SETTING THE SCENE

SUMMER ENTERTAINING

Entertaining is always such a pleasure – picking the food, the wine, the music. I like to make sure the house is tidy and the kids are clean, and then it never fails – I leave setting the table to the last minute. I can hear the veteran entertainers gasping but it's true. I mean let's face it, entertaining should be about the food and the company, but putting in a little aesthetic effort sets the tone for the event and quite frankly, it can be a lot of fun.

The Base Layer

Think of a tablecloth as your base layer. Be bold or keep it simple. White linen is always a lovely classic that can be layered with colourful or neutral dishware. For a modern-country aesthetic (or if you're on a budget), use burlap. It stains and can't really be washed, but for a one-night affair, it's the perfect cheap and cheerful fix.

If you're not into tablecloths you can always start with placemats or a runner. Generally you can't accommodate both, but it depends on the width of your table. If you choose to do both, make sure they don't overlap or your table will feel crowded and messy. I love a thin linen placemat with a fine detail around the edge. It looks contemporary and timeless.

The Necessities

If you have a full set of dishware, don't feel obliged to use everything that got ticked off your wedding registry. Mix and match so it doesn't feel too uptight. And if you're lacking on serving pieces, set up a buffet and skip the table clutter altogether.

You can layer three different sets of dishes and not feel stiff if you pick the right combination. Try a plain white base, a patterned centre dish and a textural plain top piece. Whether you're formal or free-spirit, the style of tableware will set the tone. And plain white is always an option (pair with colourful linens, flowers, serving dishes and candles to add some interest).

Twigs And Petals

A striking assembly of flowers in the centre of the table is always beautiful but the guidelines for flowers are: Make sure they are not

overly scented; are not too tall so people sitting across from one another can see each other and not so wide that a guest ends up with a hydrangea in their soup. For something less traditional, create a long grouping of greenery down the centre, running the entire length of the table. It takes a bit of work, but the effect is striking.

Lighting

Please don't make your guests eat underneath a 100-watt bulb without a dimmer! Lighting is key. It's important to see your food, but it's equally important to not feel like you're eating at a sports complex.

Dim the lighting and light the candles. If you're outside, try battery-operated candles or tall glass hurricanes to block the breeze.

A Little Je Ne Sais Quoi...


Sometimes we just need to treat ourselves (and our guests). Here are a few ideas to keep you on the VIP list:

- Decant your wine – it allows your wine to breathe and looks great.
- Put sea salt in a small bowl (personally I prefer to use my fingers so I can feel how much salt I'm using).
- Put out some nuts or small appetizers. Life is busy, and we're all on the run. Don't leave your guests waiting for dinner to be served.
- Have sparkling and still water available – invest in a Soda Stream if you like carbonated water, it saves money and recycling.
- Make butter balls – I know, it's 80s, but who doesn't like a butter ball?
- Create a playlist beforehand so you are not fussing with the music throughout the evening.
- Use your old brass candlesticks – with tall white candles they add whimsy and formality.







WHERE TO NOW?



Baby boomers are giving retirement a whole new meaning, especially when choosing where to live.

“Today’s seniors are not your grandmother’s seniors,” says Susan Eng, vice-president of advocacy for CARP, a national group dedicated to enhancing the lives of aging Canadians. “There is a huge difference in terms of attitudes and expectations about what they ought to be doing,” Eng tells *Zoomer* magazine.

Census statistics show 92 per cent of Canadians age 65 and older live in their own homes, homes that are changing in step with the habits of people born during the 18-year baby boom that followed the Second World War. Retiring boomers are living longer than previous generations. Most intend to work, in some form, beyond age 65. They want to stay active, engaged and healthy for as long as they can. For many, that means moving to a home better suited to a new lifestyle, an opportunity to live life on their own terms, to get what they want as well as what they need.

Anyone who has owned a home in the city or nearby suburb for 25 years or more can sell it and buy a new house in a small town for less than half the cost of a city home. It’s an appealing idea, and a growing industry caters to this market.

