



editor's note



OUR HOMES' stories often touch on history - family traditions, treasured legacies and fond memories of the cottage.

It happened again in Fenelon Falls when we visited a lake house built by RWH Construction for Sheila and Jamie Hetherington. "Being able to preserve our family history is important to us," Sheila told us. She and Jamie recently moved into their new retirement home on Cameron Lake, the same lake where they first met as teenagers.

They built on land Jamie's great-great-grandfather bought nearly a century ago.

Near the shore is a small wooden cabin Jamie's grandfather Russell Webster built in 1935. It's still in excellent condition. Jamie's great-grandfather, Henry Webster, was a butcher and barber who founded Webster's Wholesale. Old photos of Jamie's forebears and antique keepsakes found in the family barn are carefully preserved and displayed in their home. So is the intricate needlework stitched by Sheila's mother and the pottery collected by her father, an acknowledgement of their family's contribution to their lives. "They really appreciate still having these things in the family," says Sheila. They preserved a piece of the property's natural history in a fireplace mantel cut from one of the white pines that had to be removed from the property.

Their beautiful new house is just steps from the original rail bed of the Victoria Railway, a railroad built to haul timber and iron ore from the Haliburton Highlands. Construction of the meandering 55-mile track began in 1874. Two years later the railway linked Lindsay with Fenelon Falls, a community thriving on logging and lumbering, powered by the large waterfall spilling from Sturgeon Lake to Cameron Lake. The railway changed ownership three times before its final owner CN abandoned the line in the 1980s. The track was torn up and the right-of-way is now used as the Victoria Rail Trail for hiking, cycling, horseback riding, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. Some of that rail line's history is preserved in the Hetherington home. Iron spikes collected from the old tracks have a new life as coat hooks in the couple's home. A little more history preserved. See their story on page 36.

The Ultimate OUTDOOR KITCHEN

Interior Designer **Dolores Pian** shares her ideas.

Our summers may be short, but from March through July and on to November, cooking outdoors allows us to share our food experiences with family and friends while we extend our outdoor play time. More and more people are choosing to invest in their homes and backyards rather than vacation elsewhere.

Before planning and spending on an outdoor kitchen, ask yourself some simple questions:

- How much time do I want to devote to maintenance? Knowing this will save you a lot of grief and disappointment.
- What's critical-to-have, must-have and nice-to-have?

Critical to Know

- Safety first. Make sure you meet your region's building and fire codes. There's a difference between a code for building a house and a code for preventing open flames in and near a building. They are two different things.
- Protect combustible materials.


Choosing Cabinets and Materials

Cabinets and counters need to be corrosion and weather resistant, low maintenance and made with stable materials. All materials

expand and contract with temperature change and moisture. Sun fades colours, and natural materials break down over time. There are three types of cabinetry-based kitchens for outdoor use: HDPE/Polymer, wood and stainless steel.

Polymer: Waterproof, sun safe, available in a variety of solid colours, lower maintenance, plastic, variable durability.

Wood: Flexible design, requires some maintenance, most affordable, not fire resistant.





Stainless Steel: Heat and fire resistant, non-corrorisive, easy to clean, available in powdercoated colours.

Things to Consider

Appearance: What do I want to see when I look at my outdoor kitchen? Choose your landscaping and furniture for that perfect outdoor style.

Clean-Up: Install a sink with water. You may not want to use your indoor kitchen to clean greasy, sooty stuff. Plan ahead for plumbing.

Heating and Electrical: Layer your heat sources. Consider heat lamps, fire pits or a built-in infrared heater. Make sure you put in multiple electrical outlets that meet code. Plan ahead for electrical.

Shade: Create shade from the sun and protection from the rain with pergolas, retractable patio covers or tents.

Stay Cool: Cool yourself off with fans, misters or rugs to shield you from the hot floor and use light-coloured furniture.

Layout and Seating: Transition your rooms with removable screens, doors and walls. Offer a variety of seating – low Muskoka chairs, chaise loungers, stools and benches.

Storage Space: The ultimate amenity. Think of what else may need to be stored – equipment, furniture, sports and hobbies. You don't want to run back and forth from the house or garage, to the outdoor living area.

Small Spaces – Condo Balconies and Terraces

Electric grills make outdoor eating possible despite strict fire and safety codes. Brown Jordan has fully assembled kitchens for terraces, to be lifted by a crane, or custom units transported by a service elevator.

