



# PAPER possibilities

Every so often I look around my home and wish that I had covered every wall in grasscloth and over-painted in white. It would achieve an aged look like a charming farmhouse in the English countryside and I would never have to think about my walls again. Of course, I would. And how could you not with all of the wonderful wallpapers on offer?

We've seen enough traditional wallpaper to know that it can be beautiful in the right setting and withstand the test of time, so you will see no toile or damask on this page. But will you be happy with your walls in time or will they age quickly with some of the newer, more daring designs? Wallpapering can always be stripped away and re-painted (or re-papered) but the expense would be a shame, so choose wisely.

Manufacturers will provide samples to take home and look at in situ. What you see online or in a showroom does not always translate well at home so take advantage of this service and make sure you're happy with the colour and the pattern.

When you're ready to take the plunge, think of two things: What am I trying to achieve? How can I achieve it?





Designer Stephanie Redmond answers your questions.

#### WALLPAPERING SCENARIO 1

**Dilemma:** I would like to see a bold change in my modern dining room. **Advice:** Use a daring pattern on one wall to create a visual pop when entering the room.

I have never been a fan of the "accent wall" but it does apply in some cases. Take this Cole & Son geometric (1) which gives the effect of a colourful kaleidoscope. It is shocking and the scale enormous, but it could be stunning paired with all things simple to tone it down. For something less extreme, try Trove wallpapers. Again, the scale is huge, but the pattern, a little softer (and easier to apply on all walls if you choose). My favourite is Auva in blue (2). You would certainly have no need for art!

#### WALLPAPERING SCENARIO 2

Dilemma: I would like to add warmth to my den.

**Advice:** Choose a paper-backed linen or a finely textured grasscloth and apply to all walls.

Applying texture to walls gives a sense of being enveloped in a room. It creates warmth and a cosiness that you can't achieve with a flat paint. And there are limitless possibilities when it comes to textures – try Phillip Jeffries' Manila Hemp (3) or Tapetex's Espada Linen (4). If seeing the seaming will bother you, steer clear of grasscloth and opt for a paperbacked fabric instead. The seams are tighter and inconspicuous. It's admittedly, my favourite treatment.

#### WALLPAPERING SCENARIO 3

**Dilemma:** I would like to make my bookshelves appear more interesting and less bare.

Advice: Use a small-scale pattern to create a visually interesting backdrop.

Choose a classic like Farrow & Ball's Polka Square (5), whose gold dots will add a bit of glam to the setting. Or try Galbraith & Paul's Small Star (6) for a contemporary twist on classic patterning. This would create a beautiful backdrop highlighting the items placed in front. Of course, when choosing your paper, keep in mind what you intend to place on the shelves. If the objects are ornate, be sure to tone down the backdrop.

Wallpapering never really went away, but with the advancement of printing techniques and the popularity of home decorating we've certainly seen an incredible array of new designs. It's exciting and the applications are endless. The only trouble with wallpapering is, once you commit to one area, the remaining walls seem nude by comparison! **OH**







The before picture shows a nondescript brown ranch bungalow, the sparse lawn dotted with weeds and no garden to speak of, yet in the background the promise of a big sky over wide open water beckons. Originally a boathouse built in the early 1950s, the dwelling was converted into a cottage several years later and its location—nestled right beside the shoreline of Lake Simcoe—made it ideal for a potential guest cottage for the Walton family, who own a larger cottage next door. Marilyn and Howard Walton spend their summers here and the decision to spruce up the small home for guests was easy. Choosing the designer to do it was equally simple.

**Elke Bradford** of **Designers Plus Kitchen & Bath** has been in the design industry, along with her husband Jim, for 37 years and she had already redone the main cottage for the Waltons. "Having worked with Elke in the past and loving her work I was totally confident in putting this project in her hands," Marilyn says. At first it was going to be a simple renovation; small improvements meant to modernize and perk it up. But the bungalow needed some structural changes – there was no entrance from the waterfront to the cottage, interior doorway heights were too low and the roofline needed to be changed, plus there was a five-inch difference in floor height from one end to the other.