Design consultant Adam Stuart is too young to be a boomer, but in the past six years he’s helped design nearly 200 homes, most of them for retirees who are tearing down old family cottages in their favourite summer haunts and replacing them with new homes.

Most clients, Stuart says, are looking for smaller, low-maintenance, energy-efficient homes. “If they’re going to go away for a couple of months, they can close their houses up quite easily and not have to worry about any pipes leaking,” he says. “They don’t have to worry about spending three or four hundred dollars a month, trying to maintain heat.” They favour homes with open-concept designs. Two-bedroom homes, with en suite baths and main-floor laundries are popular. “A lot of people now are looking for a crawl space, rather than a full-height basement, so they eliminate the amount of stairs in the home,” Stuart says.

Anticipating customers’ future needs, his company offers wider doors for wheelchairs and walkers. It also installs blocking for the

future installation of bathroom grab bars. Quick draining tubs that eliminate that big step over the tub wall are a new option.

Some builders incorporate “visitability” design standards, such as no-step entrances, wide hallways and doors that allow people in wheelchairs and on scooters to come into a home and, if needed, use a ground-floor bathroom.

Although the choice of floor plans, upgrades and finishes can be exciting, a new home, in itself, is just one part of the retirement equation.


Many builders realize retiring baby boomers are making lifestyle decisions. Across Canada, there are hundreds of new neighbourhoods, some as small as a few dozen houses, others with hundreds of homes, geared to people creating a new way of living in retirement.

Each of these communities is distinct, with its own attributes and amenities. Some offer recreation centres, swimming pools, fitness centres and places for people to congregate. Many surround golf courses and offer memberships as part of the home package. Some are built on scenic lake shores, near ski hills and walking trails.

Community kitchens, woodworking shops, art studios and theatres with tiered seating serve a variety of interests.

Often called adult lifestyle communities, these developments attract people who like the idea of aging with neighbours of the same vintage; like-minded people who share similar interests and enjoy the same activities. Selecting the ideal place to build or buy a retirement home takes time and a lot of visits to different communities. It’s a choice that requires looking at the surrounding community as well – medical facilities, hospital, curling rinks, shopping – and gauging the distance to children and grandchildren.

Homes in adult lifestyle communities range in price from \$139,000 for a house in a land lease development to more than \$1 million for a home in a gated community surrounding a private northern lake. Even monthly rentals are available, from \$490 for an apartment to \$763 for a detached house. The choices are endless. They’re not just about bricks and mortar, they’re about enjoying life to the fullest. **OH**

- 1. Accessories:** Use cushions with stags on them, or art with twigs that remind you of the great outdoors – nothing too twee. Lay a visual path to give that wonderful escapist feeling.
- 2. Colour scheming:** A big colour this season is green in its myriad of shades. Layer it on with textures from knobby throws and gorgeous touchy-feely cushions that are a feast for the eyes and fingers. All these things allude to life at the lake.

7. Seasonal adjustment: Pale slipcovers and bright cushions are amazing for changing the mood and look of a room. Check out Bemz.com for slipcovers and myoverlays.com for transfer stickers and panels that adhere to standard, ubiquitous Ikea-style furniture, so you can add images to bookcases and shelves.

8. Scents: "When we are decorating homes for our clients, it probably sounds cliché, we are not just interior designers, but interior diviners," Justin remarks. The mood of a room is changed by how it looks, how it feels and how it smells. So add lots of beautiful scented candles. Buy good soy wax candles that don't contain any of the nasties of the cheaper waxes.

9. Noise: A soft cottage soundtrack will always remind you of the lake. Get an alarm that sounds like a loon. It's such a beautiful, soft way to wake up.

ECHINACEA

With its long blooming and superb display of giant, daisy-like flowers, Echinacea is the perfect easy-care perennial for most sunny locations.

Echinacea Purpurea "Raspberry Truffle"

Attracting butterflies, bees and hummingbirds to gardens across North America, its colourful, fragrant flower heads are held high upon sturdy stems. Though its foliage is somewhat weed-like, going against my usual rule of thumb, the masses of eye-catching blooms vindicates its place in most garden circumstances. Just be sure to hide that weedy vegetation with some nice foliage companion plantings such as dwarf daylily, coreopsis or sedum.

