Designer Stephanie Redmond answers your questions.

Dear Stephanie.

What's hot in decorating for 2010? My house is ready for a change and I want to know "what's hot" and "what's not" so I can start planning my projects. I don't want to make any mistakes. Can you help? - Carolyn S.

Stephanie Redmond replies:

My bet is more sustainable style to come for 2010 – think eco-chic in all shapes and forms - Low VOC paints, furniture in recycled materials, organic cottons and linens.

As far as colour trends go, use earth tones or, in direct contrast, shockingly bright colours and metallics. Primary tones are everywhere from kitchen utensils to appliances in red, yellow and blue. Going "green" could take on a whole new meaning next year. And the good news about paint is, if you make a mistake, you can always get out the paintbrush and apply another coat.


Stephanie Redmond replies:

LIVING "OFF THE GRID": A Tale of Two Houses BY PAUL WILSON

One chilly October in the late 1980s, I spent a weekend deep in the New Hampshire woods with an acquaintance who had built himself a small, airtight cabin far beyond the reach of any electrical service. It was a classic "off-the-grid" setup, with an array of solar panels that pumped and heated his water, and allowed him to run a few small appliances. But as the darkness closed in and the Coleman lamps kept sucking oxygen out of the air, the place, with its tiny windows, began to feel more like a Hobbit's house than a human dwelling, and my host's enthusiastic banter about the joys of self-sufficiency began to sound hollow. Nor did it help that his wife remained sullen and silent most of the time, as though she had heard it all before and wasn't buying it. When Monday came, I couldn't wait to get back to my unenlightened life of parasitic dependency on the grid.

And that was pretty much where my thinking remained for the next couple of decades: "Off the grid?" Nice idea, but I didn't want to live there. Then I met the Bartram-Thomases.

Bill Bartram and Janet Bartram-Thomas are retired school teachers who have a beautiful, modern home in a rugged forest area on the Niagara Escarpment, about a quarter of a kilometre from the nearest side road. They designed it themselves and it would fit right into any upscale urban neighbourhood. The ground floor is a bright, airy, open space that combines kitchen, dining and sitting room, with large windows on three sides affording a panoramic view of the surrounding forest. In winter, when I first went to visit, the place was cosy, warmed by radiant floor heating and an airtight wood stove. To the naked eye, it was just exactly what it appeared to be - a well thought out, comfortable dwelling made for contemporary living.

Yet a few dozen yards from the Bartram-Thomas home, across a small clearing, there is an insulated shed with an array of photovoltaic solar panels on one wall, slanted upward to catch the sun. Inside the shed, batteries collect and store the electricity the panels generate and an



inverter transforms the power - just over one kilowatt - from direct to alternating current to feed the household appliances. As long as the sun is shining, they have plenty of electricity. Another part of the shed houses a diesel generator that kicks in automatically when the batteries need recharging at night or in cloudy weather.

The south-facing roof of the house holds a second array of panels – solar thermal panels this time – that heat up a glycol solution that powers the in-floor heating system and warms water for household use. The airtight stove has a water-jacket that feeds additional hot water into the heating system. The electronics and mechanisms that control these systems are discreetly hidden away in service areas and for extra cold spells there's propane backup to keep the house at 50 degrees Fahrenheit even when no one's home. "We were pioneers," Janet said, "but we also wanted our creature comforts."

Bill and Janet built their off-the-grid house six years ago and, despite advances in solar technology, I realized that the real difference between their lovely home and that cramped, uncomfortable cabin in New Hampshire lay in the priorities. My American friend had built his dwelling to accommodate the technology; design, for him, was secondary and he accepted the notion that a certain amount of roughing it went with the territory. The Bartram-Thomases, no strangers themselves to roughing it, had designed the technology to accommodate their notion of creature comfort. Two different approaches - two different outcomes. There was no question in my mind which I preferred.

Of course, Bill and Janet freely admit to making some mistakes along the way. The builder and the solar technicians were often at loggerheads. "It was as if they were speaking two different languages," Janet said. "Now I'll bet you can get a contractor who has people trained to work with alternate energy."