Once it became apparent that the structural changes would create a blank canvas, Elke asked Marilyn what she would like to have done. "Marilyn handed me the cottage keys and said, 'surprise me,' which was wonderful," says Elke. Because Elke and Marilyn had worked together on other Walton residences in the past, Marilyn was comfortable putting the entire design into Elke's hands, and Elke was comfortable taking on the task because she was familiar with the Walton family's taste.

"When I did her main cottage a few years ago I had a good understanding of what she would like except I wanted the guest cottage to be different," she explains. The main cottage has a Muskoka look and feel and Elke was thinking that the smaller guest cottage would be a perfect fit for a more edgy "Malibu North" look. The end result is absolutely stunning.

The once-decrepit lawn has been replaced with shapely stone, winding pathways and perennial gardens by **Zeng Landscaping** in Creemore. Pillars with a solid stone base frame the orange doorway and the roofline is completely different, with a new peak that adds much-needed curb

appeal to the waterfront dwelling. Stately cedars outline the property and the exterior paint colour, a customized version of Benjamin Moore's Metropolis, makes the residence pop but is still subtle enough to fit perfectly within its frame of trees, stone, sky and water.

Since the guest cottage used to be a boathouse it's only steps away from the water, something Elke kept in mind when she considered tearing the place down or renovating it where it stood. "That was the beauty of this building," she says. "Had we torn it down we would have needed to go much further back from the shore to rebuild." The structural changes and new design as envisioned by Elke were completed by Barrie contractor **John Raimondi** of **Meridian Design Build Inc.** 

Designers Plus supplied and installed the kitchen backsplash and bathroom tile, including a wavy, shoreline-shaped pebble tile that embraces the wall around the tub in the guest bath. Elke likes to colour match so all of the paint colours are custom mixed from Benjamin Moore's Aura line supplied by **Sue Kay & Company** at **Allandale Decorating Centre**.

Marilyn also asked Elke to furnish the guest cottage, which is not normally something Elke is involved with, and she was thrilled to take on the task with her design team. Guests can sit and enjoy a cup of coffee in white leather swan chairs in the family room that swivel to face either the magnificent waterscape or the beautiful modern marble fireplace. The family room also boasts several solar tubes – clear inserts in the roof that bring natural light into the room – and the roller blinds are by **Salnek's Custom Window Treatments** in Barrie.

All the bedroom furniture and linens were supplied by Designers Plus and Elke also added beach features like a bedside glass lamp filled with sand and pebbles. A credenza from Crate & Barrel was hand-finished by Elke in a weathered grey wash to complement the driftwood colour of the wood floors throughout the cottage. "The colour scheme really started with the

floor, which is a hand-scraped driftwood stain," Elke says. All of the wall colours, from the kitchen's Blue Echo to the bathroom's serene Crystalline plus the exterior colours were customized by Elke and her team.

The kitchen and bathroom cabinetry and fixtures were ordered through Designers Plus and all of the light fixtures were purchased through Restoration Hardware. Some of the items, like the kitchen stools, took many months to arrive but Elke says she looks at delays this way: "You have a choice; you can go to choice number two or you can stay with your first choice, which you know is the right choice, and wait a little longer but have a very happy client."

Elke wanted the guest cottage to be upscale but also feel homey, so the Walton family and friends would feel comfortable and want to stay there. According to the homeowners, she succeeded in spades. Marilyn says,

"Elke and her team were so great to deal with, from their exquisite taste and great ideas to their excitement upon completion. They don't just get the job done they treat it as if it was their own. Their trades are excellent as well, which is so important in the finished product."

Marilyn and Howard are completely happy with the finished guest cottage – so much so that Elke and her design team have undertaken a renovation on their Toronto home – and they look forward to hosting family in the cottage this spring and summer. Marilyn says, "We love our guest cottage. Our sons are presently using and enjoying it so much."

