# MUDROOM mareover

We have decided to build an addition onto our home in order to accommodate a mudroom and more storage space. Do you have any tips or hints to help us make our new room work for our family? We have no idea where to even begin. – Carol





**QUICK TIP:** An easy way to add softness to your mudroom (and necessary storage) is by using baskets. When selecting your baskets, make sure they are just deep enough to fold a scarf or store a bulky pair of gloves. Things get lost at the bottom of deeper baskets and become disorganized too quickly.



Designer Stephanie Redmond answers your questions.

As much as I would appreciate my home always looking as though it's in the middle of a photo shoot, it is simply impossible. We have boots, mittens, scarves, strollers, keys, mail, grocery bags, backpacks, spare change and all things made to produce clutter. Unless we dedicate a space for each item, it seems to all end up at the bottom of a basket, on the floor and just plain lost. The mudroom, however, is my saving grace.

Some would argue that a mudroom is the busiest room in the house. They endure the ebb and flow of a household on a daily basis. Let's face it, it's constant abuse! If you're going to invest in an addition for your home, make sure you spend time planning. It will make that extra space go from functional to fabulous.

#### DESIGNING YOUR MUDROOM

A well-designed mudroom is a well-planned mudroom. Look in closets and the garage and itemize what you will keep in your mudroom. Take into account the height of boots and number of shoes, the length of jackets, the size of purses and helmets. Instead of promising to take that trip to Goodwill, plan for what you've got.

### Consider the following:

- **Seating** to put on and take off shoes
- **Hooks** a lower level is handy for children
- Counter for mail and car keys
- **Broom closet** for regular sweeping
- Coat closet for longer items
- Baskets, cubbies or drawers for mittens, scarves, etc.
- **Pet station** for leashes, food and bags
- Grocery bin storage for easy access on the way out

#### **BUILDING YOUR MUDROOM**

Material selection is critical. Ensure that surfaces are hard-wearing to prevent scratches or water damage. Leave enough room in your budget for quality materials that will withstand the test of time and keep your room looking unsullied.

#### Consider the following:

- Radiant heat this will dry the floor and your wet shoes
- Drawers with soft closers to prevent slamming
- ${\bf Central\ vac}$  install in the baseboard so you can sweep directly into it
- **Good lighting** brighter is better
- Slatted shelves for airflow so wet items can dry easily
- Stone or slate floors thinner tiles could crack
- **Wood cabinetry** a painted finish will eventually scratch or chip (but can be repainted)
- Electrical outlets for charging phones

As utilitarian as this space may be, don't forget to make it chic. Just because it's where you keep your shoes doesn't mean it needs to look like a boring old closet. Have fun with it!  $\mathbf{o}\mathbf{H}$

When it comes to building luxury homes on time and on budget, **Cole Leibel** of **BigEast Construction** has developed a winning formula. He says the design, the material, the trades – everything – has to be ready and scheduled before the building begins. "Planning, communication and trust are everything," Cole says while standing in front of a stunningly beautiful modern-rustic home in north Innisfil that he completed inside and out in just eight months.

"When I build a home I work on the whole home until it's complete," he says. "There's no stopping and starting because we're waiting for materials and trades. I've planned out every aspect of the build so the project runs smoothly and is completed as promised."

Cole has had wonderful teachers. A third-generation builder with an honours degree in business management, he's been swinging a hammer since he was a very young boy. His passion for building is evident in every finished detail. *Continued on page 33*

This house was inspired by its surroundings – five-and-a-half acres of mature forest. "I wanted to build a house that would capture the beauty of the undisturbed land," says Cole. "The footprint offers 360-degree views with each window and door framing the treed landscape." The 4,500 sq. ft. home stands at the end of a winding driveway. You can't see the home from the street, a must to ensure peace and privacy. Relaxed gardens in green and white grace the front of the home. A large-cut flagstone walkway and stone stairs lead to the black, hand-distressed solid-wood front doors.

