gorgeous but sensitive species, including climate change, habitat loss and herbicide or insecticide spraying. Current studies show that, if existing trends continue, monarch populations could face migratory collapse within the next 20 years. Want to give these stunning creatures a muchneeded helping hand? There are several ways to help ensure a brighter future for monarchs.

Plant milkweed

Milkweed is beautiful, easy to grow and the only plant monarch butterfly larvae (caterpillars) can consume. Planting milkweed provides sustenance for monarch caterpillars via the leaves, and adult monarch butterflies via the flower nectar. Choose from these native varieties:

Common milkweed – Asclepias syriaca Swamp milkweed - Asclepias incarnata Butterfly milkweed – Asclepias tuberosa



No herbicides or insecticides

Both caterpillars and butterflies are extremely sensitive to chemicals. Even a small amount can affect the caterpillar's ability to grow and form a chrysalis. Make your property a safe haven for butterflies as well as all life.

Plant nectar plants





BEGINNERS' GUIDE TO RAISING MONARCHS AT HOME

Nurturing monarch caterpillars in the home environment is easy once you understand their lifecycle. They have four stages: egg, larva, pupa and adult butterfly.

The adult butterfly lays eggs on the milkweed, and within four days the eggs hatch to form a caterpillar, which survives by consuming the milkweed. During this stage caterpillars are extremely susceptible to predation, with only a 2 per cent survival rate. Their predators include birds, ants, spiders, praying mantis, stink bugs and frogs. Within two weeks, the caterpillar attains full growth and transforms into a pupa (or chrysalis). The monarch begins this miraculous process by making a silk button and attaching it to a leaf or stem (or part of an enclosure), then it hangs in a "J" formation for about 12 hours before making its chrysalis. In the next 10-14 days a continuous process of metamorphosis occurs. Once complete, the adult butterfly will emerge, called "eclosing."

FOOD

Milkweed is the only food that can sustain monarch caterpillars. Although it's best to grow your own milkweed from seed to ensure it's free of chemicals, foraging is also possible. Stick to natural areas away from roads and industrial places, and search for plants housing other insects – it's a good sign the plants have likely not been sprayed. The best way to keep milkweed leaves fresh is to use milkweed cuttings. Cut the top portion of the milkweed plant, including a few sets of leaves and stem. Place the stem in water to keep the leaves fresh for days. A tight-mouthed glass bottle works best, to prevent caterpillar drownings.

HABITAT

I like to use fine mesh enclosures. Place enclosures on a screened porch, or indoors near a window with sunlight but no direct sun. You'll need at least two enclosures – one for caterpillars and one for chrysalises, as butterflies can sometimes carry diseases that can affect the caterpillars. (Once a chrysalis has formed and hardened for 2 days it can be safely moved and attached to the separate enclosure.) Caterpillars are eating machines and produce a lot of poop, called frass. You can line the bottom of the enclosure with paper towel and replace daily or use a keyboard vacuum to remove the frass.

EGG & CATERPILLAR HUNTING

It's fun to hunt for eggs and caterpillars! If you find either, take them in right away to avoid predation.

RELEASE

After a butterfly ecloses from their chrysalis, they need to dry their wings for 4 hours before releasing. This gives them their best chance to survive, mate and begin the cycle again.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Not all caterpillars will survive. Just like the outdoors, your indoor environment needs to be chemical-free (even topical flea and tick formulas for your pets can kill caterpillars). They can also fall prey to parasitic flies, wasps and other diseases. A great place to ask questions and get all the pertinent info is the Facebook group The Beautiful Monarch. So, when it was suggested they remove the original fireplace to allow for more space in the living area, making room for heirlooms and the piano, they trusted the outcome. "It was important to keep the home's original character while making it ours," says David. "We love to entertain and host friends, and family from Nova Scotia. We needed an area that inspired mingling." The chiseled stone surround (Sarana Tile) creates a stunning focal point along with built-in shelving, made by **Andrew Tskrekos** of **Aktuality Designs**, to house the couple's treasures. "This is the hub of the house," says Dawn. "We read and watch TV together, and our daughter does her homework at the kitchen counter."

The kitchen now accommodates the busy family of three, along with relatives and friends who come to visit. 



Barrie Robinson has been collecting antique maps for about 30 years. It's a pastime he dialed back when he ran out of space. "After 10 years I had so many maps on the wall that my wife was beginning to complain," he says. Maps with original colourings look beautiful; they make an interesting conversation piece and are a novel way to trace family origins, Barrie explains. The intricate steps and skills involved in creating early maps is part of their appeal, he says. "People don't realize how much technology there was behind it in the 16th and 17th century and the stories that go behind their production," he says. "They're very high-tech, but they're also very pretty."

