# FABRICS 101

Interior Designer **Dolores Pian** shares her ideas



We interact with fabrics more in our day-to-day lives than any other material in our homes. They must wear well, look fantastic and be reasonably priced.

Although fabrics may appear on walls, seating, carpets and household textiles such as bedding and towels, it's upholstery and window coverings that we put the most demand on in the home. Knowing the basics about textiles will help you invest in your fabrics wisely.

# **LABELLING**

Always read the label and ask questions. All textile products should have a label that commonly contains the following information:

**Fibre Content** – listed in order of the highest fibre content first

Country of Origin

Product Details – type,
size and style

Retailer's Logo and Product Number Barcodes

Care Labels – how to look after your product to keep it looking good

Abrasion Resistance – the ability of a fabric to resist surface wear caused by rubbing

**Other Information** – ratings for safety, flammability, classifications of finishes

**Finishes** – aesthetic and performance functions

# **FINISHES**

A finish may not be apparent to the naked eye but it is there. And they vary with the end use. Fabric finishes are used to improve the fabric in some way. This could be to:

Improve the appearance
Change the texture
Improve the feel
Improve how it drapes (hangs)
Improve functional qualities
and durability such as water-,
stain- and soil-repellence, carefree finishing, wrinkle resistance
and shrinkage control.

The average interior design fabric is treated with six finishes in order to be saleable.

# **HEALTH & WELL-BEING**

Another important consideration for fabric selection is your sensitivity to materials and finishes. Manufacturers understand this environmental concern and will tell you what their IAQ (indoor air quality) rating is.

Most materials off-gas. After installing furniture, drapes and carpeting, it's important to open your home to fresh air to dissipate possible fumes. This allows the volatile organic compounds (VOCs) to dissipate.

# UPHOLSTERY (AKA SEATING)

The fabrics that we sit on are subjected to a great deal of stress.





4) 5 Kids, pets and couch potatoes seem to be the most demanding creatures on these fabrics.

Homeowners are now asking for commercial abrasion and durability ratings such as 30,000 double rubs to 50,000 double rubs, or more, for their sofas. The Wysenbeek method, a standard of rubbing fabric back and forth on itself, is used to evaluate a fabric's strength.

If your label doesn't contain durability information, then use other tried and true methods such as the "key test" or the "diamond ring test." On a sample fabric, rub a key or ring back and forth across the fabric to see if it starts to wear, makes a mark, shifts or if its threads pull easily. If so, then it is not suitable for upholstery applications.

Luckily, Robert Allen Design and other reputable textile suppliers have beautiful

performance fabrics that are stylish. They are easy to clean, highly repellant to stains and spills, and reduce or eliminate the need for chemical cleaners. You'll find them as standard fabric offerings for various seating manufacturers.



Sunbrella, used for outdoor seating, wears like iron. Manufacturers of beds for pets use Sunbrella for its virtually indestructible, yet pleasing, properties.

# **WINDOW COVERINGS (AKA DRAPERY)**



Draperies enhance the appearance of windows or architecture, provide privacy, control light and sound and can provide a pleasing view.

Although not subject to as much stress as a sofa, they still have performance standards to consider.

Remember that fabrics, as well as other materials, can fade in direct

materials, can fade in direct sunlight – even synthetics. le the fastest. If you have

Natural fabrics will fade the fastest. If you have direct southern or western exposure on the top floor of a penthouse with air conditioning – yes, your drapes will still fade. This is the law of nature and physics.



# **FABRIC'S FUTURE**

What's in store for fabric? Drapes that contain solar cells, or perhaps seating fabric that can monitor your health or allow you to communicate with your "intelligent" devices? The possibilities are endless with textiles. Embrace the fabrics that surround you. Choose wisely. Choose well. OH




# EVERY WELL-WRITTEN STORY NEEDS STRUCTURE,

bones. Like a house. A writer starts with a character and a situation, the foundation on which the entire story stands. Next comes the inciting incident, the framing that creates something from nothing. Stories are fraught with obstacles, ups and downs, and building a house is no exception. Nothing goes as planned. Until it does, and what merely resembles a house starts to look like a home, and eventually, the character gets her happily-ever-after. And there you have it, the building of an author's story.

