WINE CELLARS

Interior Designer **Dolores Pian** shares her ideas.

WINE CELLARS AND WINE-TASTING ROOMS ARE COMING OF AGE.

Wine collecting requires a special space of its own and more homeowners are installing wine rooms in new and existing homes to ensure the right bottle is on hand. With today's technology, refrigeration and modern materials, wine can be stored in almost any location. However, this 6,100-year-old beverage still requires tender loving care.

WINE IS FUSSY

Wine breathes through the cork and ages in the process. Too much oxygen makes the wine bitter. The pace of this breathing is faster at higher temperatures and slower at lower temperatures. Fluctuations in temperature and humidity accelerate the aging process.

WINE STORAGE

Wine requires a cool, dark space with higher humidity than the average living space. Wine does not like noise or vibrations from any source.

It doesn't like any temperature extremes; 45°F to 65°F are the best temperatures for serving wine and 55°F is the ideal storing temperature for long-term storage, regardless of your wine style. Wine storage rooms come in two types: passive and active.

Passive Wine Cellars such as caves, basements and closets are naturally cooler and only receive indirect sunlight. They minimize swings in temperature and damage to the wine.

Active (Cooled) Wine Cellars are fully climate-controlled and can be set to the perfect storage temperature and humidity level to ensure ideal conditions. They are more flexible and can fit into any large, small or odd space in your home.



MODERN DESIGN TRENDS

Glass enclosures allow you to show off your wine collection and can be built as tall or wide as you want. The choice of tempered glass used is extremely important. The insulation value should maximize the refrigeration, humidification benefits and UV protection required for wine rooms that are in direct contact with sunlight. Etched or frosted glass are decorative options.

Integrating wine cellar design into your space for that WOW factor. Placing wine storage in living areas,

man caves or kitchens allows you and your guests to engage with the wine while you show off your collection.

A label-forward design draws attention to the label art. It creates an intimate, interactive experience between the user and the bottle of wine.

Metal and acrylic wine racking. These materials are gaining popularity in contemporary wine cellar design. They provide the same storage quality as wood and can be much more cost effective.

Bridging old and new. Combining wood with metal or acrylic allows for more flexibility in a project design that is less stuffy and ornate, more contemporary and inviting.

MODERN DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION CONSIDERATIONS

- ▶ Use LED lights and UV film for glass enclosures.
- No vibrating wall speakers and no noisy air conditioners. Insulate your mechanical air ducts or use a ductless air conditioner.
- Vent equipment heat outside.
- Storing multiple bottles of wine requires plywood backing for wall installation.
- Proper wall insulation, a vapour barrier and moisture-resistant green board walls are essential.
- Easy access to electricity.
- Moisture-resistant flooring is a must. Consider the insulation value of the floor and materials.



RETURN ON YOUR INVESTMENT (ROI)

A wine cellar is a high-end investment and, in some homes, it is a must-have upgrade. With an average bottle price of \$95, it pays to design your investment so it can add value to your home.

Galileo tells us: "Wine is sunlight, held together by water." Then sunlight and water hold together the truth in wine. Take good care of your truth. $\ oh$




The name hydrangea stems from the Greek word for water, hydros and jar, angos, and more than hints at the constant moisture required to keep these plants happy, healthy and blooming. Their long-lasting blooms are not actually flowers, they are actually flower bracts, which explain their very long flowering cycle.

don't require staking. They bloom on new growth each year, so no need to worry about a hard winter destroying tender buds. In colder climates like ours, these beauties take full sun but enjoy protection from the strong afternoon heat. They typically grow between three to eight feet but can be pruned to maintain height. Their leaves are dark green, oval-shaped and turn shades of red/brown in autumn.

VANILLA **STRAWBFRRY**

The fragrant Vanilla Strawberry hydrangea takes a few years to really get growing but when it does - oh my - patience will be rewarded with huge, fluffy and creamy white blooms slowly fading to pink and white bi-coloured flower heads.

QUICK FIRE (AND LITTLE QUICK FIRE)

Quick Fire hydrangea (as the name suggests) blooms earlier than all the others. The flowers open white and quickly turn to dark pink. Little Quick Fire is exactly the same except it grows only about four feet in height - great for small spaces.