Antique maps are a better option for wall art than limited edition prints, painting reproductions or expensive original art, Barrie insists. Old maps appreciate in value, as well. One of his maps, a 1598 rendering of the Pacific that may have been used by the navigator on a galleon, has more than tripled in value to more than \$5,000. Antique maps of many different parts of the world and some European countries are very inexpensive, Barrie says. He estimates that beautiful maps from the 16th and 17th centuries can be bought for less than \$200.

Ken Rose, owner of Lake Effects, a gift store in Westport, the heart of eastern Ontario's cottage country, knows first-hand that people value maps. In every cottage he's visited, someone would open a cupboard to reveal a map or point to one tacked on a wall and show him their cottage location, fishing spots and islands. At a trade show in Atlanta 15 years ago, he found threedimensional, laser-cut wooden maps that illustrate lake depths and roads. "When I saw them I knew they'd be perfect for our area because Westport has 30 lakes within

half an hour or so," he says. "I realized how special they were and how they can be personalized." Lake Effects has sold hundreds of laser-cut lake maps.

"Everybody loves their lake. Whatever lake they're on, it's probably the best lake in the whole world," Ken says. "It's people's happy place, so when they can have something indicative of the place, it is aesthetically pleasing."

For those who want to go big, Murals Wallpaper offers world map wallpaper that can cover an entire wall. It comes in panels that are installed like wallpaper. There are also multiple style and colour options to choose from.

Steve Predko of Trailhead Designs is a new mapmaker who appreciates the art of early cartographers. "Original maps were as much

paintings as they were technical," he says. He started making maps with a vintage look, then began using wood and a laser cutter. "Once I created a couple, I became aware of how many other people are equally interested in maps for the places that are important for them," he says. "There are thousands of lakes and cities out there - and each one is special for someone." Maps help people stay connected to a place they love, he says. His maps are usually displayed as part of a grouping of items on a wall to help set a theme. "They are natural wood so they bring warmth to a wall," Steve says.

Cindy expects to use new and historical maps in home décor often. "It provides a perspective for your children, that the world is bigger than what is around us, and the possibilities to dream and even explore are virtually endless." **он**





LIVING WALLS

What is a living wall?

A living wall is a system that allows plants to grow on a vertical panel, and can be either waterbased (hydroponic) or soil-based. Professionally constructed walls have their own irrigation systems and are available in two types: passive, which provides water and nutrient delivery; and active, which mechanically circulates air through the wall to improve indoor air quality.

On the higher end, living walls are lush, organic backdrops. Most often you'll see them gracing corporate headquarters and public buildings – but if you really love them, you can bring this concept home, too. Perfect for clean, modern interiors, Amanda says a living wall is like a large art piece and makes a bold design statement: "There's always that fun, wow factor. If you host a dinner party and people come over and they see it, they are like, 'Oh my gosh!' It's a talking piece."

So what's involved? To really thrive, the first thing living walls need is proper planning and installation. Amanda says the process usually starts with an in-home consultation, during which a consultant evaluates your space and available light to determine what artificial light you may need, then discusses your plant and design preferences.

The best time to bring in a consultant, says Adam Holder, sales and client relations manager with Nedlaw Living Walls, is prior to a renovation or new home construction. And once your project has been installed, he reminds homeowners that maintenance is key to the living wall's survival – even with built-in irrigation. As Adam says, "It's a baby; it needs love."

Adam points out that maintenance is one area where homeowners can save a bit on costs. Typically, installations require a monthly maintenance call, where a technician will "maintain the plants, look at the system, check that things are running optimally, prune the plants." But alternatively, Adam says, his company can teach clients how to perform their own maintenance.

To integrate a professionally designed and installed living wall into your space, basic systems start at around \$175 per square foot and more complex ones can reach up to \$300 per square foot, depending on your specific requirements and personal preference.

PLANT CHOICES

When it comes to the fun stuff – choosing plants – for either DIY or high-end routes, Amanda's recommendations lean toward plants that traditionally do well indoors. Tropicals predominate here, she says, adding, "It's almost impossible to kill pothos, ivy, spider plants, snake plants."

TALK TO A PROFESSIONAL

Even if you've chosen the DIY route, Amanda always recommends getting some advice first. "Still reach out and chat with a professional, because there are a lot of new systems coming onto the market... And at the end of the day, there are a few factors that need to go into a living wall to ensure it's going to be successful." **OH**