Nice to Have and Trending

- Specialty right-sized appliances replacing mammoth barbecue grills. These can include: Argentinian grills, smokers, side burners, pizza ovens, fridges, dishwashers, beer on tap, espresso machines, ice makers and Kamadostyle grills.
- Lighting schemes, televisions and sound systems. Treat this space like another room of the house.

Value to Your Home

Outdoor kitchens seem to be replacing the pool as an add-on feature. It increases your competitive edge when selling because people will imagine themselves having great times in their new backyard.







Light up the summer night with easy-to-make solar light posts. Storebought solar lights, commonly used on pathways or flower beds, become task lights in a cluster. Use on the deck, around the pool or at the lake.



DIRECTIONS

- Cut post into three lengths measuring 38, 32 and 26 inches each. Your lumber yard can make cuts for a small charge.
- Using a drill paddle, drill a hole 2-inches deep in the top centre of each post for the solar light stem.
- Paint posts and let dry thoroughly.
- Arrange and attach posts together with brackets and screws – L brackets for inside corners, flat brackets on the back side.
- Attach rope around the middle of the post bundle. Tuck ends in behind wrapped rope and nail end in place. Using finishing nails, tack rope into post in random areas to hold in place.
- Cut solar light stems to 2 inches or desired length. Insert light stems in posts, attach solar lights to stems. Enjoy. он

- 1 6x6-inch post, 8-foot length
- 3 Solar lights with stems
- 4 L brackets
- 2 Flat brackets
- 24 1-1/2-inch woodscrews
- 15 feet of rope (pick your desired thickness)
- 1-1/4-inch finishing nails

Drill



Confederation's team listened carefully to the couple and accommodated the family's every need. They enlarged bedrooms, installed in-floor heating, a loft above the main floor and extra linen closets. They built the home with the big windows that were Angèle's priority. "They were really great," she says. In their first meeting with Confederation, the log home manufacturer already had a builder, **Steve Johnson** of **Cedarwylde Homes Inc.**, who had priced out his part of the project. "Confederation was very organized and very professional."

Born and raised in Northern Ontario, Angèle had always dreamed of owning a home on the water. She even bought a lot on Lake Nipissing, near North Bay, intending to build a house there. A bilingual teacher, she moved to work in Toronto where she met her future husband and soon sold her lot, using the money as a down payment on a home in the city. The north country's allure never faded. The couple often enjoyed spending time with relatives on Pigeon Lake. As luck would have it, a nearby 50s-era cottage came on the market. "We just loved being on the lake, boating and all that kind of stuff. So when the cottage came up for sale, we jumped on it," Angèle recalls.

Jamal, chief financial officer for a public software company, says he hadn't wanted to own a cottage. He had always thought it would be a lot of work and that weekend visits would become obligations. But when they got their own place on the lake, his thinking changed. "It was like, 'Wow, this is different.' I actually wanted to come up here," he says. Sitting on the deck, looking out at the lake and trees, makes the stresses of work and city life distant memories, he explains. "It puts you in a whole different mindset."






They loved the old cottage. "It was very cute and quaint," says Angèle. But they have a large family and they like to entertain. When guests stayed overnight, their son Marcus had to sleep on the sofa. When they had a full house, daughter Bianka slept on the floor of her parents' bedroom. After carefully considering the costs and logistics of renovating, they decided to tear the cottage down and start fresh with Confederation. "They were great to deal with," Angèle says. "They delivered everything they promised. They were very efficient. They were easy."

Built of pine logs and timbers, their new lake house was finished in time for Canada Day last year. It has five bedrooms, four bathrooms, a loft with a gym, a sauna and office. A large Napoleon fireplace warms the main-floor great room. On the ground floor, they furnished a second living room with a bar, pool table, dart board and walkout to the front yard and hot tub. Beyond the glass doors and windows downstairs, a Kawartha room, supplied by **Sunspace by Nortech**, has a tabletop fireplace surrounded by woven furniture, a luxurious spot in which to contemplate the lake. "When we have people up, it's an entertainer's paradise for us," says Jamal. "It's an oasis for me to come to on weekends. You sit out on the deck or in the Kawartha room and your mind just goes to a whole different place."

The family enjoys cruising the lake aboard their large, well-powered pontoon boat with lots of room for children and guests. "We love the water," says Jamal. They have a furnished deck on their dock and a unique glass-sided deck atop their boathouse. At night, the boathouse glass, like the glass railings surrounding the cottage deck, glow softly with blue LED lighting.

Natural elements were essential in designing the visual aesthetics of the cottage, Angèle says. "It was very important to have the wood, the stone and wrought iron. I want that feeling of being away at a retreat – that you're away from the city in a lake environment." A nautical theme expresses her love of the ocean and the beach.