While Designers Plus usually has about 15 to 20 jobs in various stages of completion on the go, Elke says, "The most enjoyable thing about those jobs is the people." Obviously, from Marilyn's perspective, the feeling is completely mutual. **OH**



# STORY AND PHOTOS BY MELANIE REKOLA OF THE SPRING FOREST

Here in Canada the early spring forest is a wet and muddy affair. But don't let that deter you from donning your rubber boots, grabbing your camera and exploring the diverse life that inhabits our local forests. You must seek forest flowers early in springtime as they need the sunlight available in early spring to develop; before the tree leaves come to choke out the forest-floor light. From native orchids to tiny carnivorous sundews, we are fortunate to have our diverse ecosystem. Keep on the lookout for these native beauties; as well as a perfectly preserved paw print or two!







**Spring Beauty:** A dainty beauty with weak stems bearing white or pink blooms with deeper pink veins. The plant prefers moist soil and disappears entirely after flowering. The flowers close at night, during storms or cloudy weather, just like tulips and dandelions.



**Trillium:** Probably the showiest of the spring forest and Ontario's provincial flower. The whole plant dies down and disappears after flowering. Though you can pick this flower if it's on your property, remember that it may take up to five years for the seed to germinate and the plant to flower. Large-flowered trillium seeds are usually dispersed by ants. The ants carry the seed to their nest to feed their larvae, which is afterwards discarded in the ants' nutrient-rich waste pile. The seed has a much greater likelihood of survival placed in such an area.

#### THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPORTANCE OF THE FOREST

It is said that the forests are the "lungs of the Earth." Canada has 10 per cent of these lungs! Trees and forest ecosystems are tremendously important for our environment.

#### Trees can:

- Reduce the effects of climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide gases that contribute to the "greenhouse effect"
- Conserve energy by reducing heating (by buffering cold winter winds) and cooling costs (by shading buildings in the summer) by up to 50 per cent
- Give people a psychological boost (studies show they make us feel good)
- Increase our property values by up to 20 per cent
- Provide wildlife a place to live
- Reduce sedimentation and regulate flooding and drought periods
- Provide us with food
- Reduce "Heat Island" effect
- Reduce waste water impact on storm drains

Let us all take part in preserving this irreplaceable treasure. Plant native trees and plants wherever you live, leave nature as you find it and why not take an extra bag when you hike and pick up after those who take for granted our special space on this fine Earth. You'll enjoy your walk even more the next time if it's garbage free!









Lady's Slipper: Can be yellow or pink and is in the orchid family. Kids love this exotic looking plant and it actually resembles a lady's slipper. If you do happen upon one, please do not disturb as they are rare and will likely not survive a transplant.



Sundews: The common sundew is a small carnivorous plant with narrow, hairy leaves. These plants feed on insects! They produce a sweet and glistening "mucilage" that covers its leaves, attracting insects. The insects then get stuck in this mucilage, the plant dissolves the insect and then absorbs its resulting nutrient.



**Trout Lily:** Another plant whose seeds are dispersed by ants. The bloom is a clear and happy shade of yellow, with long elegant petals. Its flowers open in midday sun and it only has two leaves, which resemble the skin pattern of a brook trout! **OH** 





# PLANNING YOUR CUSTOM HOME

Building a custom home was such a pleasure that Sheri and James Cox say they'd do it again. "We are thrilled with our home," says Sheri. "It is exactly everything we wanted and then some."

Distler Construction Ltd. built the Cox's five-bedroom house on Georgian Bay. "We explained to them the features we wanted in a home and they came up with a plan for a home that would suit the lot and had everything in it that we wanted," says Sheri. She and James like their surroundings to be unique and special to them. "That's why we went custom. There is no other home like ours out there. It is tailored to our lot. It is tailored to our family," says the mother of three children, aged 9, 10 and 12.

Unlike some contractors who offered estimates with 10 to 20 per cent variables, Distler gave them a firm price and finished the 3,500 sq. ft. home ahead of schedule and within one per cent of their final budget. "That was huge for us," says Sheri. "It made a difference in being able to add different features to the home."