BOBO

Bobo hydrangea is a dwarf panicle that is exceptionally floriferous. White blossoms turning to blush pink smother this smallstatured three-foot shrub.

LIMELIGHT AND LITTLE LIME

Yet another wonderful panicle type, Limelight hydrangea sports cool limegreen blooms. Little Lime hydrangea does too, in a smaller size.



SMOOTH TYPE (HYDRANGEA ARBORESCENS)

Sometimes called wild hydrangeas, these have gorgeous, round snowball blooms that last for weeks in mid/late summer. They are much more shade tolerant than the panicle types but bloom best with some morning sun. They flower on new wood and can be pruned to the ground or near ground level in late winter/early spring to encourage abundant blossoms. The leaves of arborescens are large, dark green, heart-shaped, and thin.



ANNABELLE

Annabelle hydrangea is a well-loved classic hydrangea with tremendous staying power. It has large, pure white snowball blooms but they do tend to flop after a heavy rain. Peony rings work to keep them upright and are quickly hidden by their large leaves or you can prop them up with strategically placed dead branches.



INCREDIBALL

Incrediball hydrangea is exactly like Annabelle but with even more gargantuan white blossoms the size of basketballs!

CLIMBING HYDRANGEA (HYDRANGEA PETIOLARIS)

As the name advises, these hydrangeas are actually vines. Gorgeous white and fragrant lacecap flowers cover this sturdy vine in June/July. Mid-green leaves turn yellowish in fall with pretty peeling bark. This is a slow grower that enjoys a shady spot but can grow 50 feet, so plant wisely.

BIGLEAF TYPE (H. MACROPHYLLA)

These include both lace-caps and mophead types and are sometimes called French hydrangeas. They have big, glossy leaves and have gorgeous pink, blue, purple or white blossoms and are the fancy kind coveted by many. I hate to be cynical and the bearer of bad news, but in our Ontario climate, this type of hydrangea will often produce lots of leaves, but blossoms can sometimes be a scarcity. Most varieties bloom on old wood, making the flower buds susceptible to killing winter temps, though there are some that flower on both old and new wood. Read below.

ENDLESS SUMMER


Endless Summer hydrangea and its offspring (The Endless Summer collection) bloom on old and new wood, making them the most reliable of the bigleaf type for our climate. The blooms of the whole series are beautiful! Just be prepared; they are high-maintenance and if you want to keep them blooming, you need to water them often and just the right amount. They need to be kept moist, but not have wet feet. Best of luck! он

DOUGH

INGREDIENTS

¾ cup milk, warmed

2 1/4 tsp active yeast

¼ cup white granulated sugar

1 egg + 1 egg yolk, room temperature

1/4 cup unsalted butter, melted 3 cups all-purpose flour

½ tsp salt

DIRECTIONS

Place warmed milk (110-115°F) in the bowl of a stand mixer and sprinkle yeast on top. Yeast will begin to bubble/foam as it activates. If not, your milk was too cold or hot.

Once foamy and dissolved, add sugar, eggs and butter and mix with a spatula until combined.

Add flour and salt and stir until a dough begins to form.

Transfer bowl to the stand mixer fitted with the dough attachment and knead for 8-10 minutes on medium speed.

Transfer the dough to a large, well-oiled bowl and cover with plastic wrap and a towel.

Let rise for 1.5 hours or until doubled in size.

FILLING

INGREDIENTS

¼ cup butter, softened

1 Tbsp brown sugar

1 Tbsp cocoa powder

DIRECTIONS

Combine butter, sugar and cocoa powder in a separate bowl.

ICING

INGREDIENTS

¼ cup unsalted butter, softened

¼ cup cream cheese, softened

 $\frac{1/2 \text{ cup powdered sugar}}{1/2 \text{ tsp vanilla extract}}$

DIRECTIONS

In the bowl of a stand mixer, cream together butter and cream cheese.

Mix while slowly adding powdered sugar and vanilla.

ASSEMBLY

Roll dough into a rectangle that is 1/4-inch thick.

