### Classic FURNITURE

PIECES YOUR KIDS WILL ACTUALLY WANT TO INHERIT. WHAT MAKES A CLASSIC PIECE OF FURNITURE?

Are you downsizing, rightsizing and considering selling or giving away your furniture? The reality is that some people don't want your "old stuff" no matter how much money you spent on it.

The more modest Thonet Coffee House Chair can still be seen in French bistro cafés. Good design lasts forever.



### Where Have You Seen Famous 20th Century Furniture Icons?

Modern furniture from the 1920s to 1940s and Mid-century Modern from 1933 to 1965 is widely popularized. We see pieces in architectural design magazines or celebrity interviews in the pages of *GQ* and *Vogue*. Cultural institutions such as New York's Museum of Modern Art and London's Victoria & Albert Museum have large exhibits displaying the perfect examples of modern-day aesthetics and good taste.

Also, popular television shows have embedded many of these pieces in our modern psyche. Notable examples include Breuer's Cantilever Chair and the Barcelona Chair by Ludwig Mies van der Rohe, both on display in *Mad Men's* stylish offices and lobbies. Who could forget the Mid-century modern Eames Lounge Chair in *Frasier's* sleek modern apartment, elegant and separate from his father's old recliner?

### Why Are They Valuable?

Modern furniture is mobile and lightweight, designed for city residents in smaller urban homes. It's relevant for today's interiors, ensuring these pieces will keep their inheritance value for a very long time.

Manufacturers such as Knoll and Herman Miller employed Charles and Ray Eames, Marcel Breuer, Ludwig Mies van der Rohe and others to design quality, mass-produced furniture, all while educating clients and the public on principles of good design. Retailers such as Design Within Reach sell prestigious brands direct to the consumer, making these pieces accessible and contributing to their popularity and status. They're also instrumental in introducing



the new 21st century classics, such as the Louis Ghost Chair by Philippe Starck or the LEM Piston Stool by Shin and Tomoko Azumi, to the world.

Unfortunately, many of these designs have been reproduced, knocked-off and made cheaply, spoiling the original design intent. However, this makes the original and authentic pieces more valuable. Authentic pieces are still produced by the original manufacturer, branded with copyright labels placed somewhere discreet. These pieces are Sotheby's-worthy and carry certificates of authenticity.

- Buy via auction, consignment or internet.
- Buy one piece at a time all good things are worth waiting for.





Colour evokes emotion. Different colours lend a different look and feel to a space, and in a world where most gardeners opt for the popular pink and purple colour palette, the colour orange deserves another look. It certainly has a lot of punch and it may be just the zip and zing your garden needs.

### **ORANGE POWER**

Orange is a powerful colour with lots of attention-grabbing strength and energy. Used strategically, it highlights key areas of a yard, such as an out-of-the-way seating area or hidden path. Hot colours such as orange come to the forefront of vision while cool tones recede. Use orange hues to bring cosiness to an expansive space or use a combination of hot tones in the forefront with cool tones in the back to make a small space seem larger.

### **CREATE HARMONY**

A riot of different colours isn't the best approach for a harmonious garden composition. ### **COLOUR COMBOS**

### **PURPLE AND ORANGE**

Purple flowers abound in gardens everywhere, but too much purple can seem a bit dark and dreary. Adding orange makes cool blue and purple tones sing with vibrancy.

### PINK AND ORANGE

Pink is another prevalent flower colour and can look tiresome on its own. Mixing in some orange transforms a pink palette into a gorgeous mix of sorbet colours that looks fresh and modern amidst green foliage. You can even see Mother Nature combining these colours in many blossoms sporting pink petals with orange centres, such as Coneflower and Cosmos.

### Calendula – Pot Marigold

This beautiful, sunny-orange annual plant is really easy to grow from seed outdoors and self-seeds for subsequent years too. Its petals are edible or can be used to make skin-healing salves due to its natural antifungal and antibacterial properties.

### Hemerocallis - Daylily

There are so many varieties of orange daylily beyond the wild ones often known as "tiger lilies." Daylilies have evolved and are often shorter with finer foliage and longer bloom periods. The flower buds on this perennial are edible. Two of my favourites are "Ruffled Apricot" and "Tiger Kitten."

