STAIRCASES GOING UP AND DOWN IN STYLE

Interior Designer **Dolores Pian** shares her ideas.

Staircases are corridors, leading both the eye and visitor from one storey to the next. An important element in the design and function of a home, stairs can make a dramatic or subtle statement.

When planning a new staircase or renovating an old one, it's important to seek a reputable staircase manufacturer who can provide expert advice on types of steps, spindles and handrails, as well as crucial information regarding timing and pricing.

DECISIONS, DECISIONS

Staircase design is based upon your needs and wants, for example:

Architectural style: Gothic Revival, Georgian, craftsman or modern?

Function: utilitarian, statement piece or discreet?

Shape: straight, scissor, open, closed or double (à la *Gone With The Wind*)?

Materials and finishes: wood, glass, iron, metal, painted or carpeted?

SAFETY FIRST MAKE IT STRONG AND MAKE IT SAFE

"Stairs are the most complicated aspect of your home, and your contractor can't make important decisions on-site that could contradict the Ontario Building Code (OBC)," states seasoned contractor Dan Robinson. "Even the smallest change can become a life-safety issue, affecting permit requirements and construction. Hire a professional who can design what you want and help you make important decisions to get your permit."

ALL GOOD THINGS REQUIRE TIME

Whether traditional or modern, all professionals agree: Stair placement and design should be one of the first interior elements considered when planning a project. "It's important



to have a clear, unified vision between all parties: client, builder and homeowner," says Lee Whitaker, President of Barrie Trim & Mouldings. "Make sure all parties involved are all on the same page, trying to achieve the same outcome."

TIPS FROM THE PROS

Ask for shop drawings and 3-D renderings. They're a great way to review your decisions prior to building and installing a staircase.

Beware of falling in love with internet images. Staircase details from other jurisdictions may not follow strict OBC requirements.

OPEN-PLAN LIVING

Minimalist staircases are the eye-catching, sculptural focal point of many interiors. Their seamless design utilizes materials used elsewhere in the home, adding to a spacious feeling. A modern staircase can be the hallmark of a unique home.

To create a sound staircase with minimal structure, customstair professionals prefabricate each component, often using computers to ensure each piece is precisely cut. With the skeleton installed early in construction, all details must be finalized in advance – details cannot be modified on-site.


THE FUTURE OF SPECTACULAR STAIRS

Lighting: LEDs show stairs in their best light, and can be placed on the wall, tread, handrail or riser. To avoid shadows on staircase treads, use a light source with a wide beam.

Varying materials: Mixing metals and metal finishes offers another colour and sensory option for your décor.

Laser-cut balustrade: Any design imaginable can be created for your unique project.

Stairs can be magic. So make them beautiful, one step at a time. on



INGREDIENTS

4 or 5 star anise pods 1/3 cup sugar or honey One orange, sliced

2 cinnamon sticks ½ tsp whole cloves

1 bottle of a bold, full-bodied red wine

GARNISH

Orange slices

Cinnamon sticks

DIRECTIONS

In a medium saucepan, combine sugar or honey, orange slices, cinnamon sticks, cloves and star anise.

Add ½ cup of red wine and simmer over medium heat until flavours are infused and a syrup forms.

Turn heat to low and add the rest of the wine. Gently heat through, being careful not to bring the wine to a boil.

Serve with an orange slice and cinnamon stick. OH

Hamilton. While the home, designed and built by Marcello Alaimo of Exquisite
Living Homes Inc., was still in early stages,
Janet and Jose could see Marcello's vision.
"Architectural design is key," says Marcello.
"I think like a homeowner, so I know how the home will be used for entertaining and living. Everything from location to supplies to finishes and cosmetics has to tie together, so there are no obstacles once the build starts."

Marcello took care of the location, the permits and the design. The electrical was done by AMI. The plumbing was completed by Alamo Plumbing & Drain Specialists Inc., and HVAC was installed by Rennie ClimateCare. Many parts were finished, yet there were plenty of options for the

homeowners-to-be. Janet and Jose suggested adding floor-to-ceiling windows and doors in the open-concept kitchen and living area. They wanted the cosy roofed-in patio warmed by an outdoor fireplace - to feel like part of the interior, bringing more sunlight inside, which carries through the space with the help of white cabinetry and light floors. The Lincoln Design House hardwood flooring was picked to bounce light, but has the added advantage of hiding dust and dirt. The cabinetry was made by **Royal Kitchen Doors & Cabinets**. Also on Marcello's team and integral to the project: Jill Fraser of House of Fraser Decor, and Vincent **Fracassi of Coldwell Banker Community** Professionals, Brokerage. Continued on page 29

When Janet Kovacs, a dentist, and Jose Da Costa, an endodontist, had the opportunity to sell their respective practices in Toronto and begin anew, they jumped on the bandwagon and headed west.