Coneflower Facts

Commonly known as purple coneflower, and possibly Canada's most popular native wildflower, Echinacea is simple to cultivate. Indigenous to the central plains of North America, it performs best in full sun but also adapts to partial shade situations. It is drought tolerant after it establishes. Most varieties are considered large by perennial standard, about 36-inches tall and 24-inches wide. But bear in mind, the plant's height when blooming varies widely by

cultivar and can range anywhere from 12 to 40 inches. Echinacea petals are edible and can be made into a savory spread, added to fruit salad, or sautéed with onion to add to various recipes. Coneflower is a strong and resilient plant resistant to deer destruction and damage from most garden variety pests such as aphids, caterpillars, grasshoppers, Japanese beetles and whiteflies. The only exception is the leafhopper. Though Echinacea is impervious to most sickness, leafhoppers transmit a disease called aster yellows, which often causes the flowers to form abnormally and remain green. Echinacea is also susceptible to powdery mildew.

Remedy For The Common Cold?

Frequently cited for its medicinal attributes, it was aboriginals who dubbed Echinacea "snakeroot," because its thick, black roots were used to treat snakebites. First Nations also used Echinacea as a cure-all for a wide range of other illnesses. *Continued on page 42*

Tomato Soup

Since then, the healing properties of Echinacea as treatment for cold and flu viruses have become recognized world wide. Although the cure to the common cold seems forever elusive, and although the herb's countless advocates claim that it possesses anti-viral and immune-boosting properties, there has been little scientific evidence to substantiate these claims.

So Many Varieties To Choose From!

The genus Echinacea was named after the Greek word "echinos," which means hedgehog or sea urchin and refers to the prickly, spiky central cone of the flower. The old garden standby, Echinacea purpurea had proved to be very easy to hybridize. Recent cultivars produce a rainbow of delicious flower colourations and types consisting of single, double or quilled varieties in hues of magenta, orange, pink, purple, white, green and yellow. Some varieties even boast petals that change colour over time. Continued breeding breakthroughs will surely follow to keep up with the demand for these ever-popular garden perennials. Below are a few of my favourites.

Melanie's Plant Picks

- **Echinacea Purpurea "Magnus"**: Though common, this original heritage favourite still makes my cut. Its magenta petals are held horizontally, making the blooms appear even larger. And with its rusty-orange centre, who says pink and orange don't go together? It's also very robust and multiplies quickly. A close cousin that also

performs amazingly is Echinacea "Pow Wow," with vivid, deep rose-purple petals that retain their colour even longer than the original.

- **Echinacea Purpurea "Raspberry Truffle"**: This is a short and sturdy selection of coneflower with salmon pink blossoms held upon thick chocolate stems. I often prefer the shorter varieties, including Echinacea "Kim's Knee-High" and "Echinacea Red Knee-High" as they take up less room and can be placed towards the front of the perennial border.
- **Echinacea Purpurea "Razzmatazz Pink Double Delight"**: I adore the uniquely shaped pom-pom flowers of this coneflower. Its showy blooms have a rose-pink centre with magenta, daisy-like surrounding petals. It's another shorter, sturdy variety of coneflower that is easy to place, even where space is limited.
- **Echinacea "Big Sky Sunrise"**: Large and architectural, this elegant butter-yellow coneflower is a beauty to behold. Its five-inch blooms have an orange centre with petals that fade from yellow to cream with age.
- **Echinacea "Tomato Soup"**: Tomato Soup is a bright, tomato-red coneflower whose five-inch-diameter flowers feature slightly drooping petals with rounded, dark yellowish-brown centres. Tomato Soup is also one of the larger varieties of the coneflower family.