Spread filling over dough.
Fold dough in half.

Cut dough into 1-inch strips.


Twist each strip and tie them into knots. It's okay if they're not perfect!

Place knots on a baking sheet and loosely cover with a layer of plastic wrap and a towel.

Let rise again for 30 minutes before baking in a preheated 350°F oven for 12-15 minutes.



NESTLED IN THE WATERFRONT VILLAGE OF SHANTY BAY, THIS AWARD-WINNING NEW HOME IS DEEPLY CONNECTED TO THE HISTORY OF ITS COMMUNITY. SO IS THE YOUNG COUPLE WHO BUILT IT.

hen construction began in October 2017, entrepreneurs Russell Austin (Ontario Modular Solutions founder) and designer **Vanessa Rogerson** of **Vanessa Rogerson Designs** planned to build their new 3,000 sq. ft. residence on the foundation of an existing 1960s cabin.

It wouldn't be the first time the site had experienced a renaissance. The cabin had been rebuilt from a shack dating back more than a century – perhaps one of the original shanties that inspired the village name. During excavation, horseshoes were discovered suggesting a one-time farm.

"Russell and I love the property," says Vanessa, who designed the house to integrate within its surroundings rather than simply sit on top of it. "The privacy and the view year-round are just stunning and so peaceful. We live one block from the lake and enjoy boating and jet-skiing in the summer months, and ice fishing and snowmobiling all winter."

In the summer of 2017, the enterprising couple decided to renovate, and began the work themselves. They quickly realized assistance was necessary to achieve the home of their dreams. Having collaborated with **Prycon Custom Building and Renovations** on other projects, Vanessa invited their team to help. *Continued on page 34*








Their combined expertise was recognized by industry experts across Canada. The home won the 2018 Award of Creative Excellence presented by Simcoe County Home Builders' Association.


The couple continued to work on the house together to a lesser extent, sourcing and finishing the red cedar planking showcased on the front exterior to complement the black shingling, modern black Garaga garage doors and charcoal siding. The large front door adds to the curb appeal with its unusual, long steel handle, wide sidelites and triangular transom that accentuates the front porch peak while framing the massive mid-century chandelier that hangs in the foyer.

The red cedar planks pop up again as a feature wall in the master bath, contrasting with a patterned white ceramic backsplash from **Tilemaster**. Additional textural elements come into play in the master bedroom where full-length velvet drapes hang from a rod with crystal egg finials. *Continued on page 37*

Elsewhere, natural materials continue to balance hard surfaces. A Brazilian cowhide rug on the great room floor is a stylish reminder of Russell's tenure out west in Alberta. It's also the base of an airy expanse that showcases an open-riser walnut staircase climbing 23 feet to a catwalk perimeter edged by a **Stairhaus Inc.** handrail in glass and steel.

"When we have the windows open, we can hear the birds chirping – it feels like they're in the house," adds Vanessa, laughing at the perplexed reaction of her two Bengal cats, Bruce and Dior as the sound echoes around. "It certainly keeps the cats occupied!"

At the room's pinnacle, a dramatic

LED globe fixture from **Glass Lighting Gallery** doubles as art while infusing elegance and energy into Vanessa's second-floor design studio.

"Lighting really makes the home – it's my favourite aspect of each project," she admits. "Every piece needs to work together as part of a set, but also function independently for each room."

In the dining area, the light fixture is a modern interpretation of a tree branch. It's surrounded on two sides with oversize windows from **DeCola Windows and Doors Inc.** that slide open to a wraparound covered porch and the living trees beyond.

The chandelier shines on an enormous harvest table crafted from a live-edge walnut slab by **Bateman Fine Cabinetry**. It's set with ghost chairs to expose the custom detailing. The walnut wood grain repeats in the walnut flooring from **Irvine Carpet One Floor & Home**, and in bar chairs that line the 10-foot waterfall island, sculpted by **Di Pietra Design** in Blackberry Granite.