For the kitchen, she chose Nile Blue granite countertops from **Stoneworx** and custom blue-stained cherry cabinetry built by **Burke's Kitchens and Bath**. Their dinner table, large enough to sit 14 people, consists of two slabs of live edge maple, joined by an oversize metal zipper, custom-built by **Patterson's Furniture & Design**. Hardwood floors are pre-finished, wirebrushed engineered Hickory Bayou flooring from **Monaghan Lumber Specialties**.

To create spa-like bathrooms, Angèle had the walls and ceilings in two showers finished in river rock. "It makes you feel like you're part of nature when you're having a shower," she says. Two other showers are clad in tile that resembles wooden planks. To complete that feeling of a vacation retreat, each guest bedroom has two robes and slippers while bathrooms are furnished with all the toiletries and amenities guests might need. "We love having people over - sharing a weekend at the cottage by the lake with everyone," she says.

Unlike the original cottage, this one is air conditioned for those sultry summer days. Derek Bolton of Tin Banger 4 Design, who installed the home's heating and cooling, has provided excellent service, even at nine at night on a winter Friday night. "We call him if we have any questions or something's not working properly and he's there right away."

The owners also praise **Kirk Kimble** of **Wyatt Electric Ltd.** "His work was really impeccable," says Angèle. "His employees were so respectful." The Wyatt team used a lot of forethought to plan the electrical services and the location of switches and outlets, she says. "They thought everything through so that it made sense."

The couple consider the cottage a legacy for their children. "Not only did I want to provide them with the opportunity to grow up with their cousins, instead of being a family fragmented by distance and busy lives, I want to leave them with a place to come together as a family, with their spouses and children, long after I am gone," says Angèle. "Hopefully, they will always see and feel the love I put into this cottage reflected in their gatherings there." **OH**







In planning their retirement nest, Sheila and Jamie opted for a smaller home that would be easy to clean and maintain, that did not break the piggy bank when it came to taxes and heating costs, and one that would be easily accessible as they grew older. They were looking at building something that was just barely half the size of their 2,700 sq. ft. home in Markham. "We started looking at books and lots and lots of different plans. We had all kinds of ideas," says Sheila. They decided to build on Cameron Lake in Fenelon Falls on a property that has been in Jamie's family for nearly 100 years. They approached Fenelon Falls' **RWH Construction** with their ideas, worked with RWH co-owner and designer **Ryan Hayter** and with architectural technologist **Michael Burke** to draw up plans. Construction began in the summer of 2017. "We thought it wise to go with a local builder and they have their design centre in town. That was very handy, because I was still working at the time," says Sheila. With samples of everything at the design centre, design manager **Rheanon Antoniak** provided samples for the couple to take back to the house and see how light affected colours at different times of day.

Jamie had already retired as a meat manager at Markham's Garden Basket. He moved into the old cottage for the summer and was on site for most of the construction. "It was pretty neat to watch it grow every day. I enjoyed collaborating with **Jason Toms** and


Josh Scott, the building leads, and **Kent Barrett** did a beautiful job on the wood finishing," he says.

In May 2018, construction was complete and they took occupancy August 1, 2018. Sheila retired as a principal from the York Region District School Board later that year.

The two-bedroom, 1,470 square foot bungalow with a walkout basement feels anything but small. "It is a very efficient layout and we love it," says Sheila, adding they were able to get all of their must-haves for the home, making sure everything they needed was on one floor. Lakeside, floor to ceiling, custom windows provide the light, sunsets and lake views the Hetheringtons wanted. At the centre of the home, a great room with a 17-foot-high vaulted pine ceiling give them a little bit of the log-cabin feel they desired. Oil-finished engineered oak floors enrich the

space. For Jamie, la pièce de résistance is a large, **Friendly Fires** wood burning fireplace. Clad in cultured stone, it spans to the ceiling. The mantel is a very special touch, built from one of the white pines that had to be removed from the property.

Pottery, collected by Sheila's father, needlepoint and a quilt made by her mother, and collections of art are among the treasures displayed in the home. "They really appreciate still having these things in the family and because all of the colours we chose were sort of earth tones and natural colours, everything just worked out perfectly," says Sheila, as she also points to pictures of Jamie's greatgrandfather, his grandfather and the locks in Fenelon Falls. "There is a connection to all of these things. We were fortunate to not have to go to an antique store to pick these items up," she says





In the kitchen, cream Cambria quartz countertops keep the space light and bright. An island does double duty as a favourite perch or a prep space. "The fact that you can make your food at the island here and still be part of the whole conversation is great. It is a very social space," says Jamie.

