My husband and I spent years making rough sketches of our dream home, bookmarking photos, discussing features we admired in other houses, visiting building lots. We had a fairly specific idea of our wants and needs, but the reality of building a custom home seemed out of reach.

When a cottage we purchased as an investment proved structurally unsound, our plans changed and we found ourselves digging through our stack of magazine clippings and feverishly researching details. The cottage had to come down. In its place we'd build the custom home we

While the ins and outs of design decisions and project management would come easily to us, financing a home build was utterly perplexing. With the mortgage we had in place for the cottage, and modest savings, how could we fund the needed construction? Would a lender approve us, a couple with no prior homebuilding experience, to be the general contractor of our own construction?

We were fortunate enough to enlist the help of Treena French, mortgage specialist with RBC, our everyday bank, who answered our questions, quelled our fears and walked us through each step (and there are many).

Yes, we could act as general contractors, as we had gathered and presented detailed cost estimates and drawings. Yes, our financials were sufficient for approval of our small home build. But just how would our construction mortgage operate?

Ours was the most common type, a construction draw mortgage. The first draw was enough to replace our original mortgage and gave us sufficient funds to begin the building process. Then, as work progressed on the house, we made three further draws against our final mortgage amount. Each time we reached a milestone in construction, we contacted Treena, who set the process in motion for the next draw.

That draw process was straightforward. An independent appraiser stopped by to evaluate the percentage of completion, and his report indicated that number to the bank, who released the next set of funds.

Those funds could take anywhere from days to weeks to arrive, during which time contractors required payment. In addition, each draw had its own holdback - a percentage of the funds that are held

CONSTRUCTION MORTGAGES AT-A-GLANCE

COMPLETION

A completion mortgage is one in which the builder receives all funds only after the home is complete - therefore all costs for the build are shouldered by the builder during the construction process. These types of mortgages are more common for homes with fewer customizations, as most lenders require construction to be complete within 120 days in order to lock in your interest rate.

With a completion mortgage, your application is approved before building commences. But, as the mortgage will not be registered in your name until completion, your financial position must remain unchanged during this period. A change in employment, a new car purchase, additional loan, etc., could jeopardize the mortgage of your home.

DRAW

With a draw mortgage, your mortgage is registered before the building process begins. Your builder receives payment throughout the build, via periodic draws on the final mortgage amount. The interest rate is locked in from the initial draw of funds, and you hold the title.

Each time a draw is initiated, an appraiser assesses the progress of the build, and funds are released through a lawyer. As a result of these steps, additional fees can be associated with a draw mortgage. In some cases, a larger down payment may be required up front to purchase land for the project, as well.

Your mortgage specialist will walk you through the details of both options, and help you choose the right plan to suit your needs.

by lawyers until project completion. For these circumstances, we were able to utilize our existing line of credit, which was required for the construction mortgage's approval.

If our line of credit had not been sufficient, or if we were otherwise not a good fit with our bank, where could we have turned for our mortgage? I contacted Gerard Buckley of Mortgage Wellness to gain some insight.

As an independent mortgage agent, Gerard works to match the objectives of his clients with the strengths of his various lenders. In the case of an insufficient line of credit, the right fit might be a lender who offers far more than three or four draws throughout the construction process – perhaps on the order of 25 or 30. Buckley describes these draws as buckets, noting, "Thirty buckets is less precise and gives more flexibility to the homebuilder."

In our case, four buckets was exactly what we required. We hit no snags on the way, only asked a handful of needless questions of our lender, and somehow finished on budget.

I often mention, and speak highly, of the team who built our custom home - the tradespeople who spent weeks and months drilling, sawing and painting. But, although she was never on site, one of the most important players was Treena, our lender. Having an accessible, supportive mortgage specialist was crucial to the success of our build, and we found that finding someone we could trust and with whom we had a comfortable rapport was just as important as choosing tradespeople. on

A recent survey of Canadians who purchased a newly built home shows walk-in closets topped their list of must-have features.

Suprising? Not really says Tim Bailey, division president of Avid Ratings Canada Ltd., a customer satisfaction company that works with Canadian homebuilders to determine what buyers want in a new build.

"The 2018 Canadian Homebuyer Preference Study revealed three themes," Tim says, storage solutions, energy efficiency and kitchen design.

New home buyers across the country are asked to answer 190 questions based on a recent new home purchase. It's the largest survey of its kind in Canada. The result is a comprehensive report by region, buyer type and demographics that Canadian homebuilders can use to plan new housing projects based on consumer wants and needs.

Avid Ratings is currently compiling results for 2019 but Tim doesn't anticipate dramatic changes. There's only been moderate changes in the four years Avid Ratings has been conducting the survey.

Consumers clearly want energy efficiency, Tim says. "But they also want granite and quartz and all the fine features so it's really about trying to strike a balance between what buyers can afford to spend. Energy efficiency is a hot button for consumers, especially with the carbon tax and rising utility costs. Buying a home is one thing but then carrying the cost of that home is another thing."

