



HOME HUNGRY

Young homebuyers who work in Toronto have to choose between a long commute or condo living to make the dream of owning a home a reality.

FORCED BY CLIMBING RENTAL and

property prices in the Greater Toronto Area, Emily Proctor and her partner Dean Lane are taking the same route as plenty of other young people – they're heading north to buy a house.

"We've been halfheartedly planning for over a year," says Emily, who lives and works in downtown Toronto. Buying a house in the GTA is not easy these days, acknowledges the 27-year-old. "We took a look at our finances and started putting away some money and making cuts."

Dean sold his car, a move, he says, that also cut down on insurance and took away condo parking fees, gas and car maintenance expenses.

Then it came time to consider where they would buy a house, says Emily.

"I've always wanted to have a house in a smaller city," she says, adding, "It's also within the budget."

The Building Industry and Land Development Association (BILD) and the Toronto Real Estate Board (TREB) recently polled young people in the GTA and found that 92 per cent of them agree that the dream of home ownership is becoming more difficult to achieve for their cohort living in their city.

"Affordability is a huge barrier," says Emily. "There are fewer, stable full-time jobs that pay well. Wages haven't been rising as much as the cost of living has."

She says she's noted that friends who've moved out of the GTA are in a better position to own homes.

That's why Emily and Dean are looking to buy property in Simcoe County.

And that's where the trend seems to be moving, says Sarah J. Stevens, a realtor with Century 21 B. J. Roth Realty in Orillia.

Sarah says to afford a house, groups of friends and couples are pooling their money to make it happen. This creativity, she says, also means young people are buying different types

"They may buy triplexes so they can get some rental income from it," says Sarah.

With changes in rules around mortgages, everyone from real estate agents to mortgage brokers have to work harder.

Sarah says young people vying for properties have to drive their income. "Make as much money as you can," she says. "Find a side job, or an extra job, maybe online, or wherever your (soft) skills lie. Be conservative and live within your means and don't take on extra debt."

And as time goes on, Sarah says, she's finding most people are okay commuting farther for a cheaper house.

But according to the BILD and TREB poll, 86 per cent of respondents say it's important for young families to be able to afford to live and work within the GTA without having to commute over an hour to get to work.

That's what veteran GTA real estate representative Sue Massa of the Sell with Sue Team at Right At Home Realty Inc., Brokerage, is finding with her clientele.

"The condo market has taken off," she says, adding her clients want to stay close to the

city because of the high cost of commuting. "Most people when they sit down and do their budgeting, they want to cut down on their travel costs," she says.

"The trend of moving north has slowed down considerably," says Sue. "When the market corrects itself, the properties north will be hit first."

In her experience, she says, younger people buying homes are willing to spend that extra bit, instead of having to fix up a property

"At one time you were able to purchase a property and go and fix it," she says. "Today, it's hard to find that extra money to put towards that."

At the end of the day, both she and Sarah recommend that anybody looking to buy property should work with investment, real estate and mortgage experts to reach their goal of home ownership.

To save up, Sue says, take inventory of where you're spending your money. Most people can save a lot simply by cutting back on their monthly coffee and eating out expenditures.

"Once you've kept an eye on your money, you can decide where you're going to invest it," she says. он



Pollinator-friendly gardens are on the rise. Pollinators, especially bees, are responsible for the propagation of approximately one-third of our food supply. Follow these guidelines to make your garden pollinator-friendly.

Basic Needs

Pollinators have a few basic habitat needs: a diversity of flowering native or naturalized plants, egg-laying or nesting sites, a water source and perhaps a spot to overwinter. Interestingly, I find what works for pollinators is also what I naturally prefer in garden spaces.


The Food

The sheer diversity of our native bees, butterflies, moths and other insects is astonishing and their specialization to feed on certain flower types is equally awe-inspiring. Some insects only pollinate one particular species. Others are far broader in their feeding habits, feasting on nectar from an array of flower types. Ideal pollinator habitats grow various species that bloom in diverse sizes/shapes and

flower in a succession from early spring to late fall. These should also include trees and shrubs in various heights.