Pocket doors at either end of the main bathroom permit access from the guest room or from the main entrance. "You just have to lock that door, and our guest has their own private en suite at night time," says Sheila. One of their indulgences was being able to tile the walls in the home's two bathrooms rather than just the floor. "John **Morrison** with RWH did an amazing job in lining up the tile patterns." A laundry room doubles as a mudroom, accessible from the roadside main entrance. When the old nearby railway track was removed, they salvaged some of the iron spikes and cleverly repurposed them as coat hooks.

Rather than air conditioning, they decided to install ceiling fans. "If it is a dead quiet night, we like hearing the loons. We are so close to the water we can hear the waves lapping," says Jamie. The downstairs is unfinished. The bathroom is roughed in, and they will eventually add an office, a family room and two bedrooms for their daughters and sons-in-law. Continued on page 42

Look up. Is a popcorn ceiling staring back at you? If so, it might be time for a change. Here's some inspiration for that overlooked "fifth wall" in every room.



Reclaimed barn boards add rustic, textured character and provide an interesting colour palette to draw from. Plywood is another choice and when sealed with a gloss varnish, adds warmth and simplicity to a space.



BEADBOARD No longer just for the cottage, use it of the cottage.


No longer just for the cottage, use it on any ceiling. In a peaked ceiling, try running the boards vertically towards the peak, it will draw the eye upwards. A real time saver if placed right over a popcorn ceiling.

COFFERED DIMENSIONAL

You need ceiling height to get the full effect of this style of finish, as the elements can overwhelm a nine-foot ceiling. This design adds formality and looks best in a living or dining room.

INDUSTRIAL

The unfinished, finished look is not for everyone. Exposed duct work and wiring can be a turn off to some, while others are excited by the conversion of industrial spaces into housing.





Metal ceiling tiles were introduced in the 1800s as an affordable alternative to detailed plasterwork. Today, reproductions are plastic and come in a variety of patterns. Of course, if you can find the antique tiles, their patina and dented appearance will add incredible character.

LIGHTING

LED lights come in many options these days. Pot lights are smaller and directional and bulbs come in cool and warm light. LED strips or tape come in several lengths and colours and are waterproof.



PAINT-

In some ways, paint is one of the easiest ways to finish a ceiling, but try to move away from white. Stencils, stripes, faux finishes and glazes will add that extra touch or just use a high-gloss paint in a rich dark colour.

MOULDING

With a seemingly endless choice of mouldings available, creating a design pattern on the ceiling is only limited by your imagination. Foam or plastic ceiling medallions can start the design and highlight a hanging fixture.



BEAMS

If beams are existing and need an update they can be re-clad. You can paint or stain existing beams. Faux wood beams can also be added. **OH**



Clipped and formal hedgerows have charmed society for centuries. Used to create living privacy walls, boundaries and attractive garden borders, hedges have many practical uses and also add value to any property.





YOUR INVESTMENT

The use of hedges dates back to 4000 BC in ancient Egypt where the first boxwoods were clipped for ornamental purposes. Amazingly, this style has some serious staying power as they are still being used present day. As mentioned, hedges can serve multiple purposes: they can conceal unsightly views, create privacy from nosy neighbours and significantly cut down on noise pollution. Hedging can make a patio space warm and cosy by acting as a windbreak and it can cut down on snow accumulation by acting as a snow fence. It can delineate property lines and formalize gardens that contain more unruly plant life by creating a tidy edge.

Hedges can be planted in a range of types and sizes depending on the required result. Select the plant that meets your needs.

THYME: One of the shortest hedge plants available and sometimes called edges instead of hedges, these borders look especially smart in formal herb gardens when acting as dividing lines between other, wilder looking herb species.

BOXWOOD: The "little black dress" of the garden world (meaning everyone should have one), boxwood is the perfect small to medium size hedge. Its pretty evergreen leaves take very well to pruning. Korean Littleleaf Boxwood (Buxus microphylla var koreana) is one of the heartiest, just be sure to plant it in an area that isn't exposed to high winds or road salt.

YEW: Yews make gorgeous hedges but range wildly in height from two-and-ahalf-feet to over 50-feet so read the plant





labels carefully. As with most evergreens, it can be susceptible to wind burn and needs to be protected from strong winter winds.