As with all perennials, be bold and plant in groups with repetition throughout your garden to get maximum impact from this marvelous statement plant. Keep your Echinacea looking its best by deadheading regularly to extend its blooming period, and bring a bouquet inside as they also make excellent cut flowers. In fall, leave your Echinacea standing as the seed heads provide winter interest to the often barren landscape. Plus they provide a food source for local songbirds. And if you haven't yet already, why not experiment with the immune enhancing properties of this famous herb the next time you contract a cold? Science fantasy or science fact; you be the judge! **OH**



GEORGIAN BAY *meets* WEST-COAST MODERN

Fabulous flat rooflines, and windows, windows, windows showcase this modern year-round lakefront home built by Dave Harrington of Absolute Craftsmen Ltd. Whether you're inside or out, the views are spectacular at every turn.

Passing sailors and paddle boarders are treated to the most exciting vantage of a modern glass home built by **Absolute Craftsmen Ltd.**

On the west side of Thornbury, from out on the bay, the face of the glass house reflects water, sky and trees; the roof lines and cement chimney draw the eye in many satisfying directions. On land, the best vantage of the house is from inside the second-floor lounge, which overlooks the courtyard by the front door, but because the front and rear walls of

the house are glass, the view encompasses the stunning great room, past its stone walls and orbs of light, and outside to the shores beyond.

This home is the year-round getaway for a busy Toronto family of five. Originally from British Columbia, when they decided to buy a vacant lot on the water, the owners drew inspiration from the large windows and flat

roofs of the modern homes on B.C.'s West Coast. With a modern design, the family could have their wall of windows, and an airy, open space with simple lines that draw the eye to the home's setting, instead of its interior features. But Georgian Bay winters are more severe than those of coastal Vancouver, so the homeowners needed an architect and builder to design a wall of windows strong enough to withstand bay-side storm fronts.


Enter **Dave Harrington** of Absolute Craftsmen, who is a sought-after builder with 26 years of experience, and a former neighbour





in Craigeith. “We thought of Dave because his house is one of the few in this area with a flat roof and modern design,” says the homeowner.

For Harrington, the 2011-2012 build was exciting. “We rose to the challenge, as did all the trades people we brought on for the project,” says **Christine Harrington**, Dave’s daughter and project manager on the build. “That house inspired me to find my calling,” says Christine. “As a kid, I was around my dad’s job sites a lot. After two years of university, I took a summer job at Absolute Craftsmen and everything changed; there was no turning back to veterinary school after we built this beautiful modern house.”

The homeowners are on a first-name basis with most of the people who built their home. “When our trades feel they have all the resources they need to get their job done, they really perform, and it shows,” says Christine. **Brad Abbott**, of **Abbott Design Ltd.**, drafted the architectural plans, working closely with Collingwood engineer **Dan Barill**, of **Barill Engineering Ltd.**, who ensured the home’s two 24-foot high, 20-foot wide glass walls had steel reinforcements across the top, bottom and middle (windows and doors sourced at Tiltco). Aircraft cables were strung crosswise in the ceiling to hold the walls at a tension, bracing against the shore winds. The home is completely secure and wired for sound, using the expertise of **Red Brick Group**.

Indoor and outdoor spaces merge together. The sauna-grade cedar ceiling, and stone wall cladding start on the front exterior, pass inside across the great room, and end on the rear patio. Floor coverings are dark throughout: custom-stained walnut and flamed-and-polished basalt stone on the inside. Outside, walkouts are man-made Owen Sound pebbled patio-stone sourced by **Parklawn Landscaping**. A

It’s always playtime in this great room! The homeowner designed the area around the orb light fixtures the family call “starry night lights.” One seating area is for TV viewing and another is for enjoying bay views.

16-foot side wall with 10-foot-high bi-fold doors separates the great room from the Muskoka room. A massive cement fireplace, built by **Grey-Bruce Construction Ltd.** and Dave Harrington, is the centre point of the space, with comfortable sofas to relax on by the fire. Motorized screens (installed by Ontario Screen Systems Inc.) can be drawn up or down to keep the bugs out.


The home is heated via both forced air and radiant, in-floor heating, installed by **Nottawasaga Mechanical**. Air ducts

blow a blanket of air up the sides of the great room to combat any drafts from the glass.

