editor's note



A NOTE FROM Oakville Burlington Mississauga

Large lots aren't always feasible (especially in this market!) but making the most of a petite property can be equally challenging.

We live in a subdivision where yards and windows face one another and stepping onto your deck sometimes feels like stepping onto the main stage. Hello neighbours!

We love our backyard oasis and while we don't have room for a pool, we have enough space for a dreamy retreat.

A small space can still be stylish. Here are a few of my favourite tips for creating a backyard haven no matter the size or budget.

- Define your space. A deck off the kitchen is practical because it extends living space, but in close quarters it can feel like a fishbowl. The solution? A retractable awning. It adds shade, provides privacy and acts like an extra room. *Bonus:* It cools down the house.
- 2. Add multi-purpose furniture to entertain without feeling cramped. Instead of a traditional table-and-chairs combo, we went with a large sectional and fireplace table that allows us to eat or lounge outdoors. *Bonus*: It's easy to add or take away pieces when needed.
- 3. Buy or build flexible furnishings. My husband built adorable folding tables that can be tucked away when not in use. *Bonus:* They are easy to find at garden centres or seasonal departments.
- 4. Grow up. No space for a full garden? Grow vertically. My husband built beautiful cedar planter boxes that allow us to grow vegetables, herbs and flowers. *Bonus*: It adds to the view.
- 5. Add night lights. You can hardwire new lighting or use widely available solar options. A few string lights illuminate and add ambience.
- 6. Establish privacy. Tall plantings to the rescue! Column oaks and emerald evergreens are the best investments we've ever made. They create a tall, dense barrier that adds a lot of privacy. *Bonus*: The evergreens look beautiful year-round.

There you have it. A small space doesn't have to equal small style. We can have all the things on our wish list if we get creative.

Designer Tamarisk McNalty Stephens explores the principles of sustainable living.

You're a millennial who has just entered the housing market. Now that you have a place, you need to furnish the space. But how can you make it sustainable and eco-friendly?

Where to begin?

The desire to have a space that feels finished the moment you move in is understandable. However, we must move away from instant gratification and towards playing the long game. The reality is that making environmentally-conscious choices takes time and energy – and that's okay. Plus, curating a space over time will create a finished product that is much more personal and reflective of your unique style.

FURNITURE

One of the easiest and simplest ways to be more sustainable at home is to purchase fewer items.

Before buying, ask yourself: Is this a "need to have" or a "nice to have"?

You can hunt antique markets, local second-hand and vintage shops, estate sales and online e-commerce sites for furnishings. Investing in pre-loved pieces is a great way to contribute to the circular economy.

You can often find high-quality pieces in good shape and for a great price! Antique and vintage pieces provide the opportunity for you to express your style with character, charm and uniqueness that homogeneous,

More product equals more resources – and there's nothing sustainable about utilizing more raw materials and consuming more energy.

Purchase goods that you can envision loving long-term and avoid trends. Buy for style and longevity.

APPLIANCES



manufacturing durable products, utilizing metals that can be easily recycled, restricting hazardous materials during manufacturing and providing a recycling program at the end of the product's useful life.

You can often find second-hand appliances that function perfectly well and are in great shape. Also, peruse the scratch-and-dent section of local stores – you can find qualitymade appliances with minimal aesthetic damage. You can always put a grocery list or piece of art over top of a small scratch on a fridge. If you don't like the colour or finish, research how to paint appliances to suit your desired aesthetic.

Finally, learn how to fix things (or be willing to pay someone who can). The cost of goods has become so affordable that instead of repairing something we replace it. That mentality is simply not sustainable.



ACCESSORIES

Accessorizing your home is where you can let your resourcefulness shine. There are so many second-hand accessories available for you to upcycle, recycle and reimagine. See how creative you can be!

Vintage rugs are worth the investment and no one will have the same one. They have already been around for many years and with proper care they will last for many more. Plus, they are often made of wool and other natural materials and will biodegrade more easily than carpets made from synthetic materials.

Support local artists and artisans by purchasing a unique piece of art for the walls or everyday utilitarian items, such as hand-thrown coffee mugs. Buying local isn't just sustainable, handcrafted items add a different energy to your home.

Another way to instantly accessorize your home is to introduce houseplants – it is one of the simplest and most affordable ways to add texture, interest and colour to a space. **OH**





PONDS

Ponds, streams and waterfalls let you take creativity to the extreme in your landscape design. As these are custom made, you can design anything imaginable, from a cool modern vibe to something Mother Nature designed herself – as long as you have the right budget in place as these can be costly.

