



TIP #7: Extra lighting. Dorm rooms can look cold. An extra lamp or two helps personalize and adds much needed ambience.


TIP #8: A mini fridge. It's a great way to store drinks, snacks and homemade meals cooked with love.



COOL HOUSE

You may be fortunate enough to have air conditioning in your home, but did you know that there are some practical ways to help minimize your dependency on the AC? Read on for ideas that are good for the environment – and your pocketbook!



Ceiling fans should turn counterclockwise in the warmer months as this creates a downdraft. The effect of moving air hitting the sweat on your skin is known as evaporative cooling. As sweat evaporates, it helps lower your overall body temperature. Thus, you can keep the thermostat turned up a few degrees and still stay cool. High-quality ceiling fans are worth the investment because they are often much quieter while providing powerful airflow.

PAINT

If you have a room that gets a lot of southern exposure in the warmest months of the year, keep the paint light and airy. Dark colours can absorb the sun's radiant energy and that energy creates unnecessary heat gain.

BEDDING

An important consideration in the summertime is optimizing comfort levels in the bedroom. In addition to keeping the room cool (65°F is considered optimal for sleeping), another element that can greatly impact body temperature is the material of your mattress, pillows and bed linens. Natural materials are preferred over synthetics because of their ability to breathe. Some

synthetic materials (including most memory foam mattresses) are very dense and tend to trap body heat. Ensure your bed frame allows for proper airflow around your mattress. Consider a mattress topper made from natural material such as latex, wool or cotton. Select bedding that is natural and breathable - such as linen. Use a lighter duvet in the summer months made with natural down or wool filling. These will help keep you cool as they allow moisture to escape. A shredded latex pillow with a cotton or linen cover is a good combination to help keep your head cool. Latex is a naturally breathable material and when shredded, provides improved airflow.







Porcelain or natural stone tiles generally provide cooler

temperatures in the summer (look to Mediterranean architecture) that is, if not continuously exposed to direct sunlight. Natural stone floors and porcelain tiles will hold heat, which is why they are often successfully paired with radiant heating options to warm up spaces in the colder months. Again, consider selecting lightercoloured flooring in rooms that get direct sun exposure.

WINDOWS

If you are in the market for

replacing windows, get the most energy-efficient windows you can afford. Spend some time with a professional to review the various frame, glazing and operation options. To minimize solar heat gain and reduce energy loss, you may require different energy efficiency ratings depending upon the exposure/orientation of various windows within your home and the overall ratio of window glazing to walls. A professional can also make recommendations on the operation styles and how the layout can optimize the breeze available from cool air entering through lower window openings, travelling through the house and the warmed air exiting at a higher location. Close windows first thing in the morning and open them up once the outside temperature has dropped in the evening.





WINDOW TREATMENTS

Window treatments are an excellent way to keep the cooling bill in check by controlling solar heat gain (while also adding an element of design). Blackout drapery is the most effective at preventing the sun from entering a room and offers a great solution for the sunniest times of day for south/west facing windows (specifically bedrooms). Solar shades provide various degrees of privacy, light penetration and heat transfer - all while offering a view to the outside.

LANDSCAPING

Landscaping outdoors can also help to keep the inside of your home cooler. Planting deciduous trees, shrubs and tall grasses can provide shade that will help mitigate solar gain in the summer months.

APPLIANCES

Practical day-to-day tips include firing up the outdoor grill instead of using the oven, installing a clothesline for drying and waiting to use the dishwasher until temperatures dip in the evening. Also remember to turn on exhaust fans in the bathroom when taking a shower to remove hot, humid air. OH

A recent Mississauga project by **David Small** of **David Small Designs** and builders Joel Atkinson and Mike Murray of **Profile Custom Homes** demonstrates how beautifully a modern build can fit into the landscape.


With a frontage of 100 feet, the goal was to maximize width to create a strong street presence and minimize depth to allow natural light to reach the centre of the home. The positioning of the home preserved the mature trees that border the property and accommodated a U-shaped driveway, a priority item on the homeowners' wish list.

The 5,700 sq. ft. home is an ubermodern design juxtaposed against its traditional neighbours. To help assimilate the home to its surroundings, the variation in roof height downplays the overall height to create a dynamic facade.

Homeowners Marian and Joseph Noora mixed the modern aesthetic with timeless finishes and features by using raw materials. The natural limestone and shou sugi ban wood highlight the tones in the surrounding landscape, adding warmth to the exterior design. A 10-foot tall front door clad in charred wood is nestled between windows to minimize unnecessary borders for a seamless look. The vast expanse of glass, often a privacy concern, is concealed with a unique stone landscape wall that blocks the view to pedestrians but preserves the natural light. "The home is incredibly energy-efficient and was designed in a way to provide the utmost privacy even without the use of window coverings," says Marian.