"The lot itself posed many challenges, positioned on the shoreline of Lake Ontario with a relatively small building envelope, and a significant slope to the water's edge," says our builder Brent Pym of Pym & Cooper Custom Homes Inc.

A large investment and countless hours were spent investigating building restrictions, land stability, and shoreline protection. Approval from local and provincial bodies was needed before the City of St. Catharines would look at our house plans.

Permission was one hurdle, construction was another. Finding a suitable shoreline engineer was a task. LGI Consulting Engineers Inc. created something from nothing, a work of art made of massive armour stone strategically placed, soaring 80 feet from beach to bluff, and providing a second patio area.

The shoreline contractor, RWC & Company Inc., had to manoeuvre huge cranes and trucks down a crazy slope ending in beach and lake, moving five- to seven-tonne stones until they completed the puzzle. This wasn't a project for the faint of heart.

There were times even we felt the project was impossible. Several times we stood on the edge of the land, looking out over the water, wondering what we got ourselves into.

To keep things in perspective, we'd take the kids on afternoon bike rides to look at houses, taking pictures and notes on features



we liked and how they'd fit into our lifestyle. We pored over decorating magazines and books, cutting and pasting, honing our wish list, and creating a scrapbook. Websites like Houzz were inspirational and a source of examples to show **Designs By Santy Inc.**, the architectural designer who put our ideas to paper. When things seemed impossible, we focused on the future.

Come late fall, upon completion of the shoreline, the team at Pym & Cooper Custom Homes Inc. sprang into action. Within days, **Cotton Inc.** poured the foundation. The weather played nice, and soon **Schilstra Builders**, the framers, were working their magic. We'd designed a three-storey, 3,500

sq. ft. house, including lower-level walkout, with a complicated witch-hat roofline and several dormers. It wasn't an easy roofing job for **Benevento Roofing & Siding Inc.** Full-length Dayside Windows and transoms were installed so every room had an amazing view of the water.

Believing a front door is the focal point of any house, we hand-designed oversize iron and glass doors topped with an intricate iron arch, a beautiful entrance brought to life by **Niagara Pre-Hung Doors**. And **Walter Ledwez Masonry Ltd.** not only clad the house in neutral brick, but hand-chiselled the elaborate limestone entryway to frame the doors, drawing the eye.



With the external components under way, including stucco by Schuit Plastering **& Stucco**, we turned our attention to the internal details. They required a ton of time and planning on our part, along with Pym & Cooper co-ordinating master craftsmen, vendors and trades. Our wish list was vast, and for months this felt like a full-time job. or designer. I already had a few design tricks up my sleeve.

Stepping inside, the first thing you notice and a floor-to-ceiling library.

The main level and finished walk-out lower level both feature large **Stamford Fireplaces** surrounded by granite from **Custom** Granite & Marble

door, which required careful electrical planning by Gore Electric Company Inc., but saves floor space. Pym & Cooper brought to life our drawings of built-in storage in lieu of closets, so the bedrooms needed little furniture. Continued on page 28



# THE NEW MUST-HAVE: MUTED COLOURS

These days, many people crave a little colour in their interiors,

a desire that traditional neutrals like white, beige and grey just don't satisfy.

Muted colours stood idly by for years, but lately they've been taking their place on centre stage, as the new must-have for designers and homeowners alike. Their subtle depth deserves a little attention, so in this issue, I'm answering some questions about what makes a true muted colour, how to use them, and why they might be your new favourite too. All paint colours by Benjamin Moore.

