# INOD TOTHE PAST

Leanne and Dave Steiner had rather specific ideas about how and where they wanted to spend their retirement years.

The former operating room nurse and oil executive had their hearts set on the historic charm of Niagara-on-the-Lake, a place that also offered all the modern conveniences they were used to after 10 years living and working near Houston, Texas.

"We wanted a small town feel, but with reasonable access to some of the amenities and activities you might find in a larger community, and Niagara-on-the-Lake seemed to fit that bill perfectly," Leanne says.

After purchasing a lot in Old Town, and with a floor plan in mind, Leanne worked extensively with builder **Ken Martens** of **Brook-Lite Homes Ltd.** to create a space that was both visually stunning and convivial. "I gave him my floor plan," she said, "and we sort of evolved from the floor up."

But Niagara-on-the-Lake, known for its picture-postcard heritage, has specific criteria for new builds. The couple had to ensure the house fit into the traditional look of the historic district while incorporating Leanne's vision. The home, which looks like it's always been there, is actually a two-year old bungalow, but from the street it looks like a two-storey – as per the town's requirements – thanks to a window cleverly placed under the peaked roofline.

As for the inside, it's entirely the Steiners' idea of a dream retirement home.

The whole main floor has a monochromatic off-white colour scheme that incorporates texture and creative ornamentation to add character and warmth. The baseboards, mouldings and trim look like they belong in a century home, but thanks to the exquisite work of **Lee Bambridge** of **Bambridge Woodworks Ltd.**, they're wider in places, and have intricate designs that flawlessly marry the traditional with the modern.

Leanne loves to cook and spends much of her time in the open-concept kitchen with cabinetry designed by Artcraft Kitchens to conceal some of the appliances. The door of the Sub-Zero refrigerator looks like a generous kitchen cupboard, while a pullout Fisher & Paykel freezer is contained in a neighbouring drawer. The striking Cambria quartz centre island contains two drawer dishwashers, small and large also by Fisher & Paykel, that are seamlessly concealed and ergonomically designed to minimize bending. Like the other kitchen appliances, the stainless Dacor gas range is from Nickerson Home Appliances but it's the only one not hidden away. Along with an under-the-counter Miele combination and individual convection/microwave oven, there's a multitude of cooking options.


Flooring was another opportunity to combine old and new. "I wanted hardwood but I didn't want lots of visible wood grain," Leanne explained. The dark walnut finish by **Aristocrat** Floors of the World delivers the subtle look desired and flows through much of the home. It's the perfect foil to the off-white custom shelving in the living room and library that holds a diverse array of books and objets d'art. Both rooms also feature a gas fireplace from **Stella's Regional** Fireplace Specialists, equipped with crystals

in the firebox that twinkle in the light of the flames, and become focal points when ignited. The library also doubles as a guest room with a tucked-away Murphy bed, and an adjacent powder room provides privacy to visitors who find it hard to leave.

Leanne's desire to achieve a space that looks and feels expansive, particularly in the common areas, is accomplished by skillfully placed mirrors from Low's Glass **Mirror & Windows**.

Wall-to-wall windows by **Regional** Doors & Hardware in the living room and master bedroom provide panoramic views of the manicured courtyard patio with its European-inspired landscaping by **DeKorte's Landscaping Ltd.** "We've travelled a lot, all through Europe and Asia, and I kind of had an idea that I wanted a Parisian courtyard-style yard with lots of greenery that allowed for privacy," Leanne says.

**Jack DeKorte** worked directly with Leanne to design a charming space that boasts privacy and solitude from the nearby tourist district. Even the clip-clopping of horse-drawn carriages and car traffic are muted by the trees and other foliage in the yard. The gardens are kept fresh and green with a built-in sprinkler system by All Green Irrigation. Continued on page 22

In the master bedroom, Hunter Douglas Powerview shades from Lincoln Interiors & Furniture Gallery open and close with the push of a button. It's a feature Leanne says she wanted to prevent wear and tear from adjusting them manually. The large walk-in closet was designed by California Closets to fit Leanne's specifications of having his-and-her space and hidden laundry baskets.

The off-white theme throughout the rest of the main floor is broken up only by the grey tones of Carrara marble from Aristocrat in the en suite. A separate tub and shower from **The Ensuite** provide both relaxation and function, while a secluded toilet and bidet are shrouded in utmost privacy.

Like the rest of the home, even the staircase leading to the lower level bucks being cookiecutter. Instead of a straight staircase, Leanne split it into two sections with a landing between. Made extra wide, they lead to a part of the home dubbed "the man cave." It has a masculine feel with warm tones of grey and brown. The open-concept lower level provides office space for Dave, a second living room with a large-screen television, a small wet bar, and a round table that's ideal for a night of poker with the guys. Two guest bedrooms share a well-appointed bathroom and round out the living space.

Every feature of the Steiners' Old Town home unites style with function, traditional with contemporary, and is an example of how a homeowner with imagination and a builder with vision can work together to create living space that pleases the eye and soothes the soul.

