

You're a millennial who has just entered the housing market. Now that you have a place, you need to furnish the space. But how can you make it sustainable and eco-friendly?

Where to begin?

The desire to have a space that feels finished the moment you move in is understandable. However, we must move away from instant gratification and towards playing the long game. The reality is that making environmentally-conscious choices takes time and energy – and that's okay. FURNITURE

One of the easiest and simplest ways to be more sustainable at home is to purchase

Finally, learn how to fix things (or be willing to pay someone who can). The cost of goods has become so affordable that instead of repairing something we replace it. That mentality is simply not sustainable.



Adding a dreamy backyard water feature can be simple, extravagant or somewhere in between. There are options for every taste and budget.

WATER BOWLS

These large, watertight bowls are an easy addition, fitting any space. They have a bubbler/small filtering system and most are deep enough to add a variety of water plants. Imagine having water bowls instead of planters on a backyard patio – you would never have to worry about watering again!


WATER FOUNTAINS

PONDS


Ponds, streams and waterfalls let you take creativity to the extreme in your landscape design. As these are custom made, you can design anything imaginable, from a cool modern vibe to something Mother Nature designed herself – as long as you have the right budget in place as these can be costly.

Shelves of different depths within a pond interior can be created for certain water plants, as each has its own specific requirements. Shallow areas also act as escape routes in the event a pet or wildlife accidentally falls in.

Ponds need to be at least four feet deep (preferably deeper) if you'd like to overwinter frogs and fish successfully. UV filters

and pumps need to be carefully planned and calculated for the amount of water present and if you decide to include fish, you will need an extensive filtering system.

Pond accessories are fun and exciting! There is nothing quite like the feeling of walking on water where a cool, floating step is present. Other fun features include architecturally designed, artisan metal spout scuppers, spillways and mounted spillbowls that replace traditional waterfall weirs. You can even include a floating island filled with plants; you'd be surprised how many traditional garden plants do well in these environments and they look quite natural once the plantings fill in and spill over the edges.



Melanie's Pond Plant Pichs

The world of water gardening is extensive. Here are a few favourite, hardy, native-to-Ontario perennials to get



Water Lily / Nymphaea odorata - Likely the first water plant that comes to mind, lovely lily is a wonderful, free-flowering plant for any pond. Perfect, glistening white flowers with yellow centres are formed throughout

the summer months. It prefers still waters though, so always plant this beauty far away from waterfalls.



Pickerelweed / Pontederia cordata - A carefree-growth habit and lovely lavender blooms make this a colourful addition to any pond.



Marsh Marigold / Caltha palustris - Sunny buttercup blooms arrive in early spring, but only for a brief time. However, it's still a worthy water garden addition for its pretty leaves.



Horsetail Rush / Equisetum hyemale -Wonderful stiff upright stems resemble a tiny bamboo forest - perfect for pond margins. It can spread aggressively so it's best planted in a contained area.

POND MAINTENANCE

Ponds do take work and most need to be shut down in fall and opened in spring, just like a swimming pool. Most of the work happens in spring and mucking out a pond is dirty business. Hip waders help! The rest of the year is much easier, as long as you keep up a good maintenance program. An ideal healthy maintenance schedule requires an occasional filter cleaning, replacing 20 per

cent of the water with fresh water weekly and adding beneficial bacteria when needed. This is even more important for smaller features as their balance gets disrupted easily. The larger the pond, the easier it is to maintain and if it's large enough, it will mostly take care of itself. Don't forget to consider the ongoing electricity and pump/filter replacement costs too.

The best part of including a water feature in your oasis is all the birds and wildlife it will attract! What outdoor retreat would be truly complete without them? **oH**

66 We brought

our kids to eat here every week, even when they were babies," they recall. "There was one waitress who would walk them to the water to watch the ducks while we had our coffee."

Many Tilbury residents enjoyed similar experiences until the restaurant closed in 2016. With no offers to continue its legacy, the property was ready for a new era. The homeowners were too. Their kids now grown, it was time to enjoy the slower pace of retirement. With its breathtaking views and a dock for their boat, Lighthouse Cove was calling. They bought the property, tore down the restaurant and built their forever home.

Longtime design enthusiasts, the homeowners had a very clear vision. "We wanted something casual and homey. A little traditional but not too traditional," she tells us. To bring this vision to life, they assembled a team of experts, including custom residential designer Phil Fernandes of Philip Fernandes Designs, builder Gino Piccioni of Timberland Homes and designers Richard Pursel and Melissa Woodrow of Lionheart Home Collection.

Phil designed a shingle-style house with flared walls and sweeping roofs. The dramatic lines give the home a commanding presence. But soft cedar shakes keep the building from being too stuffy. "This is a fun house," comments Phil. "It's relaxed and comfortable – perfect for the location."

