





Built on the shores of Lake Ontario, this artistically modern 1967 abode is an architectural vision overlooking an endless turquoise oasis. Continued on page 39

Owners Jan Lean and Kevin Cruickshanks purchased the home four years ago and embarked on a complete restoration – inside and out – of this stunning waterfront property.

The exterior re-do is a marvel. The couple realized early that the trees populating their three-quarters-of-an-acre property had deteriorated, leaving them no choice but to cut them down. However, the decision led to an opportunity for them to create their own scenic vision with help from Oriole Landscaping.

With a breathtaking view from every window, the couple honed in on the natural elements for the exterior landscape, their design responding to the sandy shoreline that appears to stretch for miles. The fabulous design includes an in-ground spa pool, located just steps from the lake, as well as an outdoor sitting room, perfect for evening gatherings.

Travelling to and from Michigan and the family cottage at Rice Lake during the restoration process, Jan and Kevin were able to be on-site to encourage the process and to delegate when necessary. They used local contractors and home décor vendors to create a modern interior infused with art in a home they could both appreciate.

A gravel laneway, tucked away from the main road, leads to the property. The home's soft lines blend flawlessly with its natural surroundings.

As you walk through the front door, the exterior naturally invites itself indoors as earthy tones flow throughout the foyer. The high-gloss, eggshell porcelain floors reflect the natural light beaming through the floor-to-ceiling windows, giving the impression that you are standing at the foot of the water's edge.

The living room introduces itself to the kitchen and dining area. Jan and Kevin wanted an open concept feel to better entertain guests.


Stainless-steel shelving above the sink and stove offers clean lines against a transparent glass backsplash that reflects the natural light and showcases a beautifully designed fixture, imported from Spain, which hovers over the dining table. 


The lower level reveals more of the homeowners' personalities as the old meets the new, with modern furniture in the media room and eclectic pieces in the second guest bedroom.