"I wanted a modern take on tradition," Leanne says. "It was a process that took more than 18 months, planning and choosing, going back and forth with the builder and tradespeople."

Given how much the couple is enjoying retirement, it was well worth it.  $\mathbf{OH}$














Porch Rules

Larry and Cathy Boggio couldn't imagine anything better than sitting on the summer porch of their Wainfleet home.

Lake Erie is the most prominent view from the breezy, screened veranda of the couple's house that was once the summer cottage of a prominent Buffalo business family. Since moving in 11 years ago, the Boggios have made it a year-round home, and in the process, created several other places to sit and soak in the view: the winter porch, the stone patio and the roof of an old stone boathouse where four red Muskoka chairs now beckon.

"We sit in our Muskoka chairs in the evening and drink wine," Cathy says. "It's super relaxing. I really love it. It changes every day."

The original home was built in 1924. The couple, owners of the **Boggio Family of Pharmacies** in Niagara, bought the home in 2005 and completed extensive renovations.

The colour is the first standout of the house. The exterior is cottage red with white and blue trim around the windows, from **Herman's Building Centres**. It was a bold move that Cathy, a designer, gambled on and won.

"I always say when people are trying to find our house 'It's the red house with the stone front," she says.


The white trim, Larry adds, "crisps it up a bit."

The original and only other owners – the Scheelers – founders of Buffalo Wire Works Co., used the house as a cottage and fishing camp. Cathy says beams in the basement still bear a handwritten tally of fish caught in certain years.

For 18 years, the Boggios lived about two kilometres down the road, and would drive by and fantasize about owning it. Cathy says she only saw the Scheelers there about once a year.

When the house finally went up for sale, the Boggios put in a bid. They were just about to renovate the kitchen in their current home, but Larry decided to wait until the following week to sign the contract for the renovations. A few days later, they were owners of their new house.

They knew that they'd renovate it. The home sat on a beautiful double waterfront lot, but the place needed updating

"There was no insulation," Larry says.

"There was no real heat. The electrical was old wiring. The plumbing needed updating. We replaced everything – plumbing, electrical, windows."

The goal all along, Larry says, was "to make the new look old." Much of their energy in the renovations, which took about a year-and-a-half, was spent making the place look authentic.

An example? The main staircase, installed by **Amber Stairs & Railing Inc.**, was made of fir to match woodwork in the rest of the home. Workers were concerned it wasn't the ideal wood, but the Boggios persisted.

"They suggested going with a harder wood," Cathy remembers. "But after they did it, they thought it was amazing."

The couple doubled the size of the existing house, adding about 1,900 square feet to the 1,800 sq. ft. house, with help from Cathy's brother, contractor **Ron Kieffer (Ron Kieffer Construction**), who specializes in custom renovations. They added a new kitchen, dining room, master bedroom with en suite and a new main stairwell leading to both, plus a double garage.

The large eat-in kitchen, with plentiful storage provided by **Elmwood Fine Custom Cabinetry** is a focal point of the house, spreading out to the right after the front foyer. More than being simply grand, it's spacious enough to entertain family over the holidays. The Boggios have been known to host 30 people at Christmas dinner. A pantry off the cooking area provides additional space for storage and food prep. Built-in appliances from **Doug Swartz Appliance Sales and Service** help the couple stay true to making the old look new.

The kitchen's cream-coloured tile by **Alfieri Floor Experts** pairs well with the new hardwood floors installed by **Wilson Floor Design**. Both suit the style of the home, feeling as though they were part of the original cottage.

The original kitchen was converted to a laundry room. Some of the old glass-door cabinets were retained and now showcase Larry's ever-growing collection of old medicine bottles. Additional cabinets were custom-built by **Mike Feagan Woodworkers** to resemble what was already there. Continued on page 34

The rest of the original main floor was transformed into a lounge area, with a pool table inviting games under an antique-looking chandelier from Turn of the Century Lighting. It adds to the relaxed feel one would expect of a cottage-turned-family home.

The meticulous transformation didn't stop with the renovations. The Boggios searched across southern Ontario and western New York for furniture and fixtures to suit the 1920s look of the house and complement the many pieces the Scheelers left behind. They also lucked out with accent pieces, including an area rug from **Ten Thousand Villages**.

"I didn't want to change what was here," Cathy says. "I wanted to keep the old and introduce new pieces that fit the style and era of the home."

But it's those porches, spanning the back of the house looking out onto the water, that are the heart of the home. The summer porch boasts custom-built windows and screens from **Kingswood Millwork & Design**. When the temperatures are less inviting, the view is enjoyed from the winter porch with its heated floor. No matter where they choose to sit, there's ample room to take in the view, and to share it with their friends and family year-round.

"This is our dream home, both inside and outside," Cathy says. "We've already made so many beautiful memories with our children and grandchildren, and we look forward to the many more we'll have in this home."

"We found our own paradise here," Larry adds with a smile. "It's our retreat from our busy lifestyle." **OH**
