This woodland retreat gleams with holiday hospitality. Urns spill over with Carolina sapphire cypress, dogwood and birch branches dappled with red berries and bows for colour; reindeer are watchful on the grass. Pillars are wrapped with lights and the front porch draped with pine and cedar roping.

Homeowners Wendy and Chris Emmett opened the doors on their two-year-old home in the Collingwoodlands to benefit the Royal LePage Shelter Foundation during last winter's Collingwood Holiday House Tour. Delighted visitors soaked in the hospitality, listening to music from the grand piano and admiring the bright table set for 12. Heathcote greenery designer Jessica Ladly of Riverside Greenhouses created green and neutral arrangements that brought the home to life. Christine Pritchard of Habitat Interiors Inc. and Tamarisk McNalty Stephens of Tamarisk Interior **Design** styled the gorgeous great room and dining room as well as vignettes throughout the main floor.

With over 7,000 square feet of living space, the sixbedroom home shone on the tour. The couple - Wendy, a Sales Representative on the Chris Keleher Team at Royal **LePage Locations North**, and Chris, a technology sales executive - had been weekenders in the region for 10 years, and on the suggestion of their financial planner, Dean Taylor of **Assante Capital Management Ltd.**, made the full-time move to Collingwood to build their elegant new home.