# WHAT IS A MUTED COLOUR?

When you add white, black or grey to a pure hue, you get a softer version of the colour. Although people use the word "shade" in other ways, a shade is technically a hue with black added, creating a darker and moodier version. Adding white makes a "tint," and adding grey produces a "tone." Perfectly muted "tones" are usually the most subtle and liveable, as they aren't too dark, too light, or too saturated.

# WHY CHOOSE MUTED COLOURS?

They're smart semi-neutrals. Toned-down colours carry neutral grey in them, making them truly "semi-neutral," and for this reason they can still coordinate easily with many other accent colours. Muted options like dusky blues, oceanic greens, blush pinks, and rosé purples enrich your colour palette without overloading the senses. They make great paint selections for a quick update, because they can easily coordinate with existing accent hues in upholstery or art that you won't be replacing.

TRY: For a sophisticated green-grey, Knoxville Gray (HC-160). For an easy-to-work-with red, Dinner Party (AF-300). For a soft sky blue, Sea Star (2123-30).



They look modern in a matte paint finish. Muted colours are often associated with traditional design, being especially prevalent in historical homes. However, this doesn't mean they can't be put to beautiful use in a contemporary space: choosing a matte paint finish (instead of the common eggshell or semi-gloss) gives muted wall colours a perfect modern twist. Use muted matte walls with traditional furnishings, modern ones, or even better - both, to tie the whole room together.

TRY: For a charming yellow, Amulet (AF-365). For a commanding navy, Gentleman's Gray (2062-20).

They work well together. Bold colours are made to make a statement. Neutrals are total wallflowers, letting the bold accents be the star. Muted hues, however, are made to work together, sharing the spotlight without fighting, and even making each other better. Because the undertones in muted colours are subtle or even a little hidden, they shine the most when they are offset by a contrasting hue. This means you can pair very different muted colours, even complete opposites, and watch them come alive without risking a total overload.

TRY: Pair the murky and mysterious Salamander (2050-10) or the velvety Dark Burgundy (2075-10) with a go-anywhere blush pink, Porcelain (2113-60).



# WHERE CAN I ADD MUTED COLOURS?

Walls are a great home for a muted colour, but there are many other ways to use them to stunning effect.

Wholstery: Be bold and try a complex, muted hue for a sofa or dining chair, rather than a typical pure neutral. Grey may be safe, but a sumptuous cabernet red is inspirational, like the Viansa Velvet Sofa by Safavieh Couture.




Pllows: Mix-matched pillows, like these from Eastern Accents, add tons of personality. Pile up toss cushions in various subtle-but-contrasting hues and you can add lots of life to your colour palette.





Cabinets: Who says cabinetry has to be either white or wood? Have cabinets sprayed an interesting shade, giving new life to your kitchen. I used Gentleman's Gray (2062-20) for my own kitchen cabinets, and it makes my brass accents and steel appliances sing. on

There's a rule in writing that before starting a story the author should know how it will end.

It's also the approach Anne Lennard-Otto takes when renovating her home in Fonthill.

The award-winning designer, who owns **Distinctive Designs & Cabintery Inc.** with her husband Manfred Otto, visualizes the end of every home project before she starts. And it's always a happy conclusion: a beautiful space. Functional, too. A segue to the next chapter in a larger story of turning a house into a home.

It's a story the couple have been writing for more than a year. "There's a feeling, it's happy," Lennard-Otto says as she looks at the newly painted walls around her. "The happy comes from achieving small goals, one by one."

What's been achieved so far, however, is far from small, particularly in a house with signs everywhere that previous owners may not have understood the character of the space in which they lived.

There are light fixtures in unexpected places, task lighting to replace pendant lights that were never removed. Switches that are ivory and white, others that are brass. Decorating touches by one owner clashed with those left behind by others, breaking Lennard-Otto's cardinal decorating rule that one should never know where a renovation project starts or stops.

"If somebody can figure out where it started and stopped, you compromised the whole design," she explains.