Chantico Fireplace Gallery installed a gorgeous 80-inch, two-sided gas fireplace in the front entry, inset in an eight-foot wall to act as a privacy guard at the entrance. "We challenged Chantico to vent the fireplace from below; we didn't want any pipes or bulkheads obstructing the open space inside," says the homeowner. All interior painting was done by **Complete Value Painting**.

The focal point in the great room is a

24-foot rock-climbing wall, professionally installed by Rockwerx of Calgary. The toe holds and wall materials were custom stained to coordinate with the home's stonework. The kitchen opens to a ping-pong table, rather than a formal dining room. "We wanted this to be our fun, relaxing weekend home – simple and easy to care for," says the homeowner.

Rob Perry (Riverside Custom Cabinetry Ltd.) built all cabinetry from the homeowner's design specs, including the kitchen, living room, walk-in closets and bathroom vanities. The cabinets are floating, reinforced to hang from the wall studs. Perry custom manufactured the kitchen in white, moulded acrylic. An 18-foot island is topped in white quartz, with fridges installed underneath in drawers facing the sink and stove.

Off the kitchen, passing through a glass hallway, the couple transition to their private, main floor master suite. Crisp, white floor-to-ceiling drapery, activated on a motorized track, was custom made and installed by **Ashton's Blinds Draperies Shutters**.

Up a set of floating stairs, the three children each have rooms with a view of the water. A media room and lounge is tucked above the garage where the kids do homework on ski weekends.

With open sight lines from the lounge to the glassed-in great room, the family has an easy closeness, staying connected without being in the same room. "Our modern getaway is a place our family and our imaginations can all grow into," says the homeowner. **OH**


THE WARES: In addition to paint, Lisa also showcases products from several local, socially responsible artisans such as: upcycled barnboard furniture from



COLOUR FOR THE colour shy

Does the thought of inviting a new colour into your life make you blush? If you follow my guide, you can learn to pour on the pigment gradually, until you're floating comfortably in an ocean of colour-calm.



1. NO SHAME IN NEUTRALS:

First, let me say there is nothing wrong with a neutral palette. Whether you love a restful beige or a ravishing red, you can start your space from the same foundation:

- Use as many of these textures as possible: paint, paper, stone, wood, metal, plastic, rich fabrics, light fabrics, leather, (faux) fur, grasses/plants and glass. This will ensure your space has variety even before you add colour.
- Introduce patterns for more visual texture, and contrast warm tones (like beige or caramel) against cool tones (like charcoal or silver).
- Metallics especially add depth to a palette without feeling like a bold dose of colour. Try adding gold or copper to warm up a space that feels too minimal, or silver to chill out a space that feels too hot or busy.

2. START SMALL: Once you're ready to introduce colour, let yourself start slowly – you don't necessarily need to go all-in at once. Choose a favourite hue you've always loved (instead of chasing colour trends) and add little touches throughout one room via accessories.

- So that your new hue feels integrated instead of sticking out like a hot-pink thumb, create a "triangle of colour," adding approximately the same shade to three areas; for example, in pillows on your sofa, a throw blanket on a chair and a lamp across the room.



A medium grey wall colour like Benjamin Moore's 2121-30 Pewter works well with almost any colour palette.

- Non-committal items (like pillows) add colour with low-risk. Try new lampshades, candles, vases, glasses, plates, books or linens.
- New art is another easy DIY colour infuser: take paint chips from daring colours and slip them into existing frames for a fun splash, or paint a simple canvas in a few stripes or squares to liven up a bare wall.

3. WIDEN YOUR HUE-RIZONS:

As your colour collection grows bigger, it should also get wider. When you want to add a larger dose of colour, find a secondary hue, or introduce several new tones of your favourite.

- Green and blue are colours we see every day in nature, so we see them as more neutral than fiery reds and yellows. If you're unsure what colour to mix in, green and blue are usually a safe bet for any scheme.
- Fabrics and art can help guide your choices, but don't forget to mimic the proportions of the inspiration piece; notice which colours are used in big or small amounts. Go a few shades darker or greyer when applying these colours to larger surfaces like upholstery or walls.
- A rich colour palette should include at least a little bit of dark and light hues to achieve a full spectrum (even if the overall look leans to one side), so incorporate a touch of white and a sprinkling of black. Achieve this easily with details like art frames, pendant cords or stacked books.