Working with a custom builder overseeing all aspects of construction was worth it, she says. "It eliminated a lot of the hassle and stress. It was fun, being able to choose colours and flooring and stonework. It made it very hassle-free. We'd do it again."

A custom-built home is an opportunity to make your living space precisely as you want it – a rare chance to use creativity and personal tastes to please and comfort you and your family. For many people, building a home is one of the biggest investments they will ever make. So a great deal of planning and prudence is essential.

Deciding how much you can afford is a key step, says Liam Cragg, a mortgage broker with Community Mortgage Services Corp. When a financial institution pre-approves your mortgage, calculate the monthly payment, add property taxes, utilities, insurance and all the other costs of home ownership to determine your total monthly cost, Cragg advises. "There has to be a comfort factor," he says. "That's the first thing you should establish, 'What amount of payment is reasonable for me to handle?"

The more money you have available to build a custom home, the easier financing will be, he says. If you own a mortgage-free home and intend to sell it when your new home is finished, you could get a line of credit against your existing home and use that money, as you need it, until you reach substantial completion on the new house, Cragg explains. When you sell your existing home you then pay off the line of credit. If your existing home is not mortgage-free, a bank may offer you a line of credit based on your equity.

It's always a good strategy to ask for more financing than you need, Cragg says. "You don't have to use the additional funds, but if you run into problems during the construction phase and go back to your lender for more money your lender might say no. Then your financing options could get expensive," he warns.

The cost of a custom-built home depends on its size, complexity and finishes, says Scott Clark, operations manager for Edenlane Homes Inc., a family owned and operated design and construction company. Other expenses, such as building permits, architectural fees, a development permit, as well as water and sewer services, may add to the final price.

Prospective custom homeowners, Clark says, must make many decisions prior to construction to determine whether their house will be as expensive as one already built.

Finding the right builder is crucial. Clark recommends speaking to a few builders right at the start of the project. Visiting trade shows that showcase builders will provide a feel of what's involved, he says. "The client should feel comfortable and secure with the builder from the beginning," Clark says. "If there is even a slight sense of apprehension on the part of the client regarding a particular builder, then walk away."

The Canadian Home Builders Association (CHBA) advises anyone looking for a contractor to ask around and talk to friends, family, co-workers and neighbours. Find out if their contractors lived up to expectations. How were issues resolved? Use the business directory in this magazine. The beautiful homes featured in OUR HOMES magazine are owned by people happy with their builder's work. Drive around, look at homes and find out who built the houses you like.

"A client should request references from a builder's previous clients," says Clark. "See some of their work, ask how the financial portion of the project works, ensure the builder has all the necessary insurance and find out who they use for subcontractors."

After interviewing builders and checking references, ask a short list of contractors to provide an actual bid, based on clear and detailed plans and specifications, the CHBA suggests. The bid that affords the best overall value, not necessarily the lowest price, is the one to look for, says the CHBA.

Develop a contract, determine a price and get a warranty on materials and workmanship in writing. "Verbal assurances that a contractor will come back and fix anything that goes wrong is very difficult to enforce after the job is finished," the CHBA warns. Have a lawyer review the draft contract and insist on proof of liability insurance and Workers Compensation coverage or equivalent private disability coverage for exempt workers. "A contract that requires compliance with the laws of your province or territory is a good way to protect yourself and your family from legal or financial risks," the CHBA says.

The CHBA offers a wealth of information on its website www.chba. ca. It has worksheets to help you decide what you need in a home, how much it will cost, and how to rate builders. **OH**


#### Angela Chang says she never really wanted a cottage, until, that is, her two daughters left for university.
























**Building** Homes













The birds are singing, the buds are blooming and there is a freshness in the air that beckons us outside. Springtime is one of the most cheerful seasons as it gives the exhilarating promise of great weather and outdoor fun. What better way to celebrate the arrival of spring than with a picnic?