The home is 4,200 sq. ft., but size is irrelevant. "Square footage is the least important feature," Gino says of the house he built. "This is such a special project. It was an honour to be part of it, I couldn't have asked for a better family to work for. The details in this house are incredible. They make the home what it is." What it is, is an extraordinary building with exquisite touches throughout.

Some details are grand, like the built-ins by **Frank Cremasco Fine Cabinetry** in the great room and the herringbone floor in the foyer. Others are smaller, but no less impressive. Custom vent covers blend perfectly with the floor, and rain chains are a smart alternative to downspouts. "The flared walls made it difficult to get eavestroughs tied in," Gino reports. "The rain chains are such a cool alternative. They're beautiful and unique. You don't see them much around here."

The spacious main floor is a masterclass in contemporary coastal décor. Richard and Melissa outfitted the great room in a crisp neutral palette. Floor-to-ceiling windows (**Pella Windows & Doors**) are surrounded by white walls and bleached oak floors from **Rose City Tile**. The Lionheart duo paired plush white furniture with woven seagrass accents, creating a classic Cape Cod-style look. But the addition of modern pieces keeps the space fresh and youthful. The dining table (Lionheart Home Collection), for example, features a white oak top that would fit in any coastal abode. But its lucite legs are a surprising, contemporary twist.

Of all the home's details, the lighting steals the show. "Lighting is a real key feature in this house," says Richard. "Most of it is modern, a little oversized. And it's all spectacular." Continued on page 32








Knowing that lighting is the jewel of any room, the homeowner worked closely with Richard and Melissa to select fixtures. Among her favourite splurges are a pair of oversize matte black pendants (Lionheart Home Collection) above the kitchen island. Their hammered texture pops in the fresh white kitchen, while a gold leaf inlay casts a warm glow against the quartz counters from **Roma Tile**.

The Lionheart designers were sure to inject fun and drama into the home. They clad the powder rooms in graphic wallpaper, including a bold fish pattern – a whimsical nod to the homeowners' love of the water.

Other spaces are more subtle. The stairwell pops with a deep blue herringbone wallpaper that runs to the ceiling. Built-in shelves flank an upholstered bench and a glass pendant fixture adds a touch of sparkle. This space could have easily been overlooked, but clever design has turned it into a cosy reading nook. The homeowners love to curl up here with their grandchildren. Continued on page 34





WAIVING CONDITIONS

IT REMAINS A SELLER'S MARKET ACROSS
ONTARIO WHERE HOME PRICES CONTINUE TO
RISE AND INVENTORY REMAINS LOW.

RE/MAX Canada expects a 9.2 per cent increase in average residential sale prices across Canada this year. In Ontario, relocating from one region to another continues to drive housing activity. City dwellers are cashing in and moving to more scenic areas, where their purchasing power gets them a house that suits their preferred lifestyle. With mortgage rates expected to creep up, demand for homes far outstrips supply, leaving house hunters facing multiple offers for the home they want.

So, what's a buyer to do? They could do what home sellers find irresistible – waive all conditions and warranties.

Laura and Chris Walker weren't fooling around when they finally found their ideal condo in Collingwood.

"We had been looking on and off but when the pandemic hit we got serious," says Laura. "When this three-bedroom at Lighthouse Point came up we jumped on it." The couple had lost out on other properties and vowed not to let this one slip away. They went in with a clear offer with no conditions or warranties and a two-week closing. "They were not taking offers until the following Monday and we didn't want to wait and lose it," she says. "So we put in a bully offer over asking. They came back once and that was it – bought and sold." The condo was fully renovated and they've had no issues.

Waiving conditions and warranties in residential real estate transactions is the new winning strategy for many homebuyers. But

it's not for the faint of heart or those without the means to cover costs if there's an issue with the property or home.

Typical conditions in a purchase and sale agreement include financing, property inspections, state of title, legal review and appraisal. Buyers can add their own conditions and condo owners generally add a request and review of the status certificate, which ensures the condo corporation and its board are stable.

But the current housing market is anything but typical and buyers are increasingly willing to take risks to win the home they covet.

Dr. Parham Davoudpour, an attending emergency physician in Toronto, is suffering from buyer fatigue after waiving conditions and still losing two bids on homes in the Collingwood area.

"Both homes were sold substantially higher than asking price – over 50 per cent higher than asking," he says. "One of my offers was 45 per cent over asking and I still lost. "I call these high-risk transactions because you're pressured to make a decision that involves a lot of money and you don't have enough time for due diligence. It's literally like working in a hospital emergency department where you are always under pressure and you make decisions on the limited amount of information that you have."

Parham is still looking but his experience has left him less motivated.

David Oikle, president of The Ontario

Real Estate Association, blames supply and demand for the current state of housing in the province. "We're in this pickle that buyers are competing in such a way because we don't have enough homes to buy," David explains. "OREA's been spending a ton of time advocating for increasing supply at the municipal, provincial and federal levels. There isn't enough product to buy and we need to address that."

