THE PLACE: Lagom 142 is nestled on Creemore's main street and is housed in an annexed building of Heirloom 142. This lifestyle boutique opened in 2017 and came about when owners Laurie Severn and Pierre Armengol realized how much they missed the Scandinavian design shop they had owned in Europe. Lagom is Swedish for "not too little, not too much, just right" and that is exactly the type of home goods you will find in the store.



WHAT'S HOT: Look for sustainable Scandinavian design items made from natural materials like felted-wool waterproof pots, Abeego wax-paper food wraps, natural-fibre vegetable brushes, Axlings table linens, Marimekko cotton pillows and 100 per cent Swedish wool blankets for cool spring nights. For warm spring nights, natural citronella insect repellent, incense and candles, cast iron and leather fire accessories and thoughtfully-selected Belgian white-oak furniture made from FSC-certified wood.