4. GO BIG, NOT CRAZY: A complex palette simply needs a few checks and balances to keep you from going colour crazy.

- Your palette won't appear as busy if a majority of the colours are drawn from the same family. For example, choose jewel tones, pastels, primary colours or pale mid-tones, and keep all the accents in that family so they feel related.
- White and grey will be your friends, as they can work with any colour, while black in large doses can easily become too harsh. Try Benjamin Moore's OC-65 Chantilly Lace as a clean white, or 2121-30 Pewter as a mid-tone grey.
- You can bravely apply colour to almost any surface, and then break it up by adding neutrals over top if it feels like too much. For a busy wallpaper, hang large, framed photos with wide matting; for a sofa, cover the back with neutral pillows. Always view your space as a canvas that can be repainted, remixed and reinvented and you'll never need to fear colour again. **OH**

Nestled into the forest at the end of a long, winding laneway sits a grand, six-acre haven where one Sudbury-based family finds tranquility every weekend. *Continued on page 80*

The Landmark Group worked wonders on the gardens, ponds and meditative areas throughout this beautiful rural property. A *Tree of Life* sculpture brings the gardens together, a metal moose is a nod to the homeowner's northern roots, and a horse and buggy celebrate his French Canadian heritage.

The magic they discovered and built upon lies within a tiny Pretty River tributary that gently runs through the property, giving them peace of mind and a chance to forget about busy work schedules.

“The stress leaves the minute we get on the highway,” says the homeowner. “This has become our play area. We have a different group of friends and different activities here. It’s turned out to be a great place for us.”

The couple discovered the area when they first tried downhill skiing, which led to the purchase of a vacation property at the base of Blue Mountain, but a few years later, they discovered this weekend retreat, and embarked upon a complete overhaul of the property.

The house itself was in a state of decay, but the owners saw nothing but potential, and an opportunity to remodel a house their entire family could enjoy (including six children, grandchildren and visiting parents from Toronto and India).

“The home had good bones,” says the homeowner, “It had really nice features and good configuration. We left the house as is, and we made it work better with the area around it.”

The “area around it” is nothing short of amazing. The homeowners wanted to create a Zen-like garden inspired by *The Tree of Life*, a metal sculpture by Ontario artist Laval Bouchard. It would sit in the centre of the front gardens, which they hoped to blend into the natural surroundings. They also wanted functional family spaces, as well as a spot to just decompress. So, they called upon **The Landmark Group** to design, implement, and manage the large landscaping project.

“We came up with the idea of multiple destination points (for different purposes and times of day), linked together with walking paths and visual motifs (sculpture, plantings and water),” says **Darren Bosch**, Design and Client Services Manager with The Landmark Group, “so you can meander around and enjoy all the meditation gardens and reflective places in different ways, but in the same experience.”

Upon entering the property, clusters of large trees and unique metal sculptures, including a horse-drawn wagon and a glorious

moose, greet guests as they arrive at this stately 6,000 sq. ft. home with an additional 2,000 sq. ft. in-law suite.

Strolling around the home, along limestone walkways and deck areas, visitors are invited to enjoy everything the property has to offer – thousands of plants, trees, a stream, two ponds, and sculptures everywhere, with relaxation stations around every bend.

Using over 3,500 native perennials, The Landmark Group created layers of colour and multiple grade changes to blend the gardens into the untouched forested surroundings. They also created various walk-out areas, shaded spaces and many gathering spots for friends and family. A fire pit, built near the waterfall and stream, allows guests to enjoy the symphonic sounds of nature just steps away from both the forest and home.

Working closely with the homeowners, The Landmark Group enhanced three acres of property and installed a programmable irrigation and lighting system.