Homebuyers also want storage, lots of it. "We're a four-season country," Tim explains using his family as an example. "We're a Brady Bunch family with four kids and storage is critical. We have off-season gear, four seasons of clothing and four seasons of sporting goods."

People also want open-concept kitchens with an island. "Quartz countertops and smart home technology score high on the survey as well," Tim says. Other wants include a single-detached home, double-car garages, brick exteriors, tankless water heaters, LED lighting and a main-floor master suite.

What's surprising is the renaissance of the formal dining room. According to the survey, formal dining rooms have increased in importance since year one of the study.

What isn't a priority for new home buyers is outdoor spaces. Tim figures it's because landscaping isn't an immediate concern, it's not part of the purchase and new home buyers have to save and budget for outside projects that happen a couple of years down

The 2018 study found the largest cohort of today's Canadian homebuyer is the growing family with kids followed by single couples with no kids. Millennials have edged out Gen Xers as the largest group of homebuyers.

How does the survey translate for resale homes? Tim believes new homes inspire renovations to older homes and stimulate the resale market. OH





The couple decided their time and money would be better spent renovating what they already owned. "The bones were good," says Rob, "but we needed the house to include our girls." This meant more storage, floors that hide wear and tear, a laundry/mudroom suited to a busy household, and kids' bedrooms that wouldn't be quickly outgrown. The house was in for an overhaul, so the family called in recruits.

"From the very first meeting with **Andy Clairmont**, our contractor, we knew he was the one," says Leah. "He was extremely knowledgeable,

Almost every room in the house got a facelift. And since there were no structural changes, there was no need for city permits. The open-concept kitchen, dining and living room was updated to include a **Chadwicks & Hacks** electric fireplace as the focal point. Since the layout already worked for the family, the kitchen cabinetry was refurbished by **decorrestore** to look bright and airy versus dark and drab. The countertops were topped with quartz from **Elite Granite & Marble**, and a pantry and window seat, built by **The Wright Kitchen**, were added to increase storage space and allow for more seating. 


The Wright Kitchen supplied the cabinetry throughout, including the built-ins in the living room and laundry room. The staircase spindles were stripped and repainted and the stairs topped with a plush but durable runner supplied by **Alexanian Carpet & Flooring**. Area rugs were purchased from **Rugs Bed & Bath Home Decor**, and new furniture came from **Stoney Creek Furniture**. The dated round pillars used to separate the kitchen and living area were changed to square columns with detailed millwork, a feature now loved by the homeowners. 
Geoff Joseph is a man of many talents. He's made his mark in the trucking business, the exotic car biz, and the custom home building industry. So, where does a man who runs successful businesses look for inspiration? He looks up.

When Geoff built his 4,640 square foot Ancaster home in 2017, he had visions of grandeur, all leading skyward. The home set new heights with soaring 21-foot ceilings by V.L. Drywall Services Inc. and massive windows from **Pollard Windows & Doors** – windows that offer a stunning view of the tree-lined backyard. "It's a beautiful neighbourhood," says Geoff. "We're on a quiet court with mature trees, only steps to downtown Ancaster. It's a great place for my kids, Jacob, 10, and Julia, 8, to grow up."

The amazing ceilings are the focal point. The dining room ceiling showcases intricate coffered curves, and to the right, the office boasts 21-inch crown moulding. In the open-concept kitchen and great room, the 21-foot ceilings feature a crisscross of thick coffered moulding with layered details and hotel-size chandeliers. "The ceiling designs were very important to me," says Geoff. "They tell a story, the story of my family." With his designer, Natalie Kurjancic of Interiors By Natalie, the homeowner created the sky-high elements. "The living room ceiling is my absolute favourite," says Natalie. "We came up with the curved diamond pattern to complement the circle motif used throughout the home."

Cynthia Boyer of Cynthia Boyer Interior Designs worked closely with Natalie on the millwork design. Continued on page 48

Because of the ceiling heights, proportion became a top design concern. This included the jewels of the home, the silver lighting provided by **Home Lighting**. Lights were chosen to complement the intricate ceilings while still having a presence of their own. They also complement the glass wine cabinets that separate the bar from the great room. "The bar is one of my favourite features," says Geoff. "I'm not a connoisseur of fine wine, but I love to entertain." The family hosts movie nights on a regular basis, making good use of the cinema room on the lower level.

The floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace and millwork in the living room cover the vast span of walls, largely unadorned to showcase the architectural beauty. The walls are painted Gray Owl (Benjamin Moore), hiding a treasure trove of technology. "The Sounds Good team did a fantastic job on the sound system," says Geoff. "They provided a fully-automated Control 4 platform. It's built into the walls and ceiling, flush to the drywall, then mud over, and is totally invisible." It's not the only technological advancement running through these walls. The whole

house is automated. Almost every room has a control panel capable of adjusting lighting, music, window coverings, security, media, and more – at the touch of a button. Even the **Ashland Heating & Air Conditioning Inc.** fireplaces and heated **Sarana Tile** floors can be manipulated with a fingertip. Ashland Heating & Air outdid themselves, Geoff says, installing a sophisticated two furnace zoning HVAC system.