When thinking about wines to pour at your picnic you want to think about fresh, light offerings. Just as the winter jackets and mittens get packed away, so too should the heavy red and white wines that are meant for rich, wintery meals. They can be laid down for another year of aging. Instead, pull out the fresh, crisp whites and light reds in their place.

There are many options to choose from. For conventional whites you could pour an unoaked Chardonnay or Sauvignon Blanc. If you'd like to get a little more adventurous try looking to the east of Europe for some interesting grape varieties such as a dry Furmint from Hungary, or a Grüner Veltliner from Austria. A Pinot Gris from British Columbia, or a dry Riesling from Ontario will also be elegantly refreshing, and make for great partners with cheese.

When considering lighter reds, Pinot Noir from Canada, Oregon or Burgundy can't be beat. Wines made from the Barbera grape in Piemonte, Italy are really appealing, as well as many of the wines from Spain or Southern France made from the Grenache grape (Garnacha in Spanish). Lastly, my favourite wines paired with lighter fare are those made with the Cabernet Franc grape. I've never met a Cabernet Franc I didn't like; they are always tasty and at the very least interesting. Look for those coming from Niagara or the Loire region in France.

After having said all this, my true favourite for a picnic wine is a rosé; there is no better place to drink rosé than outdoors and under the sun. And its pretty pink colour goes with everything!

Now that we have looked at possible picnic-friendly wines we need the picnic-perfect cheeses. One style of cheese to consider is "fresh" cheese, meaning "not aged." Fresh cheeses are released to market days, and sometimes hours, after being produced. They tend to be lighter in both flavour and texture because of their youth. One of my favourite food moments was while driving through a small, rural town in France. There was a hand-written sign on the side of the road reading simply, "Fromage Frais," Fresh Cheese. I followed the arrow and a few turns later wound up in a farmer's

garage. He showed me his cheese and his goats and sold me two cupfuls of fresh tangy goat's cheese, still dripping with moisture and waiting to be spread on a baguette with jam. Other types of cheese that fall into the "fresh" category include ricotta, mozzarella di bufala, bocconcini, cottage cheese and feta. These are all great cheeses for spring but for our purposes we'll want to round out the offerings to include a few more styles. Below are two groupings of cheeses that would make wonderful additions to your picnic.

Cheese Option #1
Sheep's Milk Feta
drizzled with Honey
Camembert
Beaufort

Cheese Option #2
Crottin de Chavignol
Saint André
Aged Farmhouse
Cheddar

The spontaneous nature of a picnic calls for foods

that are easy to prepare and serve. Therefore, if you create one substantial main dish accompanied by the cheeses, you'll succeed in making a great meal with little effort. I suggest Salade Niçoise, a flavourful salad full of colour.

The variations on this salad are plentiful but the basic ingredients remain the same.

Toss together in a large bowl some halved, boiled new potatoes, cooked green beans, a can or two of tuna in oil, black olives (not the tinned ones), a big handful of halved grape tomatoes, finely diced red onion and some chopped basil. Season generously with salt and dress liberally with olive oil and white wine vinegar. Add to your menu a baguette, ciabatta or an olive-studded fougasse and your picnic is ready, all you need is the blacket.

# WELL WORTH THE WAIT

The suggestion of a salty tang flavours every tread, turret and transom of this Cape Cod-style vacation home on the southern shore of Georgian Bay. From the painted cedar-shake exterior to a souvenir starfish tucked into a built-in bookshelf, the New England coast is near in heart if not in actual miles. Continued on page 79

"There's something about a nautical theme that gives the hope of travelling," says homeowner and avid global explorer Cathy Tait, who chose a myriad of blues and whites to complement nature's palette. "It imbues faraway places."

As if made to order, a lighthouse lends a haunting serenity to the island vista across the water, visible from nearly every room in this house, expertly built by Gilkon Construction Ltd. – including the four-season sunroom, which boasts drop-down panes by ROSS Windows & Doors that sink into the foundation. The resulting screened in haven invites cooling breezes while overlooking the expansive deck.