"I like the warmth of it," she says of the wide-plank flooring. "It's timeless and durable"

Once the in-house kitchen and bath designer at **Cabneato**, Vanessa hired her former employers for the millwork in her own kitchen. A wall of cabinetry painted Chantilly Lace by **Benjamin Moore** (Simply White in eggshell was used elsewhere) includes glass-fronted display cupboards with lighting – including a top row with awning-style doors and push latches. 

She also used that time to develop a strong network of local trades, suppliers and partners. Currently in progress is National Kitchen & Bath Association (NKBA) certification. Already in demand, she is now busy on another kitchen renovation, a basement, and a full head-to-toe custom home.

"I am very excited to see the finished product this fall," says the Barrie native, who has an inspiring new home studio to work from. OH





Gargantuan mahogany dining sets. Towering armoires. Royal Doulton figurines, anyone? If items like this aren't your thing, you're not alone. As *The New York Times* recently reported, thanks to today's small homes and pared-down aesthetic, the market for traditional antiques has shifted sharply in the last two decades.



5 STEPS to creating A FABULOUS DINING SPACE

> Cooler temperatures bring warmer gatherings as we all move indoors to entertain. That also means it's time to show off your home. No more backyard barbecues here. It's finally time to highlight your culinary skills or cocktailmaking and impress your guests with a dining room design that feels both elegant and comfortable. Here are my five non-negotiable design elements for creating a fabulous dining space.

> > **COLOUR & MOOD**

Think about the mood you wish to evoke. A bright room with fresh white walls and lots of natural light will make you feel awake and alive. This is great for brunches and luncheons. For a more intimate vibe, choose richer colours and warm lighting. I love to use wallpaper and grasscloth in dining rooms. It adds a luxurious touch and can even act as a

great conversation starter among guests while you slip away to prepare the meal.

FURNITURE LAYOUT Function is foremost to dining room design. If your table is too big, the chairs may bump up against the wall, or if there are too many large furniture items, guests may knock over a lamp (or each other). A general rule of thumb is to keep a minimum of 36 inches between the edge of the table and the wall for chairs. This gives chairs just enough space to pull out so that your guest can slide in. More than 36 inches is even better. Continued on page 56

SEATING SELECTION You'll want to consider what type of seating suits your needs. Some families prefer a bench or banquette seating. This works great for children but not as well for adult dinner parties. No one wants to be the guest stuck in the centre of the bench. It's like having a middle seat on an airplane and the lady at the window continually has to squeeze by you to use the washroom. Banquettes do, however, work really well when you are tight for space. The 36-inch rule no longer applies when you have bench seating. Just make sure that your table



SIZE MATTERS

The size of your table is important. Γ It's not just about what fits in the room (although this is important too). Select a table that accommodates how you like to serve and dine with guests. You want it to have enough space for plates and décor or family-style platters in the middle, but one that still encourages great conversation across the table. Never go smaller than 36 inches wide. In general, tables 42 to 48 inches wide are most common. Anything bigger is difficult for conversation. The shape of the table can also affect your dining experience. You've seen this at restaurants. A round table is great for including everyone, but if it fits more than eight people (think of a wedding), it's too big and you get stuck talking solely to your neighbour all night. Round tables are great for smaller spaces. They lend themselves well to a space that also acts as a thoroughfare since there are no sharp corners to impede the flow



BONUS DESIGN ELEMENT: If you have a little more space, consider a sideboard or a bar cart. Bar carts are fun to look at and you can set them up as an extra area for guests to serve themselves. The vintage bar cart in my own home sees a lot of action and sparks many conversations.

By considering mood, layout, table size, seating and lighting, you'll have covered all the bases to designing a beautiful and functional dining room. When you've found the perfect dining design, don't forget to add in some additional table decorations, candles and glassware. on



LIGHT IT UP Lighting is the last main factor and perhaps the most important one if you're looking to create a space that keeps everyone wanting to get invited back. Use layers of light. Always add a dimmer to this room and use pot lights for great general lighting while you set the table, but turn them off when guests arrive and use a beautiful chandelier coupled with a pair of lamps on a sideboard or wall sconces for ambience. Chandeliers should hang approximately 29 inches above the table but this, of course, depends on your ceiling height. You can hang a light higher if your ceilings are extra tall.