Janine (she didn't want us to use her full name) and her husband looked at eight homes in The Blue Mountains last year. "We lost out on two because our bids just weren't high enough," she says. They waived conditions in both bids, but it didn't help. "It was just a crap shoot," she says. "For one of them, there were about 13 offers. The vendors came back to us, told us they wanted to look at the top three bids 'so give us your very best offer.' We did and we lost out by \$1,000." They finally found and won a home they moved into last May, again waiving conditions and warranties. In hindsight, Janine says she wishes she had more time to investigate the planned developments on wetlands around them. "We love the neighbourhood, we love the house but the main issue now is the development that is supposed to go in beside us. I knew about the potential development, but I honestly thought our government would protect the environment, safety of citizens and our homes. I was wrong."

David says the key to a happy purchase is education, risk management and knowing your limits. He says a local realtor can help buyers mitigate risks. **OH**







OH: How did you come up with a design to meet their desires?

JM: By balancing form and function. The homeowner and her landscape designer, Kari Renaud (lilydesign), planned seating and activity areas that appeal to both adults and children. These areas included a really fantastic firepit (Touchstone Architectural Products) and a putting green. The pool house (Gray **Development Group**) incorporates luxuries like a hot tub, covered family room with remote-controlled screens and a beautiful, open-flame fireplace. Furniture selection was key. The large harvest table (Urbanhome) with benches is casual and accommodates kids well. Hard-wearing flooring, fabrics and accessories make the upkeep worry-free and style forward.

surprising) places in the kitchen (**Frank Cremasco Fine Cabinetry**), such as the hood fan and the interior of a white display cabinet.

OH: Any last words?

JM: Get the professionals involved. When the landscaper, the builder and designer work together, the results are spectacular.

OH: The tiles and backsplash are gorgeous. How did you decide on this look?

JM: The homeowner came across the old-world tile with a fresh feeling and fell in love with it. We created a Moroccan look working with a colour palette of soft cream, blue and beige. The floor looks like hardwood, but it's tile, so it's very functional (Marquis Tile). A big X pattern creates an interesting look. The backsplash is unexpectedly bold. We were originally only going to install it over the serving area, but the homeowner loved it so much we carried it around the entire perimeter of the kitchen, creating a huge impact.

OH: There are so many appealing design features in the pool house. Let's talk about some of the choices.

JM: The large, industrial white drum pendants over the island worked out well. Then there's shiplap on the front of the bar, the ceiling and in the powder room, which creates a pool-house vibe. One of the touches I really like is adding warm wood in some key (and

Certified Landscape Designer Kari Renaud of lilydesign was originally engaged by the homeowners to help design an extension to the original pool house location and provide an overall plan to accommodate a resort-style backyard to enhance the existing pool. "In working through the design process, the original pool house location with the proposed extension was not fitting the space," Kari says. "So I proposed a new location and orientation to help anchor the yard as an entertainment hub and to house the new raised spa at a convenient and central location."

"The other built elements include an outdoor kitchen area with a barbecue and smoker, a gas firepit lounge area, a stone feature wall with custom fire bowls, a putting green and a collection of large scale pots for anchoring the open dining space with annual plantings. I love the fact that there is an entertainment space for everyone in the family, while having a clean and classic look that won't date itself over time."

The project, Kari says, was a fun one. "The client was open minded, a good listener, easy to work with and extremely good at making decisions. The team the homeowner put together worked very well together."














Resort-Style Luxury

OUR HOMES: This is a stunning space. What were your design challenges?

JODI MASON: The existing pool is contemporary with imported

limestone tiles and black granite. One of the biggest challenges was finding the right furniture. We needed something heavy because the wind can be quite strong off the water. These contemporarystyle Muskoka chairs and pool loungers in a heavy black resin are the perfect solution. They will never be washed away!


OH: How did you create such a luxurious feel?



OH: This must have been a really fun project to work on. What were some of the highlights?

JM: There are so many. Some of the most memorable features are the two dining areas in the pool house. There's a conversation area on the lower level near the water and firepit, and a two-level bar with a swim-up area. The stools are built right into the pool. Gas lanterns and fire bowls flank the pool on two sides. Disco lighting and a sound system (**FAS Group**) make this the ultimate place for a sophisticated summer soirée.

HIDDEN GEMS

Spring is in the air. Literally. Birds, those welcome harbingers of spring, are on the wing in the skies above us on their annual migration mission to Canadian breeding grounds. Hundreds of species are returning and tucked among them are a lesser-known family of birds that are most coveted by birders. They're a range of brightly coloured species often referred to as the "jewels" of the bird world – the fabulous family of warblers.