Shelves of different depths within a pond interior can be created for certain water plants, as each has its own specific requirements. Shallow areas also act as escape routes in the event a pet or wildlife accidentally falls in.

Ponds need to be at least four feet deep (preferably deeper) if you'd like to overwinter frogs and fish successfully. UV filters

POND MAINTENANCE

Ponds do take work and most need to be shut down in fall and opened in spring, just like a swimming pool. Most of the work happens in spring and mucking out a pond is dirty business. Hip waders help! The rest of the year is much easier, as long as you keep up a good maintenance program. An ideal healthy maintenance schedule requires an occasional filter cleaning, replacing 20 per

cent of the water with fresh water weekly and adding beneficial bacteria when needed. This is even more important for smaller features as their balance gets disrupted easily. The larger the pond, the easier it is to maintain and if it's large enough, it will mostly take care of itself. Don't forget to consider the ongoing electricity and pump/filter replacement costs too.

The best part of including a water feature in your oasis is all the birds and wildlife it will attract! What outdoor retreat would be truly complete without them? он



MUSKOKA **INSPIRED**

According to National Geographic Traveler magazine, Muskoka is one of the world's "must see places." The trend for recreating that laid-back Muskoka vibe in the city shows no sign of letting up. At one time, Peter Giampuzzi, owner of Ornella **Homes**, built maybe one home a year in the Muskoka-inspired style. Today this type of build makes up 80 per cent of his business.

FOR HOMEOWNERS Lorenzo and Lee, the neighbourhood was their priority. "Lee and I have always enjoyed Port Credit and wanted to be within walking distance of restaurants and the waterfront," says Lorenzo. "Although the location is one of our greatest enjoyments, the list of interior and exterior pleasures in our new home is vast."

Their building permit arrived at the same time as the pandemic, then things began shutting down in Ontario. Despite recurring lockdowns, strict on-site safety protocols and frustrating supply chain issues, the couple moved into their home in the summer of 2021.

Inspiration for the organic exterior comes from Frank Lloyd Wright's Prairie-style builds of the 1900s. Peter points out the low roof pitch moving to flat at points, angled walls and exaggerated eaves. "We emphasized horizontal lines," he says. The exterior is covered in Owen Sound limestone, cut in varying lengths for a lovely horizontal flow. Each stone was tooled to a smooth, seamless finish. The tongue-and-groove roof cladding is a weatherproof PVC called Sagpiper made in Portugal. It intersects beautifully with the Iron Ore grey PVC soffits. Continued on page 42






According to Peter, the challenge in designing contemporary and modern homes is the default tendency of greyscale colours, which can create a very cold home. All the wood accents give this house the warmth the homeowners wanted in this family home. "Designing a compact and efficient house that still feels open, airy and spacious is not easy," Peter says. He gives kudos to **Richard** Kossak, owner of New Age Design, for his success pulling all the requirements together so beautifully in the architectural plans, and the homeowners in being so diligent and open minded in their design approach. "Lorenzo and Lee were very organized, they knew what they wanted, and then stepped back to let Richard do what he does best."

Francy Kralik, owner of design firm House Candy, worked closely with Peter, tweaking layouts and detailing millwork, fixtures and finishes. "The goal was fresh


Peter is particularly proud of the "waterfall of oak," a lovely run of panelling that goes from basement to second floor. In the kitchen, fluting was used on the island and range hood. "We have European roots, so the kitchen is the epicentre of our home," Lorenzo says. "The common area that encompasses kitchen and great room encourages terrific family interactions." The pair wanted a traditional kitchen – no lacquered or highly polished finishes; it needed to be warm and inviting for entertaining. The outcome is a lovely blend of natural wood and white. Peter bulked up the range hood, ribbed cabinet doors and millwork and added fluting to the island. The island's panels are push-front cabinets. The island surface is white quartz. Tiles throughout were sourced from **Ciot**.


Walls of windows were common in Prairie houses. Frank Lloyd Wright designed for minimal separation between interiors and the natural world outside. The windows in this great room are floor-to-ceiling. Each window weighs about 1,200 pounds. They were installed by **Ostaco Windows and Doors.** Lorenzo and Lee put a great deal of thought into their backyard – one of the home's most impressive features. The great room's expanse of glass showcases its beautiful symmetry.





Lorenzo calls the lower level the home's interior playground. BERRY COBBLER

RECIPE AND PHOTOGRAPHY JENELLE MCCULLOCH

This cobbler is reminiscent of a sweet, soft southern-style drop biscuit. You can use whatever summer fruit you have on hand. We used blueberries and blackberries.

