





With watermelons and popsicles a distant memory, it's time to forecast the upcoming trends for 2013. Ironically, when I look at the number "2013," I think of space travel and futuristic design. Maybe we're not quite there, but we are definitely heavy on industrial style - metals, glass and a whole lot of technology and innovation.

Have designers been drawing inspiration from manufacturing plants? Not sure. But we will certainly be able to decorate our homes to look like one.

#### **METALS**

Hot rolled, cold rolled, powder coated, you name it; steel is an unbreakable trend. Tables, chairs, tiles; the industrial trend is becoming more refined than factory, but the presence of steel will be huge.



Another metal that will continue to make its comeback is brushed brass. Not the shiny kind. That disappeared after the financial crisis in the 80s. Brass evokes quality and timelessness. Cabinet hardware, faucets, lighting; brushed nickel hasn't gone by the wayside, but we now have a serious contender.

#### WALL COVERINGS

Poor old paint may just not be enough anymore. Glass, leather, metals and wallpaper are just some of the wall cladding we'll see in the upcoming year. Using back-painted glass panels in a shower creates a completely seamless wall leaving you with a translucent feel and no grout lines. Leather tiles will also become more popular as a wall material (and floor, actually) adding richness and texture to an otherwise drab piece of drywall. It's becoming available in several patterns and colours taking the place of wallpaper for a slightly more luxurious effect.





Between Trisha Bowman's nine years of real estate experience, husband Tim Perry's five years as a

of real estate experience, husband Tim Perry's five years as a custom builder at **Perry Custom Homes** and five moves in the last decade, the couple figures they've finally got every detail right in this stunning south Barrie home. "My design style is definitely traditional but we also tried to go very beachy and serene with a little bit of rustic to try to make the house feel a little more lived in," says Bowman, a Realtor at **Century 21 B.J. Roth Realty Ltd.** 

The open concept on the main floor ensures unobstructed sightlines throughout, and the soothing soft grey walls and warm white trim train the eye on the beautiful view through large windows (by **Strassburger Windows & Doors**) along the back of the house. With a solid treeline for privacy, a large travertine natural stone patio with hot tub, built-in barbecue and pool, the backyard is a family

oasis. A trampoline and play area for five-year-old Mackenzie, plus a space for a winter skating rink that doubles as a summer volleyball court, are tucked into the corners of the one-and-a-half acre lot.

This is the first time the family has lived in a two-storey home. "We are accustomed to bungalows but with this home, we wanted a different feel," says Perry, a professional engineer and Century 21 realtor who was also, of course, the general contractor and builder. They liked the idea of entertaining on the main floor of their 3,990 sq. ft. home and having all four bedrooms together on the second floor, along with a loft area where Mackenzie and her friends can play and be as noisy as they like while the adults enjoy relative peace and quiet downstairs. The entire design is unified by custom-stained oak floors upstairs and down by Majestic North Floors Inc.; installation by Darek Stapinski. Built-in units in most rooms throughout the house keep things neat and organized.

The kitchen look is classic Hamptons style – white and fresh – with soaring nine-foot cabinets, lots of moulding details and panelled fridge doors. This is the second time the couple has hired <code>Diane Smith</code> of <code>KitchenArt North</code> to design their kitchen. "I was really happy with Diane the first time so we contacted her again," Bowman says. "Diane is very good at understanding the space required for a good kitchen and she knew what would work here."

The couple particularly likes the clean lines generated by concealing the fridge and dishwasher behind white cabinetry, which visually enlarges the space. A large wall of glass, display cabinets for the couple's good dishes, is given depth with an interior coat of dark pewter paint. Bowman and Perry chose light fixtures from **Glass Lighting Gallery** and Restoration Hardware and selected marble countertops from Moscone and **Artistic Stone Design**. *Continued on page* 32

"Trish really did her homework prior to our first meeting and had a very clear idea of the look she wanted to achieve," Smith says. "She made an idea book of pictures torn from magazines that she showed me and right off the bat I knew exactly which direction she wanted to go in. It just happened to be a style that I personally love too, so it made the entire design process very enjoyable."