"The front and side doors arrived in solid oak," Cole explains. "However, new doors didn't fit the profile here." A talented artist hand-distressed and painted the doors to create the look of an old find. The exterior of the home is finished in stone and wood siding, with matching window trim.

Look up... way up to the chimney where handmade terra cotta gargoyles form the chimney flu.

Inside, **Kristylynn Banman** of **KL Interior Design** worked with a talented team to achieve a polished, relaxed look with a neutral palette, lots

of texture, natural elements, comfortable furnishings and fabulous lighting.

"It's so important during the building process to have a clear design direction," Kristylynn says. "My design team ensured all the finishings were carefully planned for during the process."

The same stone was used inside, to emulate the look of a solid stone structure, while connecting the spaces with a continuous wall that starts in the dining room, and follows through the bedroom hallway.


The stone wall forms a U-shape that frames the inviting courtyard outside. The U shape of the house, along with the openness achieved by the series of French doors, creates inter-connectedness throughout.

That wall, along with barn-board ceilings in the dining room, living room and the hallway, formed the inspiration for the interior design.

Cole sourced an old barn, took it down and cleaned the wood. His skilled trim-carpenters hand-cut the boards and arranged them on the ceilings. "It was really great to incorporate the character and history of the 150-year-old barn," says Cole. The weathered grey patina sets the tone for the rest of the interior. Continued on page 34

"We used a palette of grey, soft beige and cream," Kristylynn says. "The walls throughout the entire house are painted White Down (by Benjamin Moore)." Even the kitchen cabinets, beautifully handcrafted and installed by **Bateman Custom Furniture & Cabinetry**, are White Down.

hand-planed maple in the great room and bedrooms. The main living area is open and flows easily from one area to another.

In the dining room, two large antique iron lanterns hang above a long reclaimed wooden table surrounded by linen-wrapped Parsons chairs. Wing-backed chairs in a fun zebra fabric sit at both ends. A blonde, teak wall unit holds books and a collection of white china.

A large maple island (Bateman) anchors the kitchen. A stainless steel apron-sink and professional-grade appliances shine. A large iron pot rack hangs over the granite-topped island. The cabinet style is a sunken-panel

shaker with a hand-cut quarter-inch bead. Solid wood, soft-close doors and drawers have European hinges. It's a true chef's kitchen that doesn't feel out of place in the comfortable home.

A natural gas, open log-set fireplace is the stunning focal point of the Tumbled-marble floors in the dining room and kitchen make way for living room. Kristylynn's team cleverly designed two sitting areas on either side of the mantel. The first, off the kitchen, is ideal for conversing with friends. The other area is set around a large flat screen. Up above are two large, custom hand-forged iron fixtures (Northern Iron). The chairs and sofas are covered in neutral linens and durable cottons. Lots of patterned pillows add texture and interest. A raw-wood and iron table shares the space with a black antique chest. Colour comes from the art. Large, framed, vintage posters are hung strategically on the walls throughout the home, offering bright, saturated hues. Fresh flowers in green and white (Joshua's Greenery) add life. 

I really enjoy gardening this time of year; cooler weather, fewer biting insects – what's not to love? Readying your landscape for winter is a relatively easy task; the spring maintenance task list is much more daunting. Here are some basic tips to ensure your garden looks its best this winter and wakes up gorgeous the following spring!

**Remove Tender Bulbs And Plant Material:** Dig up bulbs such as dahlias, Canna Lilies and geraniums. Store in a cool and dry place to stave off bulb rot. It is so disappointing in springtime to find theses prized bulbs rotting and mouldy.

**Fall Pruning:** Prune off any dead areas of all trees and shrubs, but be careful to not prune for shape on your spring-flowering woody plants – you will be cutting off their spring blooms.

**Wrap Tender Trees And Shrubs:** Wrap marginal plant material and evergreens prone to ice/salt and snow damage, but be careful not to wrap too tightly. I have seen many plants smothered and choked by being bound too tightly and not getting the wrap off early enough in spring. Myself, I try to choose plant life that is well suited to the area it lives, therefore I rarely have to wrap.