A WARBLER PRIMER

Warblers, or Wood-Warblers according to their official taxonomic classification, are colourful songbirds unique to the Americas. Over 30 species occur or breed in Ontario. Some of them are among the most abundant species of birds in our vast forests. They tend to come in waves as they migrate together in tight mixed flocks. But for all their numbers, they are not commonly seen. There are good reasons why not. Despite their bright colours, warblers are tiny (smaller than a chickadee). They're easily

camouflaged by branches and leaves. They often forage tucked up high in the treetops. They don't stay still long enough for a good, identification-worthy look. They keep moving ever onwards in a quest to reach their nesting territories. And finally, by the end of May, the warbler show is over. The waves of warblers have now dispersed widely across the province, each pair ensconced in their own specific nesting-niche territories. With all this, it can very much be a case of "if you blink you will miss them.'

A BOUQUET OF WARBLERS

Warblers, like most birds, migrate at night under the protection and cover of darkness. Come morning, they seek rest and food wherever they may be in their journey north. While the backyards of our homes are not their preferred habitat, they just may drop by after a long night on the wing, to fuel up for the next leg of their migration. So, as we look out the windows of our homes to enjoy the emerging signs of spring, we may be lucky enough to see our backyard trees and shrubs adorned with a "bouquet of warblers" – the collective noun for a group of these birds. Grab your binoculars and check them out for a morning of discovering these little gems.

WHAT'S IN A NAME

So how do you sort out one wee warbler from another? There are so many species, and they don't stop and pose for you! It can be challenging, but that's where the fun is. Thankfully, each species does have its own distinctive field marks that distinguish it

from its warbler cousins. A number of species even provide clues by virtue of their descriptive names. Notice a black-and-white striped warbler? Well, it's a Black-and-White Warbler. Completely yellow? It's a Yellow Warbler. Black throat and blue back? Black-throated Blue Warbler. Gold wing patches? Golden-winged Warbler. The names alone evoke visions of brightness and beauty. But wait until you actually spot one!

And their songs! There is such a range that birders often use mnemonics to sort them out. For instance, the mnemonics for the Yellow Warbler are, "sweet, sweet, I'm so sweet." Don't you agree?

On the other hand, there's a group of warblers with decidedly unhelpful names. Tennessee, Cape May and Nashville Warblers, for instance, are denizens of the northern boreal forests, not their namesake locations. Magnolia and Palm Warblers were simply named after the plants they were first discovered in. So don't rely on those names for identification hints, and don't think you won't see them in your backyard.



WARBLER NECK

With a little patience and practice, discerning one warbler from another eventually gets easier, not to mention very rewarding. It is rightly a bit of a personal achievement to positively identify your first Blackburnian Warbler, your first American Redstart - the list goes on and on. Take up the challenge! But be prepared to wind up with a bout of what seasoned birders refer to as "warbler neck." It's that tight kink in your neck resulting from scanning high into the treetops for lengths of time, hoping to discover a few hidden bejeweled treasures. At the end of the day, the kink is just a reminder of time well spent in a quest for your new favourite warbler. A few gentle stretches and you're good to go again the next day.

SPARK BIRD

It is not uncommon for birders to have what is referred to as a "spark bird" – a sighting of a particular species that sparked or triggered their interest in birds and birding. For many, this spark is often a warbler (mine was the oh-so-handsome Bay-breasted Warbler). A good, crisp look through your binoculars at any one of these bright little beauties is often enough to give you that spark and awaken your senses to the wonderful world of warblers. Enjoy! **OH**







BERRY COBBLER

RECIPE AND PHOTOGRAPHY JENELLE MCCULLOCH

This cobbler is reminiscent of a sweet, soft southern-style drop biscuit. You can use whatever summer fruit you have on hand. We used blueberries and blackberries.

INGREDIENTS

(Serves 6)

FILLING

4 cups blueberries and blackberries*

1 Tbsp flour

1 Tbsp granulated sugar

COBBLER TOPPING

2 cups flour

½ cup granulated sugar

½ cup brown sugar

2 Tbsp baking powder

3 tsp ground cinnamon

1 stick butter, cold

1/4 - 1/2 cup boiling water

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350°F.

In a baking dish, combine all filling ingredients and set aside.

For the topping, combine flour, sugars, baking powder and cinnamon in a bowl. With a pastry cutter or two knives, cut butter into dry ingredients until the mixture resembles wet sand. Stir in 1/4 cup of boiling water and stir until combined (add in more water - 1 Tbsp at a time, if needed, to achieve a drop biscuit texture).

Spoon the topping over the berries. Don't worry about the topping covering the whole dish, it will spread as it bakes!

Bake for 30-45 minutes* until golden brown.

*Feel free to substitute any berries or fruit.

*Adjust baking time depending on size of the pan. If using a smaller pan and the topping is thicker add 5-10 minutes to baking time. on