Landscaped tiers created by Kelly's Northern Landscaping and **Classic Stone**, step down to the sandy waves.

The white tower and scarlet peak of the iconic beacon across the sound echo in the seascapes gracing the second-floor hallway. The architects of both structures clearly share the form-should-follow-function philosophy of design.

Despite the overwhelming evidence that an art connoisseur is in residence, this house - named "Glencairn," according to the curbside plaque transplanted from an ancestral home in Scotland – invites guests to plunge in and enjoy their stay wholeheartedly, rather than tip-toe timidly at the periphery. "This is not a precious house," assures the hostess, who shares Glencairn with husband Ian (both management consultants with a ravine-backing home in Toronto), daughter Meghan (a museum curator), son Cameron (a university senior), and a rotating cast of friends and family. "You know the saying 'build it and they will come?" Well, they come – and come again."

Completed in the summer of 2008 by Gilkon, veteran custom home builders, the house is the result of patience rewarded.

"It took us eight years to find it," Cathy recalls. "We wanted it to face west for the sunset, to be on a beach, and to have pristine waters with a sandy bottom. We knew what was on the property could be changed, but those things can't – or not easily."

Once the ideal location and environment had been discovered, **The Ideal Environment/Brian Lee Architect** was enlisted to replace the

existing cottage (while retaining its cedar tongue-in-groove boards to clad the sunroom's floor and vaulted ceiling.)

Gilkon worked closely with Lee.

Earthwork was completed by **S. Charlebois Haulage & Excavating Ltd.**, while plumbing and heating contractors **Tom Downer Ltd.** and electricians from **Simcoe County Contracting** were brought in for the modern conveniences

"I enjoyed the finishings on this house – the roof was a challenge," says Gilkon co-owner **Chris Bondar**, who clearly enjoys being tested. "And the eyebrow in the vaulted ceiling of the living room – it too was a unique challenge that turned out beautifully."

The unique ceiling design (painted by **Richard Secord**) is highlighted by a four-panel casement series and arching transom by Kolbe Windows & Doors. Continued on page 82

Bondar's Gilkon team is also very experienced with custom cabinetry, columns, stairs, handrails and other woodworking details employed throughout the home. Their mission included a living room mantel designed specifically to accommodate a model sailboat that made its way home from Hawaii. ("It took two years to find someone to assemble it," grins Cathy.)

The flooring – reclaimed rock-elm barn board, which had to be cleaned, planed and filled by hand - was also processed and installed by Gilkon.

The local history of the floorboards, which are briefly interrupted by granite (the entranceway is a smooth transition from the outdoors), slate (in the multi-purpose pantry) or tumbled Carrara marble (bathrooms), is now another page in the Glencairn storybook - an ongoing rich tale Cathy crafts to spark memories and conversation.

Another example: the vanity in the master bath is topped with green

labradorite quartz said to have healing powers. It isn't necessary to believe, but for those in the know who care to contemplate, life can be escalated to a level that is just a little more fascinating.

The artistic journey moves from the lighthouse seascapes (done by Portuguese artist Miguel Freitas, who Cathy met in his youth) to the over-sized Bob Marley oil portrait by Paul Ygartua that took its rightful place in Cameron's room after a three-year search, to a mixed-media Betty Boop by Steven Csorba that gains depth from a base layer of bubble wrap.

"There's always a story – that's how I choose art," confirms Cathy, who designed an entire wall to showcase a huge Chantal P. Durocher canvas that incorporates textural components, such as birch bark, that begs to be touched. "It was just the perfect painting."

An artistic appreciation for texture and depth can also be found in the Brazilian Barricato granite-slab countertop in the Something's Gotta

Give-inspired kitchen (the multi-colour design of the stone reminds Cathy of a Jackson Pollock painting), the tiny Egyptian tiles framing a nearby chalkboard, and the faux-wood ceiling beams created by muralist and trompe l'oeil artist Lindsay Davies in the guest room - the only room in the house without a water view.