The kitchen island – over 16-feet long – spans the entire room. It's topped with two massive slabs of Cambria quartz (the nine

washrooms also feature quartz by Cambria). The bar houses a custom sink with a fitted cutting board, and a prep kitchen is hidden behind the bar. **Peter Martin Appliances** supplied all the appliances for the home – including a total of six refrigerators. The dove gray custom cabinetry, built by **Wingers Cabinets** and installed by **Mark Doyle**, are a stunning combination of mirror and curved millwork that mimics the intricate ceiling designs. Wingers was responsible for the cabinetry throughout the entire home, including the custom built-ins designed by the homeowner. *Continued on page 50*

With four bedrooms upstairs, and one bedroom downstairs, there is no doubt this abode was built for family. The master is more apartment than bedroom; boasting its own sitting area with a floating two-way fireplace, a built-in wet bar with an Insinkerator hot water tap and a two-drawer bar fridge, a his-and-hers walk-in closet, and a master en suite fit for a king. "We call it 'the villa'," says Geoff, "because it was designed to feel like a hotel or spa."

While the results are even better than the homeowner envisioned, it wasn't easy to build on a pie shaped lot with mature trees. "The lot was the biggest challenge," says **Rob** Marinic of Prestige Designs, the home's architectural designer. "It's difficult to take advantage of a pie-shaped property without putting the house too far back; so this house is not your typical box design." The garage placement was also integral to the plan. The garage faces inward, maximizing living space closer to the street and allowing for a substantial amount of outdoor living space out back. "I am most proud of the lower level walkout courtyard and the wrap-around back porch," says Rob. "Oh, and the six-car garage."











The landscaping was also a challenge; the swells were difficult to incorporate into the design. City approvals were needed. But everything fell into place and the homeowner and his children have an outdoor space they love, especially the outdoor kitchen. Equipped with a built-in barbecue, an outdoor fireplace and an outdoor television, the family plans to spend an endless number of summer days and nights outside. "I'm a busy man," says Geoff, "so I want quality time with my kids and family. This house makes it happen. We love to sit outside and



Light up the summer night with easy-to-make solar light posts. Storebought solar lights, commonly used on pathways or flower beds, become task lights in a cluster. Use on the deck, around the pool or at the lake.

- Cut post into three lengths measuring 38, 32 and 26 inches each. Your lumber yard can make cuts for a small charge.
- Using a drill paddle, drill a hole 2-inches deep in the top centre of each post for the solar light stem.

PAVLOVA with citrus curd

THIS MERINGUE-BASED DESSERT IS CRISPY ON THE OUTSIDE AND SOFTER INSIDE. CITRUS JUICE AND BERRIES MAKE IT SUMMER FRESH.

Pavlova

INGREDIENTS

4 egg whites

Pinch of salt

1/4 cup cold water

1-1/4 cups sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 tsp vinegar

1 Tbsp + 1 tsp cornstarch

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 300°F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Draw a six-inch circle in the centre on the side of the parchment that will face down. This will be your guide when you shape the pavlova.

Combine egg whites and salt in a stand mixer and beat on medium-high until stiff peaks are formed. Be careful not to over-whip the egg whites at this stage. The egg whites will be thick and foamy and a peak will

form when the beater is lifted out of the egg. Turn the mixer to low and slowly add the water and then the sugar. Turn the mixer back up to medium-high and beat until stiff peaks are again formed. The eggs will be thick and glossy. Remove bowl from mixer and fold in vanilla, vinegar and cornstarch.

Pile the meringue onto the circle on the baking sheet. With a spatula, smooth edges and top of the pavlova so it almost forms a dome. If preferred, create ridges in the side of the pavlova by swiping the sides in an upward motion.

Bake the pavlova for 30 minutes. Do not open oven! Turn oven down to 275°F and bake for another 45 minutes. Let cool completely in the oven for an hour or overnight. It is normal for the pavlova to crack and the centre to sink in.

Remove from oven when cool.

Citrus Curd

INGREDIENTS

4 egg yolks

1/4 cup citrus juice of choice (lemon, blood orange, etc.)

1 tsp citrus zest

⅓ cup sugar

3 Tbsp unsalted butter

DIRECTIONS

Combine all ingredients in a double boiler and heat on medium-high, stirring continuously until mixture thickens and coats the back of a spoon. Strain curd through a fine mesh sieve into a bowl. Cover the top of the curd with plastic wrap directly on the curd and chill until cooled.

GARNISHES

Fresh whipped cream Berries Powdered sugar

ASSEMBLE PAVLOVA

Assemble shortly before serving. Fill the centre of the pavlova with curd, whipped cream and berries. Garnish with mint and powdered sugar. OH