"And it wouldn't have cost too much more to have a basement put in," Bill added. "That would be a much better place for the batteries and the inverter, because they are temperature sensitive. And we'd put a monitor right inside the house that would tell us how much power is being generated and what load we're putting on the system."

But their biggest druther surprised me. "In hindsight," Bill said, "we wouldn't go completely off the grid. We'd still have put in solar, but we'd also have brought power in, because then we'd be in a position to sell back."

Bill was referring to a revolutionary approach to power generation and distribution that is lurching into life in Ontario, a system that some analysts say is one of the most forward-thinking in the world. With a series of new acts of parliament, most recently the "Green Energy Act" passed this May, Ontario, among other things, is poised to activate a program called "net metering" (go to www.hydroonenetworks.com to download their Net Metering brochure) in which people who generate their own domestic power will be able to send any excess back into the grid in exchange for credits on their electricity bill, thus precluding the need for expensive batteries and generator backup. But you can only take advantage of it if you're connected to the grid.

Building or retrofitting a home with solar or wind power can be expensive and is not to be lightly undertaken. Even the best designed system requires some changes in one's lifestyle; a badly designed system can put serious strains on a relationship. Janet and Bill were both equally committed to the project, but they told me of a couple with a poorly installed system that almost destroyed their marriage.

"Still, if we can do it, anybody can do it," Janet said. "We're English teachers. We're not immersed in the science or technology of it. We just took a flying leap and trusted that, somehow, it would work. And it did." **OH**




The addition of original artwork into your home can instill life and energy into an ordinary space. There is greater depth and detail inherent in an original artwork. Brushstrokes convey energy, together with the seemingly spontaneous application of the medium. It can be thought provoking, mood enhancing and will add another dimension to your home. Art is a personal reflection of you and if you are considering investing in your home, artwork and the proper lighting alone can create a huge visual impact.

However, jumping from viewing art to purchasing original artwork for your home can be daunting for the beginner. There are some basic guidelines that will help you overcome your fear and increase your confidence and enjoyment of the visual arts.

- 1. Develop a base knowledge and explore what you like. The first task is to determine what you like. An introductory knowledge of fine arts through the ages would provide a useful framework for this exercise. Visit the galleries and museums in your area and see as much as you can. Explore the Internet, and visit your local library, special exhibitions and art events – all good ways to get an overview of the art scene. Acquaint yourself with different art forms, genres and styles.
- **2. Visit art galleries.** Visiting galleries during their open house events is a great way to learn: visiting artists or gallery staff may give presentations about featured work. These events also give you a chance to meet other people who have similar interests to yours. Join their mailing list to stay informed on happenings in the art community, new shows and events and openings. You'll gain more exposure to the art world. The more you know, the easier it will be for you to find the right piece.
- **3. Find a mentor.** On your research journey, if possible, find a knowledgeable individual to guide you.

- 4. Should you buy a work of art just because a certain artist **painted it?** Never buy a work of art just for the artist's name. Bear in mind that most artists produce quite an uneven body of work. Not every work will be a masterpiece. Buy on strength of the work, not because the artist is popular. Prices will vary not only by style or period, but also by size. As a rule of thumb, the earlier works from a particular period, those featuring the artist's signature (most popular) subject matter, are often the most expensive. Like everything else, however, there are exceptions to this rule. Similarly, when it comes to genre, (Impressionism, Expressionism, Realism, etc.), theme (landscapes, seascapes, still-lifes, portraits, abstracts) or media (oil, acrylic, mixed media, charcoal, lithography), let it boil down to personal choice, not the current trend.
- 5. Take into account where you want to hang it. Do you plan on displaying art throughout the house or in specific rooms? What kind of space do you have - large or small? Choose art according to area size. Large canvasses or sculptures need to be appreciated where the viewer can stand back to see it in its entirety. Make sure there is room to do that. Smaller pieces work in a myriad of places and can also be grouped together.
- **6. Only buy what you love!** Buying a work of art and hoping to make a profit is foolish even for the seasoned collector, never mind the beginner art enthusiast. But more than that, collecting artwork is an investment in the understanding of the human soul – it's what distinguishes us from other forms of life in our ability to create and appreciate art. Buying art that is loved is buying art that will always have a place in your life. It will be forever rewarding. Most importantly, don't let the opinions of others sway you. Art is a personal experience and every work will have a different impact on each viewer. You are the one who is buying, and going to live with the art, not your friends – so buy what you like. **oh**







RONA stores across the province will accept leftover paint for free recycling, part of a new initiative to keep as much as 33,000 tonnes of hazardous household waste from being buried.