### Cosmos sulphureus 'Cosmic Orange'

Another amazing annual, Cosmos is so easy to grow from seed. This variety is covered by a profusion of two-inch carroty orange blooms that float above fresh fern-like foliage.

### Nasturtium Troika Orange'

Nasturtium is an old garden favourite. An edible annual, it thrives in poor, dry soil and is so easy to grow. This glorious orange variety is a high-performance bloomer with stunning white-streaked leaves. It's semi-trailing and looks great at the front of a border or in planters.

Orange is like a breath of fresh air. From bright tangerine to soft auburn there's an orange hue for everyone. It is said that a change is as good as a rest and now more than ever we need to look forward to the future with renewed hope and positivity. It's time to give orange – the colour of life, vigour and vitality – a try. **OH**




### **ACCESSORIES**

### Blueberry HAND PIES

RECIPE AND PHOTOS JENELLE MCCULLOCH

Handheld blueberry pies are perfect for on-the-go summer days – made with a flaky crust filled with a fresh and warm blueberry filling.

### **INGREDIENTS**

### CRUST

2 ½ cups flour

2 Tbsp sugar

½ tsp salt

1 cup cold butter, cubed ½ cup cold water

### FILLING

2 cups blueberries

¼ cup granulated sugar

1 Tbsp cornstarch

3 Tbsp water

1 tsp orange zest

#### **OTHER**

1 egg

### **CRUST**

Add flour, sugar and salt to a large bowl and mix until combined.

Cut in butter with a pastry blender or two knives until the mixture resembles coarse sand and butter is pea size.

While mixing, slowly add cold water a tablespoon at a time until the dough comes together.

Do not overwork dough. Turn dough out onto a floured surface and knead until combined.

Form dough into a disk, wrap with plastic and place in fridge for at least one hour to rest.

### **FILLING**

In a saucepan over medium heat, combine 1 cup of blueberries and sugar. Cook until juices are released, about 5-10 minutes.

Combine cornstarch and water and add to blueberries. Cook for an additional 5 minutes until thickened.

Remove from heat and add remaining 1 cup of blueberries and orange zest. Cool until ready to use.

### **ASSEMBLE**

Preheat the oven to 400°F and line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Beat egg with a splash of water to make a wash, set aside.

Roll out pie crust to 1/8-inch thickness.

Using a round pastry cutter, cut circles of dough.

To assemble, place a tablespoon of filling onto a dough round, brush the perimeter with egg wash and place a second round on top. (You can also cut top into strips or braid the strips.)

With a fork, press the two pieces together around the perimeter.

Score the top of each pie and brush with egg wash.

Place pies on a baking sheet and bake for 25-30 minutes, or until pies are golden brown. **OH**







Jessica posted Facebook photos of the home they were selling. Josh Bellamy, a builder in the Guelph area, saw that they intended to renovate their new home, and he reached out to Brad. The original home was traditional with small, dark, separate rooms. The Wyldes' vision included an open-concept kitchen, living room and sunroom. The staircase was removed to create extra space. The new layout features a separate, formal dining room, mudroom, powder room and office – all pivoting from a reconfigured main hall entry. The sunroom was existing but needed updating and was separated from the rest of the house by a small entryway. **Northfield Trim & Door** supplied all eight-foot solid doors, moudings and trim.

The original house had two large bedrooms. Now there are two master-size kids' bedrooms and a separate hallway to a third bedroom, which is the luxurious master suite. 



TIPS FROM A **PROFESSIONAL** STAGER ON ORGANIZING YOUR HOME BEFORE A SALE

When you're living in your home, storage goals are simple. It's all about attractively corralling your family's shoes, homework, jackets and - ouch! - stray LEGO pieces. But when you're selling, says Kristyn Pereira, lead stylist and account manager for home staging company Well Dressed Home, there's a twist.

"We look at resale value, and all our recommendations are potentially to make the seller more money." When it comes to organizing your home before a sale, Kristyn says things become stylized and not terribly realistic. "Nobody actually lives like that so it's kind of creating this facade." You're striving, she says, to create clean, fresh spaces buyers can imagine themselves living in.