TIP

Flowers with multiple petal layers are often called "doubles" and though doubles are pretty, they should be minimized as most insects can't access the nectar within. Plus, many double flowers or hybrid plants don't produce any nectar at all.

Egg Laying & Nesting

Certain insects require certain plants for propagation. Probably the most famous insect-plant relationship is that of the monarch butterfly and the milkweed. Monarch butterfly larva can only survive and thrive on the milkweed plant. Do I really need to mention that we should all allow milkweed into our gardens? Many native bee species nest in small holes in the ground and though I am a strong advocate of mulch, it is necessary to leave an area of bare soil exposed for this purpose.



Water Source

Butterflies and other insects require places to "puddle" where they drink water from damp puddles to attain the minerals they require. Puddles are easy to make. Simply bury a shallow plate or bowl in the ground so the lip is even with the surface of the soil. Fill the container with sand or soil and arrange a few rocks on top for landing spots. Add water as needed to keep the sand consistently wet. Bees require a slightly different setup that's actually very similar to

what most birds need. A shallow, wide bowl with some large and small rocks and just an inch or two of water is all that's needed. Top up water daily.

Overwintering

Many native bee species and other beneficial insects overwinter in the hollow stems of plants. Therefore, don't cut back herbaceous plants in fall. By leaving perennials to stand you'll also provide shelter and food to a host of birds and other small wildlife. Another option is to create or purchase a bee habitat to offer them an extra helping hand.

Melanie's Pollinator Plant Picks

Even adding just a few gorgeous species from this mix of native and non-native (but high nectar/pollen) plants to your garden space can make all the difference to these small but special creatures.

Trees and shrubs: Apple, pear, willow, redbud, maple, sumac, serviceberry, elderberry, honey locust, oak, horse chestnut, mahonia, basswood, dogwood, blueberry, raspberry and currant.

Perennials: Aster, allium, bee balm, blanket flower, pasque flower, baptisia, salvia, Russian sage, nepeta, snow drop, tulip, liatris, goldenrod, shasta daisy, coneflower, black-eyed Susan, coreopsis, oregano, mint, dill, parsley, columbine, milkweed, butterfly weed, hyssop, Joe-pye weed.

As natural pollinator habitats diminish and the effects of pesticide exposure take their toll on many species, residential gardens hold the key to positively impacting the lives of these important insects. Even the bumblebee has now been added to the ever-growing list of endangered species and the time to act is now. Pollinator gardens can help fill this void by providing food, water and nesting and overwintering habitats for a broad diversity of pollinating insects and other wildlife such as birds and small animals. These gardens can also serve as windbreaks, help stabilize the soil and improve local water quality. Plus, attracting pollinators to your yard will help your garden to produce more blooms and more food if you happen to have a veggie garden. As always, when you choose Mother Nature as your ally it's a win-win-win situation. OH





Carved into a wall and clad with decorative stone that matches the stairway and living room fireplace surround, the cellar is lit from within and enclosed by **Grimsby Glass** doors, drawing the eye the minute you step foot into the lower level. "The wine cellar is one of our favourite features," says Ken.

The renovation, done by **Andy Jack** of **Jack Design & Construction**, took only four months. "We trusted Andy throughout the entire process," says Ken. "He listened to all our ideas and suggestions and brought a wealth of creativity to the project." The homeowners wanted to be involved in the entire process. Karen pulled ideas from decorating magazines and online forums. She collected pictures and created a wish list. "Karen was the visionary," Ken says proudly.

"This isn't a home we would or could have built 20 years ago," says Frank Carestia, President and CEO of Duca Homes, of their stately one-storey property in a mature Ancaster neighbourhood. "It's definitely the result of everything we've learned over the years."

More than a decade of crafting custom homes for clients helped Frank realize exactly what he wanted to put into his next home. And since he and wife Tina had collaborated to design their family's first Ancaster home together, the couple had plenty of in-the-trenches experiences to call on this time around.

In the blueprint stage, for example, Frank knew what steps to take to get Tina on board with the vision. "Because he builds houses all the time, he can visualize things," says Tina. "But I really need to see things physically in front of me." To bridge that gap, Frank would lay out measuring tape on the floor of their former house to help Tina get a sense of the size of a room, or use markers on the plywood of the new home's frame to draw in the fireplace, sofas and any other details.