**Remove Annuals:** Remove spent annuals; you will not miss them as they look overgrown and messy at this time of year anyhow. The seeds from some annuals such as poppies and Scarlet Runner Beans can be saved to plant directly next spring.

**Cut Back Herbaceous Plant Material:** The cutting back and removal of herbaceous plant material makes for an easier spring clean and protects plants from the spread of disease. It is also important to remove any diseased leaves of deciduous shrubs and trees from your garden beds for the same reason. I think leaving some seed heads of perennials such as Purple Coneflower and many ornamental grasses makes the winter garden look great and provides food for wildlife as well.

**Plant Or Transplant Hardy Perennials:** Fall is the perfect time to move hardy perennials as they don't go through that "newly transplanted" look for long and next year they will emerge like they have always been there.

**Rake Leaves:** We all know to rake our leaves off the lawn in fall, but it is crucial to do it promptly as to not smother the grass beneath. Remove fruit tree fallings as well for they will attract wasps. Leaving some leaves in garden beds helps protect plants by insulating against the freeze and thaw that is so detrimental to vegetation. And if you have the room, why not start composting those leaves!

**Plant Spring Bulbs:** It may be hard to think of spring when the garden is looking so tired, but now is the time to plan for and plant spring bulbs. Spring bulbs need to be planted in large groups, and placed near perennials that will mask their associated die back foliage. Small bulbs are best positioned near paths so their delicate beauty will be noticed. I prefer bulbs that are perennial, such as daffodils, Species Tulips and crocuses for they are lower maintenance and multiply. And don't forget about fall crocus if your garden needs a splash of colour at this time of the year!

Winter gives the opportunity to assess what your landscape looks like without deciduous leaves or flowers. Evergreens and trees with interesting bark or form take centre stage. The winter garden is often forgotten, but is ultra important in a climate like ours! Plant Emerald Cedars near your front door to make a great spot for Christmas lights, or add soft spreading yews where you need a horizontal habit. Paperbark Maple, London Planetree and River Birch all have very interesting bark when stripped of their leaves. Corkscrew Hazel looks even better in winter than in the summer with its unique curly branching. The berries of Highbush Cranberry, Mountain Ash and Serviceberry provide food for wildlife and add colourful interest.

The landscape takes on a stark but restful state as winter weather closes in. Enjoy this time, sleep long and restful and plan for the upcoming year. It will be here before you know it.  $\mbox{oh}$

# ENSURING YOUR INSURANCE

Catastrophes across the world have put the insurance industry under a spotlight over the past few years, with typhoons in Thailand, hurricanes along the U.S. Gulf Coast and earthquakes in Chile, just to name a few.

Homeowners may feel a sense of panic when empathizing with families in these unfortunate locales, but what level of insurance is reasonable when dealing with the kinds of weather-related emergencies that we experience in Ontario? Typhoons and hurricanes don't affect us, but landslides, floods, blizzards or tornadoes can and do happen regularly.

How much home insurance is enough?

"You need enough insurance to rebuild from the ground up, including debris removal," says Kevin Hodgins, secretary-treasurer, Southwestern Ontario Chapter, Insurance Institute of Ontario. This could be more than the price of your home because of the economies of scale: contractors get good deals on labour and material when building many homes at the same time, but rebuilding one home can cost much more.

Or it could cost less, according to Brian Maltman, executive director at General Insurance OmbudService. "You get overheated markets like Toronto, where homes in some parts of the city are selling for many times (more than) what it would take to rebuild them."

How much is too much?

No one wants to be "insurance poor," but being seriously over-insured is almost guaranteed not to happen, according to Maltman, because of the way insurance companies calculate the replacement value of your house.

What kinds of insurance do I need?

A package or comprehensive policy ensures that the building itself is insured, as well as the contents and the mortgage are all covered. Other types of coverage are also part of a comprehensive policy, like riders on special items or items of greater value. This type of policy also usually includes liability insurance.

Contents insurance is limited, according to Maltman, so it's a good idea to have expensive jewelry appraised (or other items that fall outside the normal range of value for your type of house) and covered with a rider.