Decluttering and staging is a lot of work, Kristyn admits, but she says it can really pay off. "It all comes down to your photographs," she says. "Because when people are shopping they're scrolling through photos that their realtor sent them, or they're on realtor.ca. And when those photos stand out, that's the house they want to go and look at. You'll see that a staged house is going to get more showings because people get excited looking at this beautiful space."

THE FOLLOWING ARE KRISTYN'S INDUSTRY-**TESTED TIPS FOR GETTING YOUR HOUSE** READY FOR THE MARKET.



### DO A WALK-THROUGH RESTYLE

Moving is a good time to start purging and looking at what you really need and what you are actually using. With her clients, Kristyn likes to start by doing a walkthrough of the entire house. "It's usually an hour-anda-half to two hours and we go through every nook and cranny." She recommends looking at everything with fresh eyes to decide what needs reorganizing or purging to create that sublime first impression for buyers.

### **DO A CLEAR-OUT**

Cull, and once done, Kristyn recommends a couple options. You can neatly store excess belongings on-site. "If you have an unfinished basement, garage or storage room, as long as those spaces are fairly organized, then it's OK to load those spaces up."

Alternatively, if you live in a condo or have a lot of clutter, off-site storage can work too. Kristyn uses a company called Second Closet, which will pick up and store homeowners' belongings and return them after the sale.

### **YOUR CLOSETS**

With closets and cupboards, ensure they have some negative space. Kristyn says, "If the closets and cupboards are overflowing, buyers think, 'If you don't have enough space, then we're not going to have enough space."

### **UPGRADE YOUR CLOTHES HANGERS**

Weed out those skinny wire hangers from your closets - "They're very distracting to the eye," says Kristyn. For a beautiful, clean look, make sure your coat hangers are all matching. Continued on page 56

### SMALL BUT SWEET





LISA AND SCOTT have travelled extensively over the years. Lisa trains and barrel races horses in rodeos across North America. Scott farms crops and raises a herd of longhorn cattle for market. The couple realized they were happiest and most at home when they were either visiting friends or vacationing in a log home. Their dream was to build one of their own.

A 107-acre country property very close to their family farm near Erin came up for sale in 2015. They'd had their eye on it for years and scored the winning bid. Lisa had watched several episodes of the HGTV show *Timber Kings* and was in awe of the featured homes. After doing some research, she and Scott decided to contract the British Columbia Company to build their expansive western red cedar log ranch.

They sent drawings of the rough perimeter design using Timber Kings' online design tool. The log structures on the property include a 6,975 sq. ft. home, a barn for the horses and a trophy room.

Timber Kings custom-cut and numbered the logs as the buildings were erected in B.C. They were then disassembled, transported to Erin, and reassembled, log by log. Scott and Lisa made all the big picture design decisions together from a distance, and were grateful to the team at **Pioneer Log Homes/Timber Kings** for their intuitive and seamless support throughout the build. However, they relied on local suppliers for their expertise and craftsmanship for the interior design. **Pete O'Donnell of O'Donnell Contracting** was the general contractor and oversaw the day-to-day work on the project. **Arthur's Fuel** was contracted to install the HVAC system.

On the home's main floor, Lisa wanted an open-concept space where family and friends could gather in one large, informal setting. There are six stools at the kitchen island and six more at the bar area. All specialty doors and mouldings were sourced from and installed by Barclay Trim and Mouldings.

Lisa says Carol, Frank and Gabriel Meyer from Meyer Wood Design Inc. offered invaluable help with the design, colour choices, finishes and major planning stages of the great room. Carol explains the colour scheme: "We took direction from the clients who wanted a greyish brown cabinet colour to complement the darker knots in their hickory wood flooring and we felt it important to tie in the grey and brown stone cooktop mantel."





There are two more bedrooms upstairs in the main house, each with a full bath. Scott and Lisa's youngest daughter and son-in-law visit from Oklahoma. They have a large private space even if there are large gatherings downstairs.