“As with all our projects big or small, I went through extensive listening and “round-table” gatherings to assess the family’s lifestyle and needs, wish-list, design style, property challenges, site analysis, budget, etc.,” says Darren. “Together, we created a vision of how they

Inside the home, it’s evident the homeowners are fans of American architect and interior designer Frank Lloyd Wright,



beautiful custom kitchen and dining area, just off the entryway. The kitchen features a very large island with stained-glass inserts and a vintage French stove, where family chef, "dear ol' dad," often cooks a fabulous Saturday morning breakfast. The kitchen and eating areas are large enough to treat family members and guests to a wonderful meal; the preparations are often a family affair.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU *Lemons...*



Nothing tastes like summer more than a big, refreshing gulp of cool lemonade.

You don't see kids setting up soda stands or coffee stands at the ends of their driveways. No, those wouldn't inspire the nostalgia that comes with the sweet, citrusy flavour of homemade lemonade on a hot, sunny day, would they? In fact, there are few beverages that celebrate a season quite like lemonade, so it only seems fair to pay an ode to this tasty treat that's steeped in many of our favourite summertime memories.

While the origin of lemonade is unknown (though some believe it originated in Ancient Egypt over 1,500 years ago), you may be surprised to discover that North America has a slightly different take on the drink than most other countries. In the United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand and some European countries, lemonade is a carbonated drink, more like the lemon-lime sodas offered here. Ireland, meanwhile, has three kinds of lemonade: red, brown and white!

Pink lemonade, along with several other fruit-flavoured lemonades have become popular over the years, but they all start with the same basic ingredients: lemons, sugar and water. Try out our traditional recipe along with some variations, including healthy substitutes, and entertain some guests with our delicious watermelon and lemonade cocktail!

Variations:

- Make it healthier by replacing white sugar with ½ cup raw honey or coconut sugar.
- For pink lemonade, add a few tablespoons of grenadine.
- Add herbs, such as basil, thyme or mint to the syrup after removing it from the heat, to infuse the flavours. Remove from syrup before adding to pitcher.
- Make limeade by switching out the lemons for limes.
- Use half sparkling water and half plain water for a carbonated beverage. **OH**

TRADITIONAL LEMONADE

Makes one large pitcher

6-8 lemons, squeezed (about one cup lemon juice)

5 cups water

1 cup sugar

- Make a simple syrup by combining the sugar and 1 cup of water in a small saucepan and bring to a gentle simmer over low heat to dissolve sugar. Once completely dissolved, remove from heat to cool.
- Squeeze the lemons until you have one cup of juice. (Rolling the whole lemons on the cutting board first can help release the juices.)
- Add the cooled syrup to your pitcher, followed by the lemon juice and the remaining 4 cups of water. Stir, taste and adjust. Add ice and serve with garnish, such as a slice of fresh fruit or sprig of mint.

days, the Toronto couple acquired the property. “We always knew we wanted to tear down the old cottage and build a place large enough for my big family to visit,” says Mary, “so we lived in it for two years, and got a good feel for the property.”

After interviewing several builders, the couple chose **Paul Rogers**, owner of **Valleyview Construction**, to build their four-season waterfront home. Says Tim, “It was a positive building experience in every way, and we remain friends with Paul and his wife Anne.”

Paul introduced Mary and Tim to **Pamela Farrow**, an architectural technologist he has partnered with on 15 homes. During Pam’s initial visit to the old cottage, she asked numerous questions about how the family live in their space. Tim replied, “I get up early and go for a run. After a swim, I sit at the dining room table, drink coffee and read the *Globe and Mail*, checking the view every couple of minutes.”

When Pam visited after the home was built, the first thing she asked when she

When Mary and Susan Taylor were growing up, they watched their father build quality custom homes in the Waterloo area. His slogan was proudly displayed on the back of his truck: “Have Your Home Taylor-Built.” His reputation grew, and the girls soon developed an appreciation for beautifully-constructed homes.

Fast-forward many years. The same Mary Taylor, and her husband Tim Burkholder, were on the hunt for a cottage. Serendipitously, after spending an active weekend with friends of their son’s in Thornbury, cycling and running, Mary spotted an ad for a waterfront cottage just down the road.