The exterior of the house is cedar shakes stained in Beachwood Grey with pristine white trim. Bowman says the inspiration for the exterior design and colour came from the 2010 Princess Margaret Dream Home, designed by Lynda Reeves of *Canadian House & Home*. "We loved the front elevation of that house but that design didn't have a loft above the garage nor did the layout work for us and I felt it looked more proportioned with (the loft)," Perry says. All the interior and exterior trim work in the house was designed by Perry with interior work by **LT Woodcraft Carpentry**.

Bowman says they went through a lot of design options and mock-ups for the trim and built-in units. Perry adds, "They may cost a little extra but they are worth it for the future aggravation they save. Instead of going ahead and finishing something right through to completion and then saying 'I don't like that,' build a small sample and make sure you are happy with it. We even did mock-ups with the trim on the exterior, which resulted in a lot of changes on the fly but ultimately added a lot of extra character to the home."




The couple figured Holly, their two-year old long-haired Australian Shepherd, would track in a lot of the mud that comes with a freshly graded un-sodded lot so they installed a tiny shower under the mudroom stairs. "That's the one thing that every trade that walked through this house commented about," laughs Perry. "I really didn't think (the shower) was going to get used but I was completely wrong." Aside from rinsing muddy paws, the shower is perfect for cleaning recycling bins or beverage coolers. All plumbing fixtures in the house from Yorkwest Plumbing Inc. were installed by Roger's Plumbing.

The family is looking forward to celebrating Christmas in their new home, with all of Bowman's extended family coming for games and dinner around the massive 14-foot dining table made from salvaged wood. They're also planning a traditional Christmas Eve viewing of *The Polar Express* in the lower level theatre room. *Continued on page 36*








# RAISING THE BAR

Bill Mullen has high hopes! The Ontario-based home inspector is also the director of external relations for a new organization, the National Home Inspector Certification Council (NHICC).

The NHICC is pushing for nation-wide licensing of home inspectors, but at this time Ontario, the Atlantic Provinces and Saskatchewan are just looking at this possibility.

Alberta and British Columbia already license home and property inspectors. B.C. led the way, endorsing inspectors since April 1, 2009, while Alberta came onside September 1, 2011. Neither of these came about without a lot of pushing from interest groups within those provinces, and Mullen doesn't expect it to be much different in Ontario, though he hopes that the timeframe to have licensing passed into law could be shortened because of the groundwork done by those first two provinces.

According to Peter Link, manager of house and property inspection registration for the Applied Science Technologists and Technicians of B.C. (ASTTBC), his organization lobbied for two decades to make this happen.

Helene Barton, Executive Director of the B.C. branch of the Canadian Association of Home and Property & Inspectors, (CAHPI), agrees. "We lobbied the government for eight years to have our industry regulated because prior to that anyone who bought a ladder and had a business card could say they were a home inspector. Many were charlatans."

Though there are training courses and college programs in all provinces, in most provinces there is no onus on someone who calls him/herself a home inspector to take such education. In the two provinces that currently license, the several certifying organizations that exist require some or all of the following to become licensed: specialized education (number of hours varies from organization to organization), a practical (or field) test, written exam, a peer inspection process, and, finally, an application to the



provincial licensing body. In the case of B.C., that's Consumer Protection B.C. For Alberta, it's Service Alberta. The outcome of the application process is not ideal, according to Darcy McGregor, secretary and founding member of CAHPI Alberta. "We thought they (the government) would raise everyone to the highest level, like our members follow, but they said that wouldn't be fair."

While the expectations aren't as high as he'd like, McGregor says, "Licensing at least gives homeowners a bit more assurance that the person they are dealing with has some education and the ability to look after them as a home inspector."

Link echoes this sentiment: "We pushed for one certifying organization and one standard of practice, but there are four in B.C." So buyer beware is still in force, and homeowners must research any home inspector they are thinking of hiring. "The onus is still on the homeowner. (They should ask) where did they get their education; do they have experience in the field to have the ability to recognize problems."

Barton, though, feels that the process has been overall positive. "It got rid of a lot of people who are unqualified. We are still trying to get the consumer to ask about the licence before hiring a home inspector. It gives them peace of mind knowing that they (inspectors) are qualified."