Indoors, clean crisp lines and an open living space reflect the lifestyle of an active family of five. With three young children and plenty of hosting, it was important to have an openconcept kitchen connected to a casual living space. The layout was designed to incorporate a 20-foot island with a 48-inch cooktop and sixfoot-long sink that converts to a slip-in salad bar, a hit on taco nights or for poke bowl lunches. Rift-cut white oak cabinetry runs the full length of the kitchen and incorporates pocket doors for easy access to the coffee station, liqueur cabinet and appliances. Corian countertops are

beautiful and resilient, perfect for a family with

The family also wanted some formality in the space. Soaring 23-foot ceilings and floor-toceiling glass create a spectacular entry. A modern black fireplace, a cantilevered staircase and a modern glass bridge add architectural detail.

"One of the first features we discussed with David Small Designs was a two-storey woodburning fireplace that would suspend from the ceiling," says Marian. "David brilliantly worked around this first wish to make sure it could be seen through the glass from the front entrance."



Radiant floor heating allowed for the use of concrete flooring on the


main and lower levels. A white polished overlay was added to the main floor.



Blue is thought to be a cool colour and it often is - but not always. Cool blues have green undertones, while warm blues have purple ones, such as denim or slate, which boast earthy, organic characteristics and are subtly warm. The "temperature" of your blue can dramatically impact the overall ambience of the room.

A warm blue is the perfect choice for cosy spaces, such as a living room, family room or den, giving some wonderful depth and drama. These shades of blue have a warmth and intimacy to them, which are conducive to the intimate activities taking place in these areas of the home. Depending on the desired atmosphere in your space, consider a moody, navy blue.

Meanwhile, on the cool side of the colour spectrum, you'll find greenish blues, such as aquamarine, HOW TO "DO" BLUE

That all depends on your space, your intended vibe and the blue you'll be using. But generally speaking, if blue is your dominant colour in the space, chances are it is a lighter, paler shade. In this case, blue acts as your backdrop, which you'll liven up with a

secondary colour and accent colour. Refer to the 60-30-10 rule when playing with colour proportion: 60 per cent of the space is reserved for the dominant hue, 30 per cent for the secondary and 10 per cent for the accent, which is usually a bolder choice.

THIS CUSTOM BUILD IN COPETOWN – LOVINGLY DUBBED THE RANCH BY THOSE WHO GATHER UNDER ITS SOARING TIMBER BEAMS – IS INCREDIBLE.

It was recently built from the ground up by $\mbox{\bf Rick\ Wiersma}$ and Braden Lomanto of Precise Projects Inc. "We are a family of builders," says Rick. "The business started in 2006 and we learned a lot doing smaller projects before tackling a project of this magnitude." The 8,020 sq. ft. ranch stands regally on acres surrounded by

conservation land, farms and golf clubs, yet is only 10 minutes from downtown Dundas. When homeowners David and Siobhan purchased the property 40 years ago, they hoped to someday renovate the existing farmhouse. But when the couple decided it was time to move back from out west to be closer to their family, the pieces didn't fit. Continued on page 47





"We wanted a house reminiscent of the post-and-beam ranch designs we had, and saw, in Montana," says David. "Yet the cost of renovating the old farmhouse was so high that building a new house made more sense." Even the conservation authority preferred the original house be torn down and a new house built further into the lot, away from protected land. "We had no doubt Rick and Braden were the right guys for the job," says David. "We could tell them what we wanted, show them pictures, then let their creativity run wild."

Following the tree-lined driveway to the main house, the spectacular timber beams that support the house's frame stand out. Rick and Braden turned to PineRidge Timberframe **Inc.**, a company with extensive experience designing, supplying and installing timber to create rustic, ranch-style homes. The timber framing carries throughout the interior, drawing the eye upward in the open-concept great room and eat-in kitchen. "The great room is spectacular," says Braden. "We used structural timber and tongue-and-groove pine to create a focalpoint ceiling centred by a massive hand-forged chandelier."

Like the endless rows of windows, everything needed to be large-scale to work with the timber framing and soaring rooflines, including the lighting. The massive fireplace and the floor-to-ceiling stone surround add texture and warmth. Varied widths of European white oak engineered hardwood run the majority of the main level, while marbled tile flooring (Bert Vis **Flooring**) was used in the bathrooms and laundry room.

In the open-style kitchen (**Kitchens for Keeps**), white cabinetry and a brick pattern porcelain backsplash offer a simple yet elegant backdrop to the stunning hand-forged hood. "The hood was designed and built by a local blacksmith," explains Rick. "The finish mimics the antique copper farm sinks and copper island lights."