Lisa's pride and joy is the horse barn. It was home to three horses at the time of photography: Katie, Sodapop and Naughty. Six stalls, a rehab area, a six-horse exerciser and a cold water spa (to keep the horses' leg muscles in perfect condition), define the barn layout. Three extra stalls are used to quarantine or care for injured or sick horses. A heated indoor riding arena is at the centre of the building – a 110 by 275-foot space for Lisa to train her horses. 




The pioneer log ranch is a lifetime dream come true for Scott and Lisa and they are grateful to the local community of tradespeople who helped them build it. oh













As for all that dramatic tropical greenery we've come to associate with millennial style - Fiddle Leaf Figs, the large "Swiss cheese" leaves of the Monstera, tall-spiked Snake Plants, palms – it all continues to fly off shelves, says Phil. The Victorian era had its own fern craze, which saw them become all the rage as houseplants and fern motifs popped up everywhere from tea sets to clothing.






Sandi – who has owned her design firm for more than 20 years and also works as a designer of interior and exterior living spaces at furniture manufacturer **Hauser** – was more than up to the task and considered the request both an honour and a challenge. An honour because her mother was a huge NHL fan and would have been thrilled that she was helping to make a hockey player and his family comfortable in their home, and a challenge because modern farmhouse style was not quite in her design wheelhouse. "My style is more classic, so this was an interesting challenge for me, which I enjoyed."

The homeowners were happy with the house itself; the bones are solid and it features the natural yet refined finishes that reflect their organic, understated style. Light beams through large windows at perfect spots throughout the day to set the scene for warmth. But the house did not feel like home. 

# **MULTI-PLANT** HANGER

A VERTICAL HANGER THAT MAKES IT EASY TO GROW HERBS OR DISPLAY FLOWERS.

#### **MATERIALS**

3 round cork trivets Paper for template Heavy card stock 1 spool of cord 1 metal ring

3 small plant pots

3 flowering plants or herbs

#### **TOOLS**

Scissors Pencil Utility knife Glue Small drill bit







Start by creating a paper template to use for cutting and drilling your trivets. On a piece of paper, draw a circle 1 inch smaller in diameter than your trivet and cut it out. In the centre of your paper circle, draw another circle 1 inch smaller in diameter than the mouth of your plant pot and cut it out. Fold your paper template in half twice, then unfold. These fold lines will indicate where to drill the holes in your trivets.

Place your paper template in the centre of a cork trivet and trace around the smaller, inside circle. Cut out the circle using the utility knife. Repeat with the remaining two trivets.

Stack trivets and place your paper template on the centre of the top trivet. On the outer edge, using the fold lines as a guide, drill four evenly spaced holes in the trivets.

Next, make some extra circles out of heavy card stock, which will be glued to the bottom of each trivet for more stability. To do this, place your paper template onto your card stock and trace and cut three more circles. Glue these to the bottom of each trivet.





Now you're ready to attach your trivets with cord.

Cut 2 pieces of cord into 8 foot lengths, fold in half and loop through your metal ring, making a knot. Now you will have four strands hanging from the ring.

Thread the cord through the holes of the first trivet, then wrap the cord over the edge and thread through the holes again for adjustable stability.

Place the second trivet on the cord 12 inches from the first trivet and repeat threading. Do the same with the last trivet, leaving enough cord to tie a knot.

Adjust and level trivets. Apply glue into the holes to secure cords and let dry.

Gather the bottom cords, tie a knot and trim if desired.

Plant flowers or herbs in planters. Add planters to trivets and hang! on

Salt and pepper to taste

Lettuce

Buns

#### **DIRECTIONS**

#### **HOMEMADE MAYO**

In a food processor or blender combine egg, Dijon mustard and vinegar. Pulse to combine while slowly adding oil until mayo is thick and emulsified.

#### **SANDWICH**

Steam shrimp for 5 minutes or until cooked through. Cut into small chunks.

Combine shrimp, chives, shallot and mayo and mix. Season with salt and pepper to taste.

To assemble, slice open buns and toast in a pan over medium-high heat.

Add filling and lettuce to the bun. Enjoy! **oH**