Though there is mixed reaction to the outcomes in B.C. and Alberta, there's one point that McGregor, Link and Barton all agree on – home inspectors in those provinces are now required to carry errors and omissions insurance. They must be insured up to \$1 million, so if they miss something during an inspection and this results in a costly repair, the homeowner may have financial recourse.

One piece of the puzzle that is still missing, according to Nigel Trevethan, of Harper Grey LLP and legal counsel for CAHPI B.C., is a "cooling off period, like many other large purchases." He thinks it's regrettable that the "government hasn't mandated that every real estate transaction must involve a home inspection. This is especially important in an overheated housing market, like Vancouver." He feels that this is key to consumer protection.

So, though Mullen's hopes for the future of licensing in Ontario – and throughout the country – are high, experience tells us that the outcome may be less than stellar but better than the status quo. **OH**

# ALMOND GINGER CHOCOLATE BARK + lots of topping variations

Every year about this time, as the mercury drops and the days get shorter, my mind naturally turns to the fast-approaching holiday season. And one of my favourite holiday traditions is poring over cookbooks looking for inspiration for this year's homemade gifts from my kitchen. Nothing is sweeter than stirring, swirling and baking up tasty treats to wrap and deliver to friends, family, co-workers, teachers and other special folks in my life. While the cookies, candies and breads I bake may vary from year to year, a staple gift from my kitchen is chocolate bark. It's appealing because of its simplicity and opportunity for variations. Plus, it's chocolate – and who doesn't love the gift of chocolate?

There are few ingredients involved, so I like to splurge a little and choose the best chocolate I can find. Dark chocolate is my favourite base for bark – its rich, deep flavour complements the roasted nuts and sweet fruits that dot the surface. But milk chocolate and white chocolate (or perhaps all three!) work wonderfully as well. As for the nuts and fruit, anything goes. Peanuts, cashews, pecans, pistachios, hazelnuts, apricots, cranberries, raisins, cookie bits, candy pieces, pretzels, marshmallows – you get the point! Stick to three toppings at most so that each flavour gets a chance to shine without getting muddled in the mix.

For this year's bark, I'm going with the combination of dark chocolate, almonds and candied ginger – a little bit toasty, a little bit spicy and perfectly decadent. Happy holidays!

#### **ALMOND GINGER CHOCOLATE BARK**

(Makes: about 20 pieces)

1 lb (450 g) dark chocolate, chopped


3/4 cup toasted whole almonds, coarsely chopped

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup candied ginger, thinly sliced

- Melt chocolate in a heatproof bowl set over a pot of gently simmering water, stirring often until smooth.
- Stir in about one third of each of the almonds and candied ginger. Pour mixture onto parchment paperlined baking sheet and gently spread with the back of a spoon until about an even scant ½-inch (1 cm) thickness.
- Sprinkle with remaining almonds and candied ginger.
- Refrigerate until solid, about 20 minutes. Break or cut into pieces.
- The bark will keep refrigerated in an airtight container for about 1 week.
- · For gift giving, package as desired.

#### **VARIATION:**

Pistachio Cranberry
Apricot Swirl Bark - Melt
separately 10 oz. (280 g) dark
chocolate and 6 oz. (170 g) white
chocolate. Stir one third of each: ¾
cup roasted shelled pistachios, ¼ cup
dried apricots, quartered and ⅓ cup dried
cranberries into the melted dark chocolate.
Spread onto baking sheet. Drizzle with
melted white chocolate. Use toothpick,
skewer, or back of knife to swirl the
chocolates together. Sprinkle with
remaining pistachios, apricots and



Whether you're from Canada or not, it's hard for anyone not to be inspired by the True North and its beautiful elements, which we are lucky enough to find in our own backyard, the great outdoors.

### Here are my three favourite ways to incorporate our heritage into our homes.

1. THE USE OF FABRIC: Add Canadian character and charm to your home with the simple use of textiles.

Plaid Upholstery: Whether it be gingham, tartan, or tattersall, this popular pattern consisting of several crossed horizontal and vertical lines (usually in two or more colours) speaks directly to the essence of Canadian settlers. Designer Terri Clark opened up the family room and sunroom, allowing a clear view of Lake Couchiching. The redesigned space has texture, colour, a new quartz wall with a fireplace from Napoleon Home Comfort, plus custom chairs and sofas wrapped in luxurious fabrics.



