**THE PLACE:** Just outside of Hanover, a tree-lined driveway leads to **The Old Barn**. Under its roof is a full-service custom stone countertop business run by Reay and Courtney Hunter. THE STYLE: The showroom has an extensive section of quartz samples from Hanstone, Caesarstone and Silestone that offer various price points for customers. Because quartz is a manmade product, the small samples reflect exactly what a large surface will look like. For granite, you have to head out to the slab yard. Since Granite is a natural product, you have to look at each individual slab to see the variances in the stone. The



selection is impressive, so be prepared to spend some time wandering and dreaming. Also available are stainless steel kitchen sinks, porcelain vanity sinks and a selection of faucets.