INGREDIENTS (Serves 6)

FILLING

- 4 cups blueberries and blackberries*
- 1 Tbsp flour
- 1 Tbsp granulated sugar

COBBLER TOPPING

2 cups flour
½ cup granulated sugar
½ cup brown sugar
2 Tbsp baking powder
3 tsp ground cinnamon
1 stick butter, cold

1/4 - 1/2 cup boiling water

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350°F.

In a baking dish, combine all filling ingredients and set aside.

For the topping, combine flour, sugars, baking powder and cinnamon in a bowl. With a pastry cutter or two knives, cut butter into dry ingredients until the mixture resembles wet sand. Stir in 1/4 cup of boiling water and stir until combined (add in more water - 1 Tbsp at a time, if needed, to achieve a drop biscuit texture).

Spoon the topping over the berries. Don't worry about the topping covering the whole dish, it will spread as it bakes!

Bake for 30-45 minutes* until golden brown.

Notes:

*Feel free to substitute any berries or fruit.

*Adjust baking time depending on size of the pan. If using a smaller pan and the topping is thicker add 5-10 minutes to baking time. **OH**

A OLD SCHOOL MADE NEW

"I LOVE THE NEIGHBOURHOOD'S historical buildings and how the facade of this old school was preserved to blend with new, modern elements," says the homeowner – a doctor who moved from New York for a position at McMaster Hospital. The area's walkable streets filled with restaurants and shops remind her of her years thriving off the energy of Manhattan.

"Working with **Eva Healy** and her design team, **Rachel Subic** and **Brianna** Didone, was fantastic," says the homeowner. "They helped me understand what I wanted, what I like and didn't like. They brought my vision to life while adding creative elements that made the 1,600 sq. ft. space fit my lifestyle."






Making the open-concept condo cohesive while anchoring each living area was not an easy task. "Most condos are boxes with no character," says Eva. "But this owner wanted a combination of modern comforts, the character of an old building and the industrial vibe she was used to in New York." Eva created unique hubs while designing the tiling, cabinetry, millwork and hardware to flow from room to room.

The homeowner relocated with very little furniture, giving the design team a blank slate to work with. Eva and Brianna (who did all the decorating) picked the furniture and décor from local and online sources, keeping a young, professional palette in mind. Original photography of New York skylines and sites made the office a familiar spot to work in when homebound. Venetian plaster was used to replicate concrete on the living room wall, complete with imperfections and dings, offering an industrial feel with dimension.

Eva added a pop of colour on the dining room side with a blue wallpaper mural that softens and complements the harder lines of the industrial-look shelving and lighting. "I love the mural walls," says the homeowner enthusiastically. "They were inspired by the artwork of a New York ink artist I adore." They also add a modern splash of colour to the otherwise neutral white walls (Benjamin Moore Chantilly Lace) and simple, clean lines of the contemporary cabinetry by Impressions Kitchens. The kitchen was designed by Rachel (who also designed the bathrooms) with ample storage for appliances and supplies. "I love to cook when I'm home," says the homeowner, who put a well-appointed kitchen at the top of her must-have list. Plumbing couldn't be moved since the unit is a condo, so they built up, adding cabinetry and shelving within typically unused space closer to the ceiling. "High cabinets are great for storing kitchen stuff not used every day," says Eva. Another design favourite is the waterfall island and countertops provided by **Stone Galleria**. State-of-the-art appliances purchased from **Caplan's Appliances** and classic white window coverings complete the look.

The hardwood floors and layout were the only interior elements remaining after **Fabio Melo** and his associates at **Kaza Contracting** gutted the two-bedroom, two-bathroom condo to start anew. As the project manager and general contractor, Fabio was hands-on from demolition to completion. "The designers and homeowner showed me drawings and pictures of what they wanted," says Fabio, "and we brought to life what they presented on paper. Nothing was typical builder style – everything they had in mind offered a unique perspective." The main living area's concrete wall adds texture to the

open space and tiles mimicking white brick honour the classic supplies used to build the old schoolhouse. Reclaimed wood was used to line the deep windows, tying the interior to the exterior, and **Loft Doors** provided visually unique doors. Mitred hexagon tiles contribute an eye-catching backdrop to the kitchen and bathrooms.

The comfortable primary bedroom and spa-like en suite are perfect spots to unwind. "I work long hours at the hospital, so it's important I have a place I can relax after hours," says the homeowner. Subtle colours and clean lines are just what the doctor ordered. Interesting tile patterns draw the eye. The double sink vanity, mirrors and built-in shelving create a functional and striking space. *Continued on page* 62



WAIVING CONDITIONS

IT REMAINS A SELLER'S MARKET ACROSS ONTARIO WHERE HOME PRICES CONTINUE TO RISE AND INVENTORY REMAINS LOW.