After living more than a decade in their waterfront house, this Orillia couple is finally coming home. Free from the demands of young children and an entrepreneurial lifestyle, these new retirees and empty-nesters began a multi-phase renovation that is just for them. "The house, while it was physically what we wanted, had tired finishes," agree the homeowners. "We wanted something far more contemporary."

"It was crying out for an update," concurs **Terri Clark**, the founder of **Terri Clark Interiors Inc.**, who was brought in to help two years ago. A consultation later, she knew a style abundant with straight edges and unobstructed sightlines would work best with the house and its owners. Little did they know that first meeting would begin an ongoing

relationship to overhaul the entire house, and lead to a close collaboration as the team travelled together to handpick each fixture and accessory.

"The games room was the preface," smiles Terri of the second-storey environment she helped raise from a pre-teen refuge to an adult haven. She swapped out the traditional green felt on the billiard table for a neutral tan to harmonize with the golden walls and leave the focus on the table itself and the themed chandelier above. Natural light from a double row of skylights on the peaked ceiling augments the glow from an octagonal accent window on the end wall of this long room. Custom built-ins from **Absolute Cabinets** coordinate with refurbished components to create several distinct but connected conversational areas. Flowing seamlessly around the games table are a bar with wine cooler, an office space, and a lounge with comfortable seating for a good chat or a good view of the large flat-screen plasma TV.

"The main floor started as the powder room and potentially the kitchen," says Terri, whose mantra became "texture," as she took every opportunity to create layers of interest in the growing project.

The foyer's enlarged powder room is now actually a three-piece bath featuring a roomy glass-enclosed shower with a built-in stone niche and rainforest showerhead (plumbing by **Derbecker Plumbing & Heating**). The spa-like retreat, washed in Benjamin Moore's Ashley Gray by Orillia's **Beitz Painting & Decorating**, was updated with moulded-panel doors and a tumbled marble backsplash with tiles sized to mimic the ledgestone dry-stacked quartz fireplace in the adjacent family room.


Set atop refinished walnut-stained oak flooring, the massive floor-to-ceiling square fireplace – unadorned by hearth or mantel – is warmed by a gas fireplace from **Napoleon Home Comfort** and flanked by custom built-ins (Absolute Cabinets). The grey walls and crown moulding point to a windowed sunroom showcasing Big Chief Island and surrounding waters.

Gone are the french doors and transom that once separated the two rooms, allowing both to benefit from the light and view. Simple sheers, plush furniture, including a smart sectional and textured throw cushions, soften the boxy construction of the sunroom while providing a finish that maintains the desired design concept. Skylights and glass doors to the deck complete the illusion of having already stepped outside.

With the removal of two more sets of french doors, the family room also opens to the large kitchen (also by Absolute Cabinets) and dining room/living room beyond, all tied together with Benjamin Moore's Quincy Tan. With a nod to the Cape Cod ambience, a tongue-and-groove ceiling was installed in the kitchen and painted the blue-grey Pilgrim Haze.

Large travertine flooring tiles and granite countertops sparkle under the plethora of pot lights installed by **Belcourt Electric**. The kitchen's dry-stacked quartz backsplash mirrors its counterpart in the powder room to add yet another natural finish, contrasting with tone-on-tone cabinetry that provides ample storage, display shelves and work stations. A large island, a bar counter and kitchen table have become destinations. *Continued on page* 60

Pulling the palette together for the entire first floor is the fabric from the window treatments in the dining room/living room: a Brunschwig & Fils pattern that melds cream and green with red and blue. The design team now laughingly agrees it was worth the over-long wait for the French import.

"We really fell in love with it," said Terri. "It was the jumping-off point." A second square fireplace, this one smaller and wood-burning, provides a focal point for this dual-purpose room, although the sumptuousness of a table by **Bateman Custom Furniture & Cabinetry** anchors the dining room décor. Dried and fresh florals from **Street's Flowers** complete the look.