It was December 2015 when the Ottos bought their two-storey home on a winding street in a quiet neighbourhood on the cusp of the Fonthill Kame. This wasn't your usual two-level, cookie-cutter box that so often dots bedroom communities. Continued on page 40











It has distinct lines, ones that forge together at a peaked roof with angles that conjure a contemporary, big city style. Windows stretch from floor to ceiling, gateways for streams of natural light, but placed just so to ensure utmost privacy. Every room has large sliding glass doors that open onto a wrap-around balcony overlooking a bucolic backyard once tended by a horticulturalist who lived in the home.

"The backyard was like a symphony (last summer)," Lennard-Otto says. "Every day, I came home and there were new flowers. Simply astonishing."

But it was the large, bright foyer that really sold the couple on a place that didn't exactly fall in line with their plans to downsize. It also promised more work than they wanted to take on when they started house shopping.

"I walked in and saw the foyer, and when I saw that foyer and vaulted ceiling, I knew then our search was over," Lennard-Otto recalls. "Its presence, its character, it pulled me in."

Other rooms in the house have a similar effect, thanks to the attention the couple have given them. They also tapped into the skills and advice of contractor **Mark Postman** of **Mark Postman Renovations** to get the project off the ground.

The kitchen, of course, is a focal point with its urban contemporary flair conceptualized by Lennard-Otto herself. The sharp look is



achieved by amaretto cabinets with clean European lines contrasted with others in Grandma's China, a fresh Benjamin Moore spin on grey.

Embossed white porcelain on the backsplash bucks the trend of ceramic or glass tile to line kitchen walls and it adds timeless texture. A unique design of shelves floats across a window in the kitchen, creating continuity of space. Quartz countertops by Cambria add durability and functionality when making a meal, or gathering around the island to eat. Stainless steel appliances, like an AEG oven from **Nickerson Appliances**, are built in to fit seamlessly with their surroundings.

She had walls removed so the kitchen, which she stretched to overtake a characterless nook, would open onto a dramatic living and dining room with vaulted ceilings and a reclaimed brick, four-sided fireplace that connects every floor in the home.

The openness gives the main floor an airiness that was further enhanced when the couple removed a large overhang from the upstairs hallway that made the space feel closed-in. Walls were painted in shades of grey from the **Welland Decorating Centre**.

Hardwood by **Aristocrat Floors of the World** runs throughout the area and
furthers the "very clean, very simple" look they
were going for.

That connection with the St. Catharines flooring business also provided Lennard-Otto with something more than planks upon which to walk. Showroom manager **Rhoda Cipparone** became her sounding board for her renovations.

"Other people who renovate go to professionals. Rhoda was my professional," Lennard-Otto says. "I need someone to bounce my ideas off. She was very inspiring to work with and helped me to understand the space."

The dining room is set apart from the formal sitting area by a custom-built table with a breadboard design that's made out of reclaimed wood by **Tice Table Co.** The hefty, eight-foot rectangle has presence and room for the Ottos to entertain parties big and small.

"It was important that we could have any celebration we wanted, that I had a main area that would hold our large gatherings. That way no one felt they had to act a certain way. They just walked in and it felt like home. So whether it's two of us or 35, it can happen."


Space was reconfigured by moving other walls to allow for a private walk-in closet and a more functional en suite with a glass shower by **Bathworks**. Built-in drawers were added in the sleeping area to create a practical yet eye-catching dressing space.

The couple's to-do list hasn't been whittled down entirely. Lennard-Otto has her sights set on the dated main bathroom next. Garden **Angels** has been lined up to tame the flowerbeds and yard in the spring. Lennard-Otto can't wait to see how tending to the landscaping will give the house presence on the street, rather than hide its unique features. Lennard-Otto selected the exterior side door from Niagara Pre-Hung Doors.

Still, there have been moments when motivation has run low, but the couple pushed through, Lennard-Otto's eye always on the prize: the ending.


"It was pretty daunting for a long time," she recalls. "Small goals and then we'll get there." он