When Phil and Elsa, who live in Toronto, wanted to build a cottage in the Tiny Beaches area, they remembered having a great experience working with builder Rene Ouellet Jr. back in 2004 when they and a few friends built a timeshare-style residence in the Wasaga Beach area. "We ended up selling our share to one of the other owners and started looking further north to build another place," Phil remembers.

For a couple of years they kept their eyes peeled for building sites in the Tiny Beaches area and were shown at least 10 properties by their real estate agent. One day, in 2017, they had just finished seeing yet another place when their agent mentioned a nearby property that was a teardown and perhaps not ideal. "Since we were already there we thought we might as well go see it, and the minute we showed up at the property we knew this was it," he recalls. "When we got out of the car we were like, 'this is it'." The next step was to contact Rene.

Two years ago Rene Jr. took over the custom building business that his father, Rene Ouellet Sr., started in 1973. Rene Sr., now semi-retired, did framing and carpentry for Viceroy Homes back in the 70s and ended up becoming a Viceroy dealer for many years, until the company closed. Rene Jr. changed the business name to **A&R Design Build** and continued specializing in custom-built cottages.


Phil says Rene is very easy to work with. "When we had to choose things like flooring or tiles, Rene was very accommodating and worked around our schedules," Phil says. "It was really a seamless process, from the day we sat down to look at designs and all through the rest, it was great. Rene is very straightforward and doesn't mince words. He sticks with his timeline and budget. We dealt with any changes that had to be made easily through email; he is very organized."


The building site was perfect for their waterfront needs. They loved that it was on a bit of hill with a nice view and that the area seemed quite private. "It wasn't teeming with people and there were no back cottages, which is nice as well just from a density perspective," Phil says. "It was just beautiful." They enjoy visits from wildlife like foxes and rabbits, and the seagulls are always calling from small, rocky islands offshore. "For a place just two hours out of the city it feels very secluded." Phil and Elsa have two children, aged eight and 11, and the whole family loves the great room the best. The high ceiling and walk-out to the deck captures balmy breezes in the summer and the comfy seating around the wood-burning fireplace is a favourite spot in the winter. The fireplace features a 20-foot-high veneered, real stone surround. The upper floor loft with three bedrooms overlooks the space.

The durable laminate flooring (Mohawk Flooring, Reclaimed Chic in Golden Honey) throughout the main living areas is ideal for beachfront life. The couple chose tile flooring for bathrooms but love the look of the laminate everywhere else.

Rene says the flooring was installed right on top of the cement floor in the lower level. This flooring was supplied by **Therrien's Floors** in Midland.

"One of the smartest things we did with the deck was make it half-covered and half-open," says Phil. The grey composite deck features a roofed area over the dining table, complete with a cedar ceiling with lighting. "You can sit out there when it's raining or use

it to get out of the sun." Many of the stately cottages in the surrounding area have cedar shake siding so the couple put their own spin on the look and selected HardieShingle composite shakes in a rich grey hue.




The kitchen has a unique feature to accommodate a request Rene hadn't encountered before. "They wanted a pantry in the kitchen but wanted the door to blend in with the rest of the cabinetry," says Rene. The kitchen company had never done that before so they attached cabinet fronts onto a regular door. The new door blends seamlessly with the rest of the warm white kitchen.

Though the family spends as many weekends and holidays as they can at the cottage, it isn't so far from Toronto that they can't also come up mid-Saturday for a one-night respite from city life. "You still feel like you have a nice break from the regular routine," he says. The family spends a lot of time in the water, stand-up paddle boarding or kayaking, and Phil windsurfs.





He appreciates Friday Harbour's proximity to Toronto and easy access to the Lake Simcoe community – including the dock-to-dock commute to work.


"We have friends all over the lake," he says.

"I love creative ways of bringing ideas to life," she says. Continued on page 83










While the scene-stealing waterfront is showcased by a full wall of windows on each of the three floors in this 2,200 sq. ft. freehold townhouse, Danielle is careful to balance decorative elements with practicality. 
In this lounge, functional guitars double as wall art.