"I just feel good when I walk in here," smiles the lady of the new manor as she looks around. "I'm very proud of it. I think it's relaxing..."





# This holiday season, OUR HOMES returns to a favourite

home originally featured in our Spring 2010 issue. The home has new owners and a totally new, natural, more traditional style, thanks to designer **Catherine Staples** and her team at **Staples Design Group**, a full service Barrie design centre that offers everything from concept development and floor plans to custom furniture, unique accessories and artwork.

The house was originally built in 2008 and the exterior was perfect, with taupe siding, white trim with grey-taupe stone that the new owners liked and kept. The interior, however, was far too modern. The new owners asked for and got, a cosy, relaxed home that fits the way they live.

"(The original design) was very contemporary, so we softened it, giving it more of a coastal beach feel," Catherine Staples says. "The clients wanted it to be comfortable and casual, not formal."

The location offers a spectacular view of Kempenfelt Bay and Staples says, "The lake view really inspired the interior so we used natural colours and brought in blue tones and taupes from outside." The sweeping staircase was painted in a more traditional style than its previous monochrome pale grey by using black on the treads and handrails with contrasting white spools. 
"Just changing the furniture to a more traditional palette gave the space a whole new look," adds Catherine. "It really suits the architecture of the home. We carefully edited the furnishings with subtle patterns to give the formal space a casual appeal. The architectural details throughout the house called for understated furniture." Several pieces are from Stanley Furniture, which is also available through Staples Design Group. The resulting look is very streamlined and uncluttered, and the white panelling keeps the design clean and cohesive throughout. Continued on page 78

The new owners asked Staples Design to finish the basement. With a blank space, Staples Design added panelled walls and painted them white to match the built-ins and coffered ceiling, adding an upscale finish to the space. Furnishings are neutral and oh so comfortable. The sectional is a perfect fit.







The design team's philosophy is modern simplicity and Staples also endorses a practical approach to a redesign. "For example, the original bar stools were black leather and very contemporary, so we created slip covers, which changes the whole look without having to get new bar stools," she says. "That's practical and it also makes them more beautiful." Catherine advises giving what you already have a whole new life, whether with paint colour or by changing certain elements. With this in mind Catherine used some of the clients' original French Country furniture in the home by simply tweaking it. "We did incorporate the antique carved table but we changed the chairs," she says.

The coastal nautical theme continues with large marine-style pendant

lighting from Restoration Hardware over the kitchen island. "We also changed out all the lighting fixtures to give it a more traditional feel," she says. All electrical work was done by **DH Enterprises**.

"Ilike all the natural elements and the monochromatic colour scheme," she says. "The limestone, the wood floors, the iron lighting and different textures really work to keep it simple." The limestone floors in the entryway and powder room are heated for winter comfort.


The basement was a blank slate, completely unfinished and ready for the design team to work its magic. "We designed the custom cabinetry (on the built-ins) and we carried the panelling that was a special part of the main floor area down through the basement," Catherine

explains. The basement bar cabinetry was done by **Strongman Custom Woodworking** and all other carpentry was completed by **Cut to Fit Carpentry**. The lower level has lots of large windows to provide natural light with nine-foot high, white, coffered ceilings. She adds, "It doesn't feel like a basement."

The downstairs area includes a guest bedroom and bathroom, a theatre area, a custom bar and entertainment area plus a storage room for off-season items. The downstairs bathroom includes shower glass by **RCM Glass & Mirror Ltd.** All plumbing was completed by **Plumbtech Plumbing Inc.** Since an engineered floor can be installed directly onto concrete, the hardwood floors extend into the basement. *Continued on page 80* 

When meeting with clients for the first time Catherine says, "We like to bring the personality of the client into the space so we'll take them through a bunch of different exercises and they tell us what they like or what they don't like and we start to get a feel for it. The client doesn't always know what they're looking for but we can pick up on it through these exercises. That, ultimately, is what they get (in a home design); we don't design a particular look, it depends on the client. How they function in the space is really important, too. We always ask about, for example, how they see themselves living and enjoying the basement, and how do they want to use the space – then we design it for that use so it's practical." OH