CEDAR: Probably the hedging you are most familiar with, cedar is an ideal choice where a tall, slim, year-round privacy screen is needed. White cedar, black cedar, even emerald cedar will work well. Rest assured, cedar trees don't specifically attract mosquitoes though any moist and shady spot will! Prune annually in mid-July for best results.

HEMLOCK: Although Canadian hemlock grow as large trees in the wild, they are sometimes sold in shrub form for use as hedges. Prune hemlock hedging twice per year, from late June to late August, for the first three years to encourage dense growth. After three years, prune once in late June, just don't cut the leader until it's at the desired height.

NORTHERN PRIVET: A lovely fast-growing deciduous hedge of about six feet in height. It has small bright green leaves and enjoys getting trims.

ALPINE CURRENT: A very hearty mid-sized deciduous shrub with interesting leaf shape. It also tolerates high winds, cold and road salt well.

PYRAMIDAL ENGLISH OAK, HORNBEAM,

DAWYCK BEECH: Perhaps not the typical scenario that most people think of for hedging, but really, any narrow deciduous tree can be planted tightly in a row to style a tall hedge. These work well where a tall screen is needed but spacing is tight. They can look very stately.

LILAC, DOGWOOD, ROSE OF SHARON, SPIREA. BURNING BUSH. HYDRANGEA.

WEIGELA: Many garden variety deciduous shrubs can be trained as hedges, just be sure to prune yearly to achieve the desired height and width. It's also imperative that if you'd like your hedge to flower, prune at the correct time of year so that you aren't removing the flower buds prematurely. A good rule of thumb is prune late-flowering shrubs in early spring and spring-flowering shrubs after flowering.


The amount of space you have and how dense you'd like your screen will determine the number of rows you plant. For large spaces, consider planting a double row to make a hedge fill in twice as fast. Spacing between rows is based on crown width, but at a minimum try to avoid root crowding by setting at least

12- to 24-inches apart, measuring from the centre of the plant. Spacing will depend on the type of shrub or tree chosen, how close you'd like them at maturity, and your patience level. Keep in mind, when planting in rows close together, trees and shrubs will not spread out as wide as if they were a single species in a landscape.

Start training your hedge after it is established and growing vigorously. Generally this takes one to two years after planting. To train, trim top and sides as required for the species, removing about one-half the length of new shoots. Ideal hedge shapes are wider at the base than the top to allow sunlight to reach the lower leaves.

It can take a few years after planting for a new hedge to take shape and start looking great. Be patient, they are worth the investment! OH







PAVLOVA with citrus curd

THIS MERINGUE-BASED DESSERT IS CRISPY ON THE OUTSIDE AND SOFTER INSIDE. CITRUS JUICE AND BERRIES MAKE IT SUMMER FRESH.

RECIPE AND PHOTOGRAPHY JENELLE MCCULLOCH

Pavlova

INGREDIENTS

4 egg whites

Pinch of salt

¼ cup cold water

1 ¼ cup sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 tsp vinegar

1 Tbsp + 1 tsp cornstarch

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 300°C. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Draw a six-inch circle in the centre on the side of the parchment that will face down. This will be your guide when you shape the pavlova.

Combine egg whites and salt in a stand mixer and beat on mediumhigh until stiff peaks are formed. Be careful not to over-whip the egg whites at this stage. The egg whites will be thick and foamy and a peak will form when the beater is lifted out of the egg. Turn the mixer to low and slowly add the water and then the sugar. Turn the mixer back up to medium-high and beat until stiff peaks are again formed. The eggs will be thick and glossy. Remove bowl from mixer and fold in vanilla, vinegar and cornstarch.

Pile the meringue onto the circle on the baking sheet. With a spatula, smooth edges and top of the pavlova so it almost forms a dome. If preferred, create ridges in the side of the pavlova by swiping the sides in an upward motion.

Bake the pavlova for 30 minutes. Do not open oven! Turn oven down to 275°C and bake for another 45 minutes. Let cool completely in the oven for an hour or overnight. It is normal for the pavlova to crack and the centre to sink in.

Remove from oven when cool



Citrus Curd

INGREDIENTS

4 egg yolks

1/4 cup citrus juice of choice (lemon, blood orange, etc.)

1 tsp citrus zest

⅓ cup sugar

3 Tbsp unsalted butter

DIRECTIONS

Combine all ingredients in a double boiler and heat on medium-high, stirring continuously until mixture thickens and coats the back of a spoon. Strain curd through a fine

mesh sieve into a bowl. Cover the top of the curd with plastic wrap directly on the curd and chill until cooled.

GARNISHES