The II-foot stained oak kitchen island is topped with chiseled-edge Charlestown Cambria quartz, and the perimeter countertops are white Colton Cambria quartz (Quartz Co.). Set in behind the main kitchen, a large

butler's pantry provides more storage and counter space (great when entertaining) and room for a coffee bar that doesn't clutter the main kitchen area.

Every detail took considerable planning, resulting in a truly beautiful, rustic masterpiece. The many trades involved were handpicked for their expertise. The talents of interior decorators **Andrea Kluczenko** of **Gracewood Homes** and **Jaclyn Harper** of **Harper Designs** were integral to the artistry of the finished home. **Adanac Rubber Flooring** installed the gym floor.

With three bedrooms on the main level and two below, David and Siobhan look forward to entertaining guests. Sliding barn doors in the primary bedroom separate spacious dual closets and a reading area opens onto the back patio. "I love this suite," says the homeowner, "but the tub was hell to get inside." Made of cast stone, the free-standing tub weighs in at 500 pounds. (It echoes the stone sinks in the powder rooms, hand carved from rocks found in the area.) Timber features were added to the main bedroom surrounding the en suite tub and reading area.

The timber roofline extends out back from the kitchen so nature can be enjoyed with the comforts of home. "We love having everyone lounge on the back porch," says David. Siding, soffit and fascia by **Precision Exteriors**. The exterior walls and fireplace consist of full-bed stones and the wood-burning fireplace boasts a reclaimed barn beam mantel. An inground hot tub is steps away. Flatwork by Complete Holmes Construction. Continued on page 52

WHEN DESIGNER ODETTE DE LUCIA BOUGHT HER WEST OAKVILLE HOME IN 2001, SHE WAS STUDYING INTERIOR DESIGN. SHE KNEW THE DETACHED TWO-STOREY BUILDER HOME HAD POTENTIAL, BUT IT WAS A BLANK SLATE IN TERMS OF DESIGN AND DECOR.

Rather than overhauling the home all at once, the young family decided to take their time with renovations, spreading out the cost and inconvenience by changing the functionality and design as her family's needs changed.

"We didn't mind waiting," Odette recalls. "We took our time, and in the end the home is exactly what I wanted, represents my style and design philosophy and is the perfect space for us."

The renovations over 20 years tell the story of a growing family and a designer – used to catering to the tastes of others – becoming true to her own preferences.

The first task was turning bland yellow walls into a showpiece. She added panelling to create a three-dimensional focal point that exudes depth. Painted a simple white, the walls are subtle but provide a bold geometric pattern that Odette carries throughout the home in different ways and adds a formality that wasn't reflected in the design before

"Panelling and wainscotting never go out of style," Odette says. "It

was the first step for me to take this subdivision home and turn it into something that felt much more custom."

The main floor was the next project. With the help of **Goran Krsikapa** of **G Custom Homes**, a dated kitchen and living room were redesigned to maximize light and space. Odette wanted to ensure that everything looked relative to the dramatic, two-storey ceilings in the living room. She chose a neutral palette of whites and creams. Dark charcoal velvet drapes frame a wall of floor-to-ceiling windows. A new limestone fireplace is much more inviting and works with the height of the room much better than the builder fireplace that came before it.

"As a designer, I'm quite adept at designing with lots of colour," says Odette. "However, I knew that for my own space, I wanted a very relaxing colour scheme that was soothing." Despite the serene palette, Odette doesn't dismiss colour completely. She adds colourful surprises with a blush throw cushion and fresh florals.

A large gold chandelier from Restoration Hardware sets the tone for all of the warm gold accents used throughout the home. "Gold is so

warm and inviting," she says. The area rug by Stark Carpet in the living room draws the eye with its bold geographic black-and-grey pattern, a nod to the wall panelling.

Odette admits that the original kitchen boasted quality and craftsmanship, so instead of stripping it completely, she chose to work with the existing cabinetry. "Like many builder homes, the cabinets didn't extend to the ceiling, and there was a gap, making them look unfinished," she says. "Instead of adding an upper row of cabinetry, I decided to just enclose the gap with moulding."

The maple cabinets were refinished in **Benjamin Moore** Floral White. The metal range hood was replaced with a custom hood to match the cabinetry. The addition of glass inserts provides a custom look.