The RONA Inc. initiative, which copies a decade-old program operated in Quebec, is one of several efforts being mounted under the new Municipal Hazardous or Special Waste program.

RONA will take the paint it collects and ship it to a Quebec-based company where it will be "reconditioned" and sold under the brand name Boomerang in RONA stores. Leftover latex and alkyd paint, stain and varnish are all accepted.

"Boomerang will be on shelves as soon as we have sufficient quantity," said Michael Rushton, RONA'S vice-president of big-box stores in Ontario. "This is all part of our new initiative to be more sustainable and eco-friendly."



















The scene is reminiscent of the western Rockies. But this magnificent home, by **Natural Prestige Log Homes**, is situated on the Niagara Escarpment, south of Ravenna, in a location fit for a true outdoorsman. Meet Brock Martin, the owner of this Scandinavian, fully-scribed log home on a 25-acre, treed parcel of land backing onto the Grey County Managed Forest. Martin selected the site for its easy access to miles of cross-country ski and mountain bike trails.

Entering the home, you are struck by the massive scale of the logs that frame the grand front entrance. The sense of natural solidity continues as the spacious entranceway opens on to a large great room with its cluster of comfortable furniture surrounding a natural wood fireplace constructed of grey, dry-stacked Georgian Bay ledge rock by **John Davidson Masonry**.

The hearth's chimney soars toward a cathedral ceiling highlighted by large log trusses accented by custom carvings. The effect is exhilarating – an exciting marriage of land and sky and forest. Engineered hardwood plank flooring by Collingwood's **Georgian Design Centre** allows

the central gathering space to flow into the dining/kitchen area with its cherry cabinetry. The food preparation space maintains the home's natural look while incorporating state-of-the-art, modern conveniences such as stainless steel appliances, a unique antique range and a functional granite-topped island that doubles as a breakfast bar. Here, over a cup of morning coffee, my conversation with Anthony Johnston, Project Manager of Natural Prestige Log Homes, begins.

Johnston radiates enthusiasm when he talks of the specialized construction techniques necessary to log fabrication. "I was attracted to log homes because of my background in the ski industry in British Columbia and Alberta," Johnston says. "I love the look and the lifestyle they convey. Nothing looks better than a log home in winter. As far as construction goes, you can do pretty creative things with wood...I learned the techniques for Scandinavian full-scribe, round log homes out west and in Norway. The logs we use are eastern white pine from northern Ontario." Johnston adds that the Georgian Bay area has the largest concentration of log homes in Canada. Continued on page 98





He stresses that, along with finished log homes, his company is eager to fashion log and timber accents for homes constructed in the timber frame or post-and-beam style or those with stucco or wood siding. "You'd be surprised how log beams or faux beams can enhance the interior and exterior of any country home," Johnston says.

When asked about the process a prospective client would go through in building a log dwelling, Johnston outlines the steps. "First of all, I'd talk with the client about the kind of home they wanted. Then, I'd want to see how the land the structure sits on could be maximized so that the home can take full advantage of the views the property offers. Next comes the generation of plans by a designer with log-home construction experience. This is critical because log construction is a highly specialized field. Finally, after budget and contract details are mutually determined, I would act as project manager from start to finish to ensure that things are done right."

Looking around, you are instantly struck by the fine detail and custom craftsmanship involved in log-home construction. Creating such a distinctive interior simply requires more time and work. Such care is evident in the intricate, handcrafted cedar handrail that leads to Martin's sleek modern office in the loft above the great room. Continued on page 100



The same attention to detail is found in the finished basement with its rustic log bar, accented by a unique light fixture acknowledging the homeowner's passion for piloting planes. Beyond the bar is a full home movie theatre with plush seating. The indoor theatre sports a complete surround-sound system by **Georgian Audio Video**, the same firm that installed the home's ambient sound system allowing music from satellite radio to personal iPods to be directed to specific areas throughout the house.