"Be aware that there are limitations on things like jewelry, furs, computer software, collector items – and sometimes even bicycles and silverware. Go over the limitations with your agent or broker," urges Hodgins.

Mortgage insurance ensures that the lender is covered in the case of injury or death of one or more of the owners. It can also ensure that the house is paid off through insurance, so as not to be a burden to the

surviving spouse.

One million dollars is the usual amount for liability within most comprehensive policies. This protects the homeowner in case someone is injured on their property. Some policies include \$2 million liability coverage.

What's not covered?

"Floods," says Maltman. "Because they are predictable (in some areas) and because they usually involve many houses."

He says, however, a flood due to a sewer back-up is usually covered by comprehensive policies.

What about deductibles?

A higher deductible means a lower premium and vice versa. This is because most claims are on the lower end, says Maltman. "Ask yourself, 'Could I afford to pay that first \$1,000 (if that's your deductible amount)?' That's the first question," he adds. If the answer is no, a \$1,000 payout would be tough, go with a lower deductible and higher premium.

What questions should I ask?

When buying a new home: "Question the seller about any water-related losses. If they have occurred, ask what steps were taken to ensure it wouldn't happen again," says Hodgins.

When renewing insurance annually: "Ask yourself if there's anything you should talk over with your broker or agent," cautions Maltman. Have you done extensive renovations that would affect the replacement cost of your home; have you purchased expensive art or jewelry; has anything changed in your home in the past year?


What should I be aware of?

There are discounts allowed if you have fire or burglary protection systems, being mortgage free and often for insuring your house and car with the same insurer, according to Hodgins.

The bottom line

"There are discounts for being and remaining claims free, so consider your insurance as protecting against disasters rather than a home maintenance policy," says Hodgins. **OH**

# A CCCC FROM EVERY ROOM

After 13 work-related moves, living temporarily in places like Edmonton, Sault Ste. Marie and Ottawa, these homeowners decided 10 years ago it was time to settle for good in the Cedar Ridge area. When they first purchased the two-and-a-half acre lot with 317 feet of water frontage, "it was all wooded and you can't believe you're ever going to make anything of it when all you see is bush and fallen trees." 






















Doug Plumb (Plumb Designs), designed a perfect layout; builder Gerard Forget (Forget Construction Ltd.) made the layout a beautiful reality and Angelo DeCola (DeCola Windows + Doors) sourced and delivered all the windows and doors exactly as the homeowners wished – no small feat for any of them since all they had to go on was magazine pictures and a verbal wish list from the homeowners.

She says, "I knew what I wanted in the house; I knew what I didn't like and what I did like and there were things in all my previous houses that I incorporated into this house." She showed Plumb a magazine picture of the perfect house exterior and he used that but designed a completely different house inside, including the open spaces and large windows

the homeowners liked. He also used several different ceiling styles in the home: a barrel ceiling in the sunroom, tray ceiling in the kitchen and soaring cathedral ceilings in the main living areas.

She continues with praise for the builder: "Gerard (Forget) is the best builder, I swear to God! It was a little less than a year from the time he started until we moved in and we just loved him the whole time. I can't tell you how happy we were with him. If I couldn't visualize something like the dining room, or I just couldn't see how the ceiling was going to work, he would do mock ups."

Angelo DeCola adds, "I've never met a more organized contractor than Gerard Forget. He was on-site and he scheduled the trades so that none of them overlapped. Doug Plumb is really good at drawing something functional and structural that you can actually build. Sometimes what you draw and what works are different but we understand each other and we all worked very well together as a team." This kind of seamless collaboration makes the homebuilding process look easy and the homeowners count themselves very lucky indeed to have procured the services of Forget, Plumb and DeCola.

Midland **TIM-BR Mart** supplied the lumber, the roof and siding. The couple also relied heavily on local trades – **Georgian Kitchen Centre** did the kitchen, granite countertops and bathroom, and also finished many other areas of the house with built-ins and shelving. A clever use of space is the hidden cabinets under the roofline in the guest room and guest bath above the garage. *Continued on page 78*