RE/MAX Canada expects a 9.2 per cent increase in average residential sale prices across Canada this year. In Ontario, relocating from one region to another continues to drive housing activity. City dwellers are cashing in and moving to more scenic areas, where their purchasing power gets them a house that suits their preferred lifestyle. With mortgage rates expected to creep up, demand for homes far outstrips supply, leaving house hunters facing multiple offers for the home they want.

So, what's a buyer to do? They could do what home sellers find irresistible – waive all conditions and warranties.

Laura and Chris Walker weren't fooling around when they finally found their ideal condo in Collingwood.

"We had been looking on and off but when the pandemic hit we got serious," says Laura. "When this three-bedroom at Lighthouse Point came up we jumped on it." The couple had lost out on other properties and vowed not to let this one slip away. They went in with a clear offer with no conditions or warranties and a two-week closing. "They were not taking offers until the following Monday and we didn't want to wait and lose it," she says. "So we put in a bully offer over asking. They came back once and that was it - bought and sold." The condo was fully renovated and they've had no issues.

Waiving conditions and warranties in residential real estate transactions is the new winning strategy for many homebuyers. But

it's not for the faint of heart or those without the means to cover costs if there's an issue with the property or home.

Typical conditions in a purchase and sale agreement include financing, property inspections, state of title, legal review and appraisal. Buyers can add their own conditions and condo owners generally add a request and review of the status certificate, which ensures the condo corporation and its board are stable.

But the current housing market is anything but typical and buyers are increasingly willing to take risks to win the home they covet.

Dr. Parham Davoudpour, an attending emergency physician in Toronto, is suffering from buyer fatigue after waiving conditions and still losing two bids on homes in the Collingwood area.

"Both homes were sold substantially higher than asking price – over 50 per cent higher than asking," he says. "One of my offers was 45 per cent over asking and I still lost. "I call these high-risk transactions because you're pressured to make a decision that involves a lot of money and you don't have enough time for due diligence. It's literally like working in a hospital emergency department where you are always under pressure and you make decisions on the limited amount of information that you have."

Parham is still looking but his experience has left him less motivated.

David Oikle, president of The Ontario

Real Estate Association, blames supply and demand for the current state of housing in the province. "We're in this pickle that buyers are competing in such a way because we don't have enough homes to buy," David explains. "OREA's been spending a ton of time advocating for increasing supply at the municipal, provincial and federal levels. There isn't enough product to buy and we need to address that."

Janine (she didn't want us to use her full name) and her husband looked at eight homes in The Blue Mountains last year. "We lost out on two because our bids just weren't high enough," she says. They waived conditions in both bids, but it didn't help. "It was just a crap shoot," she says. "For one of them, there were about 13 offers. The vendors came back to us, told us they wanted to look at the top three bids 'so give us your very best offer.' We did and we lost out by \$1,000." They finally found and won a home they moved into last May, again waiving conditions and warranties. In hindsight, Janine says she wishes she had more time to investigate the planned developments on wetlands around them. "We love the neighbourhood, we love the house but the main issue now is the development that is supposed to go in beside us. I knew about the potential development, but I honestly thought our government would protect the environment, safety of citizens and our homes. I was wrong."

David says the key to a happy purchase is education, risk management and knowing your limits. He says a local realtor can help buyers mitigate risks. **он**

About eight

years ago, when **DeSantis Homes** built Fiorella and Adam Kuczma's new home, this budding family wanted roots. They knew the house would need to grow and change with their family's needs. And it's been the perfect work in progress ever since.



decorating



A black-and-white interior is probably the most versatile decorating option. This clean and classic palette is one of my favourites, both as a homeowner and as a trendspotter by trade. A black-and-white motif is a chameleon of sorts, easily adaptable to a variety of periods and styles, from vintage to contemporary and all styles in between. Black plus white is more than just a colour scheme; it's a bold decorating category all its own. Here are some

ideas on implementing a black-and-white interior successfully.

MULTI-DIMENSIONAL

Black and white are the ultimate neutrals and they offer a good dose of drama when the look is done correctly. This palette allows you to effortlessly transition from one look to the next, room to room, all while maintaining a cohesive aesthetic throughout. On the other hand, this look can fall flat if poorly executed.