She toured the property with **Mary Norris (Cherché House of Design)**, whose brother-in-law owned the old cottage, and within



with the trundle bed is, the stone and wood frame on the outside, a stunning semi-circular staircase leading to the second floor, a bridge to the fourth bedroom, with a hanging fixture open to the main floor below, and of course, all the windows!"

There are 64 windows in this four-bedroom home, which serve to blur the lines between inside and out. Pam took full advantage of the property's amazing side yard light, which most shoreline homes don't have, by installing windows on two sides of the living room, creating a panoramic view wider than 180 degrees, with water views on two sides.

The open-concept kitchen, dining and living rooms feature cathedral and single-slope ceilings of varying heights. "Even though the space is open," says Tim, "the rooms feel like different spaces." The result? One roofline seamlessly blends into the next.

To contribute to the design and décor of their new home, Mary turned to **Cherché House of Design**, and to Ilda Howard,

glanced at the dining room was, "Tim, do you drink coffee, read the *Globe and Mail* and look out the window every few minutes?" "Yes I do," he replied.

The challenge for any designer is to listen carefully to how the homeowners live, and translate their needs and likes into the architectural design. "I'm not the kind of designer who says, "This is my style," says Pam. "There are so many beautiful styles of architecture; it has to be right for the homeowner. Every single job I've done is different. It's all about adaptation (shape, sight, how they live, what they like, where to get the best light and view), and the vision unfolds over time."

Mary told Pam she wanted a Cape-Cod-style shingle home versus a ski house. When Pam drew up the plans, she scribbled "shore house" across the top of the page. The name stuck. Tim and Mary now refer to their new abode as their shore house.

Pam designed the 3,700 sq. ft. home to take advantage of the spectacular views and natural light. She describes the style as, "Neo-Craftsman, with plenty of East Coast influence for shoreline comfort."

Says Mary, "Pam designed so many unique details: a sloping French-Canadian-style roof, a shed dormer where the reading nook



A freshly grilled, salsa-topped burger simply screams summer!

We've looked to the sunny beaches of Baja for inspiration for our very own signature burger, but it's quite at home in backyards all across this fine country. Happy grilling and happy summer!

OUR HOMES BAJA-STYLE BURGER

Makes 4 Burgers

1 lb (454 g) lean ground beef

2 cloves garlic, grated

2 tsp Dijon mustard

1 tsp chili powder

Dash Worcestershire sauce

Salt and pepper to taste

4 slices mozzarella cheese

4 buns, halved and toasted

1 avocado, sliced

- In a separate bowl, gently knead together the ground beef, garlic, Dijon, chili powder and Worcestershire sauce. Shape into 4 patties, about 4 inches wide and ¾-inch thick. Using thumb, press an indent in the centre of one side of each of the patties. Generously sprinkle both sides with salt and pepper.
- Place patties on greased grill over medium-high heat and grill, turning once, until centre of meat registers 160° F using instant-read thermometer, 8 to 10 minutes. Place cheese on burgers, close lid and grill until cheese is melted, 1 to 2 minutes.

GRILLED CORN & TOMATO SALSA

1 corncob

1 tomato, finely diced

⅓ cup finely diced white onion

2 tbsp chopped fresh cilantro

2 tsp olive oil

1 tsp lime juice

Pinch each salt and pepper

- Place corncob on greased grill over medium-high heat; grill until tender and well grill-marked, about 15 minutes. Let cool enough to handle; cut kernels from cob. Place in bowl and let cool completely. Stir in tomato, onion, cilantro, olive oil, lime juice, salt and pepper. Set aside.

CHILI-LIME MAYO

½ cup light mayonnaise

2 tsp lime juice

½ tsp each chili and garlic powder

- In bowl, stir together mayonnaise, lime juice, chili powder and garlic powder. Set aside.

Spread buns with Chili-Lime Mayo, top each with a burger, a few avocado slices and some of the Grilled Corn & Tomato Salsa. Enjoy! **OH**