Jhavi Desai designed the kitchen cabinetry and many of the built-ins. The kitchen cabinets were made by Prestige Wood Designs.

With a sound system set up by musicologist and sound engineer Andrew Weleshcuk of Solutions AV to stimulate another sense, guests can listen to the house selection or plug in their iPods wherever they happen to land – a perfect way to relax after a busy day of skiing or kayaking.

"This house has a lot of soul. Not to be absurd, it just grounds you as soon as you walk in. We worked hard at trying to get that feel and weren't in a rush. I think that made all the difference." **OH**

# FEELING GREAT IN SPACE

"What's wrong with this space?" Gayle asks. "We're just not comfortable here." "We never use this room," Adrienne says. "No one in the family seems to want to be in here for more than a few minutes." "We just can't seem to get it right," a frustrated Donna confesses. "We can't seem to pin down what's bugging us. It's not the colour, and we loved the furniture when we picked it out, but it just doesn't deliver the comfort level we anticipated."

If any of these comments strike a chord with you, you'll be pleased to learn that the struggles of getting it right for your home interior often have little to do with the aesthetics of the objects you choose, and everything to do with how you feel as a result of the impact that our environment has on our overall comfort and sense of well-being. The good news is, once we make the connection with our real needs from our personal spaces, we can begin with ease to make the choices that support and comfort us.

feeling exposed. Bring people comfortably close and remember sofas don't always need to be backed against walls.

3. Sitting too close can feel like an

Let's start at the beginning. First, it's important to understand that we experience our home spaces on two distinctly different but inseparable levels simultaneously. Rather like the proverbial chicken and egg, we are engaged in an entangled relationship of physical and emotional response that shapes our perceptions and ultimately influences our opinions about the degree of pleasure we are experiencing. We are conditioned by culture and life experience but our basic needs are pre-programmed into our biology. Some we are well aware of and others are acquired on a subconscious level and only grab our attention when they appear on our radar as intuitive feelings of discomfort. Our instinctive needs for safety, warmth, comfort and relationship are continually at work to be satisfied, so when we feel physically unsafe and emotionally disconnected, from

people and our surroundings, we experience a negative response. When it comes to

our homes, there is no getting away from satisfying these basic needs,

despite the degree of luxury you can afford.

Here are some examples of things that can undermine our feelings of safety, leaving us feeling vulnerable, along with some suggested remedies to influence those "good energy feelings."

1. Our backs to doorways and windows. Our eyes look

forward – we like to see who is approaching easily. If it is impossible to avoid, try to place a mirror in a strategic location so you can see who is coming behind you. 2. Too much distance between seats in conversational areas can restrict intimacy and leave us remember sofas don't always need to be backed against walls. 3. Sitting too close can feel like an encroachment of individual space, (like the middle person on a three-seater sofa). 4. Chairs with arm rests are generally more comfortable than armless for living and family rooms because they allow natural support in a

relaxed state.

5. Blocked pathways – backs of furniture facing entranceways

 - and sofas loaded with cushions with no room for sitting - all subconsciously say "restricted area" do not enter!

6. Rigid seating arrangements with hard edges restrict intimacy. We are naturally comfortable in conversational circles. Try angling furniture to soften edges. Face seating into the centre so people can make direct eye contact without twisting and turning.

7. Bathrooms too close to communal areas compromise privacy and are extremely uncomfortable for guests.

8. Bedrooms at the front of the house or too close to the entrance door or exposed to high traffic areas keep us in a state of unrest when their purpose is to do just the opposite.


9. Improper lighting can make a room uncomfortable. Choose wisely. 10. Mirrors can be extremely useful decorating tools, but be careful of what you are reflecting.

11. Beautiful windows by day left uncovered at night turn to black mirror and can be very disturbing.

12. Create subliminal boundaries without barriers by using area rugs to define and anchor conversational groupings and fill in corners and uncomfortable gaps with plants either artificial or natural. **OH**