Frank and Tina enlisted the help of Jill Fraser, owner of House of Fraser Decor, and Christina Wickenden, owner of The Green **Door Decor**. As a team, Jill and Christina had worked with Frank for years, and have known Tina personally for almost as long, so they had plenty of insight into what the family would want and need in a house designed to grow and change with them.

"When they started to build this home - after designing the house for eight years - we thought, 'Okay, this is huge,' " says Jill. "Not because there was any particular pressure but because we knew them so well by that time. Every decision was something of a group consensus."

Having four experienced people on the same wavelength made it relatively easy to navigate the mountain of decisions required for any custom build. "Drawing out where the kitchen island would go and where the kitchen table would go, we realized we could add a few extra feet to the island, and that's just made a world of difference," says Tina. "It meant there was room for a stool for each of us, and it's great for entertaining, too."

At one point, after looking at a 3D rendering of the kitchen (cabinetry by **CR Technical Woodworking**, counters by **Stonex Granite & Quartz**), Tina was struggling to decide on where appliances (Peter Martin Appliances) should go. "Jill knows us well and could picture how we'd use this space, so she suggested moving the bar fridge close to the dining room, and then suddenly it all made much more sense," says Tina.

When it came to choosing colours, Tina and Frank – whose previous











home was done in warm earth tones and browns – gravitated toward cooler, grey tones for a change of pace. "Since this is their forever home and they're not going to change things like the floor or fireplace, we helped them choose finishes that will be flexible down the road, so they can adapt as the trends or their tastes change," explains Jill.

The flooring, for example (Mario's Tile & Interiors), is engineered wide-plank hickory with mid-tone shades of both greys and browns. In the family room, the sleek, modern gas fireplace (Reliant Climate) is a focal point, with an Italian tile that incorporates both cool and warm tones. "When we first walked into the showroom and I saw that tile, I knew right away," says Tina. "It just looked like art to me."

While choosing fireplace tile came easily, other decisions required

wanted this look in her dining room," says Jill. "It's such a bold choice for the first room people see when they walk into your home."

When it came to finding chairs that worked with the scheme, Tina was less confident. "I couldn't go dark, I didn't want wood or leather. I really wasn't sure what would work, and then Jill helped us find these soft grey, textured chairs," says Tina. "They're perfect."

The dining room is flanked by the long, high-ceilinged entranceway. At Jill's suggestion, Frank built the live-edge walnut console table that now grounds the space, and he and Tina added the framed photographs above that reflect their roots.

"My family is from Italy, so there's a photo of an iconic scene in Venice," says Frank. "My wife is half Italian and half English, so another photo is a shot of Big Ben and London. Then, because our family is Canadian, there's a photo of Toronto's skyline."

"It's a house full of personality," says Jill. "That suits this family; there's not a shrinking violet in the bunch, so they needed a house to match."

Tucked in the master bathroom is a water closet with a surprise expanse of zebra wallpaper. "That was really a happy accident," explains Jill. "We bought the wallpaper for the powder room and it didn't work in there with the stone we chose, so this seemed like a good spot to use it." Jill laughs and adds, "I'm sure whenever people come over, they get shown Frank's toilet on the house tour!"



A CUP OF SEEDS


These charming, easy-to-make and easy-to-clean bird feeders will attract a discerning flock to your garden.

- Use the spoon hook to hang the teacup from an easy-to-access branch of your favourite tree. You can also hang the feeder with a ribbon. Fill with birdseed.



1 egg, beaten

I Tbsp water

Puff pastry

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 425°F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Melt butter over medium heat in a larger saucepan. Add shallots and garlic and cook for two to three minutes. Add mushrooms and stir. Add spinach. Mix together until wilted. Remove from heat and stir in cream cheese and breadcrumbs. Set aside.

Prepare an egg wash by whisking one egg with a tablespoon of water. Divide pastry dough in two and roll out



Flip the salmon over onto the baking sheet with the fold side down. Score the top creating a diamond pattern and brush generously with egg wash. Bake for 25 minutes, until the tops are golden brown. **OH**