Odette wanted an island, but with a small kitchen footprint, an island would restrict the space. Instead, she designed a counter-height table and topped it with quartz to achieve the look and feel of an island. A banquette seat provides a functional work and eating area. Continued on page 80



Working with the existing kitchen cabinets was a wonderfully sustainable way to achieve a custom look with a few tweaks. Taking the cabinetry to the ceiling created a seamless look and painting and adding glass panels gives the cabinetry a custom feel. Stone countertops and a custom table that doubles as an island elevate the aesthetic and add function.

As the family grew, Odette wanted an outdoor oasis where the children could lounge with friends. She longed for a backyard renovation that exuded California style but didn't realize that achieving the soft, clean look of white concrete walkways and coping around the pool would be hard to come by. Sand in Ontario is grey, making grey concrete the standard. After thorough digging, she came across **Castle Precast** Ltd., which was working on the restoration of Toronto's Casa Loma. They special-ordered and imported white sand for the project.

The walkway around the rectangular pool by Gib-San Pool & Landscape Creations is surrounded by a premium artificial turf. "It's great! No maintenance!" Odette says. "All artificial turf is not created equal, however. I spent some time looking for turf that looked and felt realistic." A pergola, built by her handy husband, houses a daybed and provides shade in the otherwise sunny backyard. White hydrangeas bloom all summer long.

The children – Alex, Laura, and Ben – would need space to grow and to accommodate their regular flow of friends. The house had to meet the family's needs today and tomorrow. Their long-term plan turned into a whole-home renovation after discovering significant concerns.



finished in October 2021. Every room in this 1960s four-bedroom, two-storey house got a major facelift. Even the lower level was they wanted," says Brad. "We stripped the interior to nothing and started from zero."



The electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems were pulled and replaced with smart, energy-efficient alternatives. "The house was insulated poorly," says Brad, "and seasons weren't comfortable." A KeepRite dual-zone HVAC system and a steam humidifier were installed, which help keep humidity levels constant in the house. **EMCO Corp.** provided the plumbing fixtures throughout the home. The electrical system includes two Eaton Panels that divide the power needs in the house if there is a blackout - a common issue in the area. The primary 200-amp panel runs the must-have needs of the home on a daily basis and the secondary panel runs a generator should the need arise from a power outage.



The homeowners adore the open riser, open stringer floating oak staircase connecting all three levels of the house. "Brad removed a wall so the backyard and trees can be seen through the stairway," says Chris, "and when you stand in the basement, you can see all the way to the top floor ceiling with recessed lighting. The kids love dropping little green army men with parachutes from the top of the open stairway." The stairway was done by **Lennox Stairs & Wood** Floors. Recessed lighting was used around the perimeter of several rooms in the house, offering a soft alternative to pot lights.

The limestone fireplace in the sunken living room is another of the homeowners' favourites. "A backyard tree was hit by lightning, splitting the main trunk," says Chris, "so we had the wood made into a mantel for the fireplace." The gas fireplaces were supplied and installed by **Distinctive Fires**.

A live-edge waterfall table from **Dhimarko Inc.** built off the kitchen island was cut from massive cherry slabs sourced locally. "We love bringing nature indoors," says Sara. They renovated using reclaimed wood, beams, organics and live edges, striving to support local vendors and trades when possible. Continued on page 100







Brownie

INGREDIENTS

1 cup cocoa powder

1 cup all-purpose flour

34 tsp baking powder

1 tsp salt

1 cup unsalted butter, melted

2 cups granulated sugar

3 eggs, room temperature

1 tsp vanilla extract



INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat the oven to 350°F and line two 9x9-inch square pans with parchment paper.

In a medium bowl combine cocoa powder, all-purpose flour, baking powder and salt. Mix thoroughly and

In a large mixing bowl, combine melted butter and sugar. Whisk until combined. Whisk in eggs and vanilla extract. Fold in dry ingredients until just combined.

Split the brownie mixture between the two pans (about 2 cups of batter in each pan). The batter will be thick.

Take a piece of parchment paper and place it on top of the batter. Press the parchment into the batter to flatten the batter (this will help the batter bake evenly). Bake for 15 minutes.

Remove from oven, let cool and place in freezer until ready to use.



INGREDIENTS

1 ½ cups whipping cream

1 tsp vanilla

1 can (300ml) sweetened condensed milk

½ cup Dulce de Leche

INSTRUCTIONS

In the large bowl of a stand mixer or using a hand mixer, whip the cream until thick and fluffy. Add vanilla and continue to beat until stiff peaks form. Fold in the sweetened condensed milk.



Remove whole brownie from one pan.

Spread the filling evenly on top of the brownie still in the second pan.

Drizzle Dulce de Leche on top and swirl into the filling.

Place the other brownie on top and gently press down.

Freeze for approximately 6 hours.

Cut into rectangles and keep frozen until ready to eat. OH