"We're in the stage before retirement," says Janet. "Our kids are independent, but we are still very focused on our careers. We don't have time to travel much, so we wanted a house we love to come home to." The couple's wish list included an open-concept kitchen and living area for after-work lounging and lazy Sunday mornings. They wanted big windows to welcome light. They hoped for a spa-like master bedroom and bathroom that would pamper them at the end of a long day. And they yearned for a backyard oasis that felt like a resort.

The couple found what they were looking for, a 3,000 sq. ft. home under construction in the town of Ancaster, only minutes from

"We love the kitchen," says Janet, "but we cut back on the cabinetry. For us, there was already lots of storage." The couple wanted space for a kitchen island and room for a small dining table. They added a side-by-side built-in Thermador fridge and freezer that disappears into the cabinetry, along with two wall ovens. Janet picked gold hardware for the cupboards and drawers, adding a touch of bling to the traditional white cabinetry. She also chose a beautiful quartz counter and backsplash - now one of her favourite features – because of its timeless elegance. "It will never go out of style," she says. The same stone was used in the butler's pantry. The nook offers additional prep and storage areas while keeping countertop appliances hidden from the main living space.

The fireplace surround in the living room was also treated with the same stone, to tie the areas together. The traditional carpentry blends well with contemporary lighting, and, in combination with the patterned flooring in the main-floor laundry and foyer, (Flooring Warehouse), the overall feel is comfortable yet new.





"Minimalist designs look simple to do," says Danny. "But in fact they are very hard to get right. Everything must be straight, flush and consistent. You see every flaw in a minimalist aesthetic, so it must be perfect." To reach perfection, Danny oversaw every aspect of the build, labouring almost five years over the design. He researched and sourced industry experts and trades. He was his own interior designer – one who knew exactly what he wanted. Danny was the general

contractor along with his brother **Palmo** of **Palm Enterprises**, and was on-site almost every day of the nearly two-year project.

The mostly charcoal, black and white home boasts soaring ceilings on the main level and floor-to-ceiling commercial-grade **Barton Glass Inc.** doors and windows. The windows flood the home with light and offer full views of the courtyard and what will someday be an in-ground pool and tree-lined backyard. "The entire house was designed around the centre

courtyard," says Danny. "It naturally divides the home into two, allowing my parents to have a private in-law suite while sharing the outdoor space and view. It's also a great spot for my daughters, Kiara, 19 and Celene, 16, to gather with their friends. I wanted a home that respected the landscape but was designed to get noticed. But top on my wish list was a home meant for entertaining. There is nothing I love more than to have a house full of friends and family."

"The floors are one of my favourite features," says Danny. "They have almost no visible seams." The engineered hardwood, supplied by **Royal Carpet**, has little grain. The **MPT Stone** concrete floors are crack resistant, easy to clean, warm, and soft to the touch. They stay warm due to the radiant heating within the lower-level floor, which

naturally heats the walls and floors above. Danny finished the floors with several layers of pure white epoxy to carry light.

To complement the flawless floors, Danny used recessed trim. "To do recessed trim right, you have to align the work of the drywall expert, the trim carpenter, and the flooring contractor," says Danny. It's a balancing act and everyone must do their part with utmost precision. It also limited the position of electrical, by Merla Electric Inc., and HVAC, by Sordo's Heating & Air Conditioning. Plumbing fixtures by Emco Corporation also required serious consideration.

The open-concept living, dining and kitchen area features a contrasting play of light and dark. Danny loves to mix white and black with greys and silver. "They are timeless colours that really let the architecture

While the results are exactly what the homeowner envisioned, it wasn't an easy build. City approvals were needed to remove the old home and septic system, and zoning adjustments were required for allowances. "It was heartbreaking to have to pull trees," says Danny. "We tried to work around them, but couldn't." The landscaping will start next spring. "The plan is to replace all the trees and then some."

The low-grade main level was designed with aging parents in mind, eliminating the need for stairs. Danny also wanted a finished lower level with large or full-size windows and an above-standard ceiling height.

"Grading (the land) was a challenge," says Danny. "My brother Palmo had a hard time accommodating a structure built so low to the ground. He worked within the grade, but it took a lot of planning."

While it's true that the devil was in the details of this project, the resulting Stumpo family home – for all three generations – was a slice of heaven. \mbox{OH}

BUTTERNUT SQUASH ROAST

A delicious, meatless twist on a classic holiday dish, this stuffed butternut squash roast is perfect for your next holiday meal – and is sure to please your guests.