Another custom detail in the basement is the bear paw and fish carvings etched into the slate floor tiles that lead to a locker room and ski storage. This area gets heavy use when Martin's two sons visit.

Johnston talks of the practical fundamentals that lie beneath the home's singular charm. "The original techniques were imported from Scandinavia," he says. "The oldest log homes date back a thousand years Today their construction is a hallmark of Canada. To make irregular-

shaped logs fit together we use a tool called a scribe that allows us to shape the logs to make a perfect seal. Also, logs shrink over time when water in the wood evaporates as the wood dries. To allow for this process of settling, we install screw jacks below vertical posts. The jacks are lowered every six months in the early life of the home to allow for this settling effect. Likewise, windows, doors, cabinetry and plumbing must be fabricated to accommodate for settling. After all, wood, like stone, is a natural material with an organic cell structure."

The Canadian art pieces that grace this beautiful home complement the earthy appeal of its log construction. Western artist Wanda Whaley's cave drawings on slate are displayed on the mantel. Aboriginal carver Enook Manomie's soap stone sculpture of a dancing bear symbolizes the joy found in nature - a perfect accent for a home in the forest.

Both works of art reflect the care, craft and timelessness captured in this wonderful log home. OH

ROASTED GARLIC SHRIMP COCKTAIL with 3 Dipping Sauces

Shrimp Cocktail is a classic holiday entertaining hors d'oeuvre and a favourite for many. This year, instead of opting for the frozen ring variety from the local grocery store, try your hand at making your own from start to finish. Rather than water-logged shrimp and pale-tasting sauce, wow your guests with plump, sweet garlicky roasted shrimp and a choice of three cocktail sauces, each bursting with unique flavour. Serve the shrimp warm or chilled with your choice of sauce – or all three sauces and let guests decide for themselves.

For small parties, shot glasses with a spoonful of sauce and a shrimp each make an interesting and novel presentation. For larger groups, a platter and bowls for the sauce will do just as well. Be sure to set out an empty bowl for people to place their shrimp tails, better there than in your planters! Increase the recipe amounts as needed to suit the crowd. Happy Holidays!

TO PREPARE THE SHRIMP:

Toss 2 lb large deveined shrimp, with tails left on, with 2 tbsp olive oil, 2 cloves minced garlic, 1/2 tsp salt and 1/4 tsp pepper. Spread shrimp in single layer on a foil-lined baking sheet. Roast in 450°F oven for three minutes. Turn each shrimp over and roast for an additional two-to-three minutes, until shrimp are opaque and firm. Transfer to serving platter. Refrigerate until thoroughly chilled, if desired.



BASIC COCKTAIL SAUCE:

Stir Together:

1/2 cup ketchup

2 tbsp horseradish

2 tbsp lemon juice

2 tsp Worcestershire sauce

Pinch of salt

Serve with shrimp. Makes about 1 cup.

CHILI LIME COCKTAIL SAUCE:

Stir Together:

1/4 cup ketchup

1/4 cup chili sauce

2 tbsp lime juice

1 tbsp horseradish

1/2 to 1 seeded and minced jalapeno pepper

1 tbsp finely diced red onion

1 tsp ground coriander and a pinch of salt

Serve with shrimp. Makes about 1 cup.

OLIVE PAPRIKA COCKTAIL SAUCE:

Stir together:

1/2 cup ketchup

2 tbsp finely chopped green olives

1 tsp grated lemon zest

2 tbsp lemon juice

1 tbsp mayonnaise

1 tbsp chopped parsley


1 tsp smoked paprika


1 tsp Worcestershire sauce and a pinch of salt

Masters decided to "Upcycle" the chair.


Upcycling is a reinvestment in the environment. It involves taking something destined for the landfill and giving it new life by transforming the item into something of greater use and value.

- Once the chair was back in Masters' hands, she sanded the arms back to the wood and then
 dry-brushed black paint into the exposed areas.
- Finally, the chair was varnished.