Similar to the principles of layering texture and pattern, add variety to your whites by layering in some off-whites, too. Technically, this trick applies to black, too (picture a charcoal shade set alongside jet black) although a white colour palette is much more common. However, when doing this, be sure to stay within the same colour temperature. By this, I mean if your predominant white leans to the warm side of the spectrum (yellowish) stick with warm tones for your other whites, too. Breaking this rule can make some "cool" whites in your space appear blue.

When it comes to black, you might think you only have one choice. However, black also comes in many different shades, ranging from midnight blue-black and charcoal to warm licorice. Apply the same principles when it comes to temperature.

Dimension is also achieved through texture and finish. Different finishes absorb and reflect light to different degrees. For example, a high-gloss varnish or paint, glass and polished chrome have high reflective qualities, bringing light and shine to a room. On the other hand, matte paints, sheen-less fabrics (think velvet!) and natural materials such as wood and stone tend to pull light in, creating a cocooning effect. Layer these within your bi-colour room to create interest and depth. Continued on page 98




HOW TO "DO" BLACK & WHITE

As you would with any other colour scheme, choose your principal colour and in this case, you have two options. If white will be your main colour (as it is in most black-and-white interiors), you'll be using black as your secondary colour and vice versa.

As a designer, I often use the 60-30-10 rule for colour distribution. The principal colour occupies the majority for 60 per cent of the visual area of your space. This typically includes your walls and floors (in terms of a black-and-white palette, think light versus dark hardwood). The secondary colour accounts for 30 per cent of the space, such as a feature wall, rug and sofa. The final 10 per cent is reserved for your accent colour - and remember. even a black-and-white room can benefit from some bold pops of trending green, magenta or blue.

When choosing your accent colour, execute it in your accessories. This can include art, accent pillows, throws and




even small furniture items, like an ottoman or painted side table. One of the benefits of the black-and-white aesthetic is the ability to transition between trends on a dime. Since accessories are easy and economical to replace and trends come and go, this is a great way to express yourself and push your style limits.

There's a good reason the black-and-white look keeps resurfacing in our homes, in every room. These polar ends of the colour spectrum deliver drama and excitement, with a timeless appeal. I guess it's true, opposites really do attract! он

easy INDOOR TOPIARY

Bring the outdoors in with greenery and natural elements. This DIY topiary is easy to make and will add an organic feel to your space.

MATERIALS

Sand texture Plastic container Plant pot White and brown acrylic paint Paintbrush Dowel Glue gun Moss Syrofoam ball Small knife Foam block Jute twine

STEP 1

First, pour some sand texture into a container – this will add a rustic feel to the plant pot. Next, pour a small amount of paint into the sand texture and mix to a peanut butter consistency. Paint the whole pot and let it dry for approximately 45 minutes. Once dry, apply another coat of paint.

STEP 2

Use a small paintbrush and paint the dowel brown. Set aside and let dry.



STEP 3

With a glue gun, glue moss to the styrofoam ball. Continue this step until the ball is completely covered in moss.



STEP 4

Make a hole in the bottom of the moss ball. Add glue to the end of the dowel and poke it into the moss ball.



STEP 5

Use a knife to cut the edges of the foam block to fit in the pot. Then take the bottom of the dowel and place it into the foam in the centre of the pot.



STEP 6

Add some moss to cover the foam block and tie some jute twine around the pot.



Find a spot in your home or create a second spring topiary to place near a mirror or artwork on a mantel and bring that spring feeling into your home! **OH**







advantage of the size of the lot, which is almost 380 feet deep."



RISOTTO ISN'T JUST FOR COLDER SEASONS. THIS RECIPE BRIGHTENS UP TRADITIONAL RISOTTO JUST IN TIME FOR WARMER WEATHER!



INGREDIENTS (Serves 4)

1 bunch asparagus 6 cups vegetable or chicken stock 2 Tbsp olive oil 1 shallot, finely diced 2 cloves garlic, finely diced 1 tsp fresh thyme 1 ¹/₂ cups Arborio rice ¹/₂ cup dry white wine 1 cup grated parmesan, plus more for serving Zest of one lemon

INSTRUCTIONS

Clean asparagus and steam or sauté until tender. Set aside.

In a large pot, bring stock to a simmer. Once heated, remove from heat and keep nearby.

In a large saucepan or pot, add olive oil and cook shallot until translucent. Add garlic and thyme and sauté for 1 minute before adding Arborio rice. Season with salt and pepper and toast the rice for 1-2 minutes.

Add white wine and cook until absorbed, stirring occasionally.

Add 1 cup of stock at a time, stirring continuously until each addition of broth is absorbed. Continue until rice is al dente.

Add parmesan cheese and asparagus to the risotto. Garnish with lemon zest, serve and enjoy! **OH**