INGREDIENTS

1 large butternut squash

Cooking oil

4 cups dried bread, cubed

 $\frac{14}{4}$ cup fresh parsley, chopped $\frac{14}{4}$ cup scallions, chopped

½ cup pine nuts, toasted

2 Tbsp allspice

1 tsp salt

1 tsp pepper

½ cup butter

1 medium white onion, diced

1 cup celery, diced

3 cloves garlic, diced

½-¾ cup vegetable broth

Butchers twine







PREPARE SQUASH

Preheat oven to 400°F.

Slice the butternut squash in half lengthwise and remove seeds.

Place face up on a parchment-lined baking sheet. Drizzle with cooking oil and season to taste with salt and pepper.

Roast for 15-20 minutes, just until the squash is slightly tender. (Do not cook all the way through.)

STUFFING

In a large bowl, combine dried bread, parsley, scallions, pine nuts, allspice, 1 tsp salt and 1 tsp pepper and mix.

In a saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Add onion and celery and sauté until translucent. Add garlic and cook for another minute.

Remove from heat and add to bread mixture, along with ½ cup of vegetable broth.

Mix until combined and bread begins to break down. If the mixture is too dry, add more vegetable broth until the stuffing is wet.

STUFF SQUASH

Remove squash from oven and scoop just enough flesh from the middle of both halves to create a cavity, being careful not to break the skin. (Save scooped squash for another use.)

Fill each half with stuffing and place the squash back together so it looks whole again. Tie with butchers twine.

Decrease oven to 375°F. Cook for about 30 minutes, depending on the size of your squash.

Slice and serve with your favorite cranberry sauce at your next holiday meal! **on**






Add water to a small amount of water-based paint and stir. Apply a thin coat to each tag so the wood grain shows through.

With a pencil, write or stencil your design on the tag and paint over markings.

Glue the tags side-by-side or overlapping each other.

Attach ribbon and hang your tags for a festive welcome. **OH**







A holiday star wreath with mixed metals you can make in minutes.



Materials

18-gauge galvanized wire

Glitter paper or glitter foam (we used gold, silver and white)

Glue gun or bottled glue Length of ribbon or twine, for hanging

Tools

Wire cutters

Scissors

How-to

- Determine the size of the wreath by forming a circle with the wire. Continue to wind the wire, forming between seven and nine circles in various diameters. Leave a tail of wire about two inches long.
- Holding the bundle in one hand, wrap the tail around the wire circles
- Cut pairs of stars from glitter paper or foam in a variety of sizes for the front and back of the wreath.
- Grab a pair of stars and apply glue to one side of each star. Pick a strand of wire, line up stars on each side, then sandwich the wire between the two stars. Repeat, adding stars at random throughout the strands until you love your design.

Tie ribbon or twine at the top of the circle to hang your wreath. OH










Accessorize in Layers


Heavy Fabrics

Heavier textiles are a great addition to the home when temperatures fall. Think velvet, thickset corduroy, faux fur, wool and chunky cable-knit designs. Swap out your lighter bedding and use richer, heavier, textural and weighted sheets, blankets, bedspreads and accent pillows. Consider swapping out your window coverings with the change in seasons, too. While a second set of heavier-fabric drapes is a bit of an additional investment, it'll be worth the spend and the benefits are twofold. You'll create a warmer. cosier look overall in your home, and heavier window coverings can actually help naturally regulate your home's internal temperature, giving your utility bills a break.



Warm Light

Believe it or not, the type of light bulbs you choose has a huge impact on the visual temperature of your space. The neutral option, bright white, is not quite yellow (on the warm side) nor blue (on the cool side). If you wish to warm up the look of your home, simply replace your bright white bulbs with soft white ones, which are a slightly warmer shade and a very popular choice in living rooms and bedrooms, where a cosy ambience is typically preferred. With any kind of light, use dimmer switches – we can't stress this enough! In fact, we recommend putting a dimmer on every light. They're a great way to customize your home's lighting, depending on the season, the occasion or your mood.







In addition to these no-fail solutions to winter's darkness, one of the easiest and cheapest ways to warm up your home is with good old-fashioned candlelight. When the temperatures drop, line your mantels, windowsills, shelves and tabletops with arrangements of glowing pillars and tealights. Place your candles in view of a mirror to double the light and warmth. Let's not forget the obligatory PSA: Be careful to never leave burning candles unattended, or consider high-quality faux battery candles.

With Canada's drastic swings in temperature throughout the year, it only makes sense that our homes adapt in order to provide us with comfort and style. If your objective is to warm up your home, play a word association game for inspiration. To you, warm might be something physical, such as a fireplace stacked with wood, or a woolly blanket rolled up at the foot of the bed. 

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 cup almond flour

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 tsp orange zest

½ tsp salt

Add all-purpose flour, almond flour, vanilla extract, orange zest and salt. Mix until dough is combined and forms a ball.

Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and roll dough into 1-1.5 inch balls.


Bake for 13-15 minutes, or until bottoms are light brown.


